Introduction

Researchers and scientists at hundreds of locations around the world, including state hospitals, children's homes, prisons, military bases, and universities, many of the locations have never been identified, cooperated sometimes knowingly and sometimes unknowingly in research on human subjects.

Academic researchers are funded through grants funnelled to them from CIA front organisations, other government institutions, and foundations while remaining unaware the government organisations sought to use their work for its own purposes. In other instances, however, top officials at these institutions knew about the government's role.

The experiments sought to identify and develop drugs and procedures to weaken subjects and implement mind control. They involved surreptitious administration of drugs and other chemicals, hypnosis, sensory deprivation, isolation, as well as verbal and sexual abuse.

These experiments continue today.

Throughout the years I have kept notes on identified locations and human experiments. I have decided to share these notes with the intention of assisting survivors and their families.

A. A. Uktomskii Military Institute in Leningrad- Dt Genady Sergeyev. Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland-Edgewood/Aberdeen chemical tests- About 7,000 soldiers took part in these experiments that involved exposures to more than 250 different chemicals, according to the Department of Defense (DoD).

Academy of Science for East Africa- Funded by the CIA research front known as the Human Ecology Fund.

Academy of Sciences USSR- Commissioned the Institute of Radio Engineering and Electronics, USSR the lead agency of the Academy of Sciences to study weak signals, the program of studying physical fields from biological objects in order to create fundamentally new methods of medical diagnostics.

Addiction Research Center in Kentucky- CIA directly managed. A 1957 study records how numerous vulnerable individuals were psychologically and physically tortured, in particular one Black participant, who was described by researchers as if he were an animal and treated accordingly. The researcher tested some 800 compounds on addicted patients. Dr. Harris Isbell.

University of Adelaide, Australia- Aboriginal Australians were subject to medical experiments on how they experienced pain and where body measurements and blood samples were forcibly taken.

Advanced Research Projects Agency for Health ARPA-ARPA-H -2021 as a biomedical version of the military's Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency.

Advisory Council on Scientific Research and Technical Development- The hope was that LSD and other such chemical weapons could produce a "humane type of warfare".

AEC Agricultural Research Laboratory- Cow milk containing radioactive iodine. Oak Ridge National Laboratory.

Aero Medical Laboratory, Directorate of Research, Wright-Patterson-Project 6302. Project 6302, "Toxic Hazards of Propellants and Materials," Task 630202, "Pharmacology-Biochemistry," for the Toxic Hazards Branch, Physiology Division, Biomedical.

African Research Foundation- Funded by the CIA research front known as the Human Ecology Fund. Instrumentation in psychophysiology.

Agnews State Mental Hospital near Stanford University to conduct experiments on hapless mental patients. The National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH), CIA-MK-ULTRA institution, underwrote her research which more than likely was to clandestinely study the effects of the Moscow signal using mental patients as subjects.

Ain Aouda Secret Prison- A suspected black site, torture and detention centre operated by the Directorate for the Surveillance of the Territory (Direction de la surveillance du territoire, DST)

Air Force 657 1st Aeromedical Research Laboratory Holloman AFB, New Mexico- Project 6302, "Toxic Hazards of Propellants and Materials," Task 630202, "Pharmacology-Biochemistry," for the Toxic Hazards Branch, Physiology Division, Biomedical Laboratory, Aerospace Medical Research Laboratories.

U.S. Air Force's 711th Human Performance Wing- Targeted Neuroplasticity Training, or TNT, program.

Air Force Intelligence Directorate, Syra (Idarat al-Mukhabarat al-Jawiyya) -Torture. General Electric-General Electric ran the Hanford Nuclear Reservation in Richland, Washington as part of the U.S. weapons program.

Experiments were performed on inmates at a prison in Walla Walla, Washington, near Hanford. Starting in 1963, 64 prisoners had their scrotums and testes irradiated to determine the effects of radiation on human reproductive organs.

Air Force Intelligence Support Agency AFISA (recent name) of the Air Force's all sources intelligence organisation.

Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL) Was "formed in October 1997 as the product of an organisational consolidation that integrated previously separate Air Force laboratories (Armstrong, Phillips, Rome and Wright-Patterson) with the Air Force Office of Scientific Research."

Active Denial System, some call it the "Death Ray." A spokesperson for the Air Force Research Laboratory served as a volunteer and described his experience: "For the first millisecond it just felt like the skin was warming up. Then it got warmer and warmer and you felt like your skin was on fire. As soon as you are out of the beam your skin returns to normal and there is no pain." The Pentagon has deployed the Active Denial System and Raytheon is working on an updated version. (2010)

Akademgorodok, 'Science City', Russia- Parapsychology.

University of Alabama at Birmingham- O ne of the lead institutions for the SUPPORT study.

Alberni Indian Residential School- Nutrition Research and Human Biomedical Experimentation in Aboriginal Communities and Residential Schools, 1942-1952. At AIRS it was discovered that the children were lacking in vitamins A, B and C, due to the poor diet, and had the highest incidence of riboflavin deficiency of the entire test group.

al-Mascobiyya Interrogation Center- Severe physical and psychological torture, without any form of monitoring and protection.

Allan Memorial Institute, Canada- To study the effect upon human behaviour of the repetition of verbal signals. Patients were treated with LSD-25 and other similar agents to break down patterns of behaviour. The plan included intensive repetition of prearranged verbal signals. Patients were kept in sensory isolation then continuous sleep for seven to ten days. Dr. Cameron completed over 100 cases.

Altered States Ltd, New Zealand- Sells tapes which perform "suggestions" (i.e. hypnosis but not called such) using the Lowery patent voice-FM method, to hypnotise without the subject being aware.

American Cancer Society- The study group consisted of three patients with brain tumours that had been scanned previously with either radioactive copper or arsenic. Gamma globulin labelled with I124 was injected and multiple scans were conducted to determine how effectively the labelled protein concentrated in tumours. A typical level of administered activity was 260 microcuries of I124. Up to five scans were performed on each patient.

American Family Foundation- W hich exists officially to guard the public from injurious cults. AFF is the mother organisation for the so-called Cult Awareness Network (CAN). Dr. Louis Jolyon West is a director of AFF. West researched "the psychology of dissociated states" for the CIA, using LSD and hypnosis. Rabbi Maurice Davis.

American Psychological Association- MK-ULTRA Subproject 107: Grant to American Psychological Association to support travel of selected psychologists to the Blacked outBlacked out. Establish contact with BLACK psychologists and learn the state of the art of BLACK research. Army Testing: Assassination: Raymond A. Bauer: Berlin Poison Case: Biometric Lab: Biophysical Measurements: Beecher (Henry K.): Brainwashing.

American Psychological Association in 2005, when the board of the organisation of mental health professionals endorsed psychologists' role in interrogations as consistent with APA ethics, for the purpose of making it safe, legal and effective.

American Society for Psychical Research in New York- In these experiments, Ingo was asked to describe the content of a sealed box a metre or so above his head.

American Technologies Corp., San Diego- Under the trade name "Hypersonic Sound". Shows that sound can be focussed to the extent of targeting just one person in a crowd, acoustically, using ultrasound.

Aminabad Psychiatric Hospital, Iran- Kianush Sanjari indicated he was injected with Haloperidol.

Andrew Hamilton Fund- CIA funding front.

ARCO plant in Monaca, PA -Investigation (1983-1992) concerning allegations of physical torture and coercive conditioning of numerous employees. Each victim was trained to enter into a hypnotic state upon the occurrence of specific stimuli, usually involving a "cue" word or phrase and trained to "remember to forget" what transpired in the hypnotic state. They were repeatedly subjected to identical stimulus-response sequence, to produce nearly automatic reactions to the particular status.

Arizona State University in Tempe -Will evaluate TNT stimulation with two groups of volunteers -- one studying intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance, and another practising marksmanship and decision-making, DARPA says. An Arizona State University team is targeting trigeminal nerve stimulation to promote synaptic plasticity in the brain's sensorimotor and visual systems. With the Air Force Research Laboratory, the Air Force 711th Human Performance Wing, and the Army Research Institute of Environmental Medicine the team will evaluate TNT stimulation protocols with a group studying intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance and another practising marksmanship and decision-making.

Argonne Cancer Research Hospital- The Atomic Energy Commission, Chicago Lying-In Hospital. Conduct analyses of the health of the exposed children.

Argonne National Laboratory -Involved injecting patients with dangerous radioactive substances like plutonium or exposing them to powerful beams of

radiation. Argonne National Laboratory from 1945 to 1947. The experiment involved injecting 18 patients with plutonium.

102 human subjects were fed real fallout from the Nevada Test Site; simulated fallout particles that contained strontium, barium, or cesium; or solutions of strontium and cesium. This experiment was designed to measure human absorption and retention of these radioactive substances.

Central Arkansas Veterans Healthcare System in Little Rock -U ncovered rampant violations in its human experiments program, including missing consent forms, secret HIV testing and failure to report more than 100 deaths of subjects participating in studies.

Armed Forces Medical Intelligence Centre (AFMIC) This centre uses mind-controlled Individuals, incl. those who are members of the Green Berets.

Armed Forces Epidemiological Board of the Surgeon General's Office—Despite understanding the optics of infecting mentally disabled children with a potentially deadly disease, Dr. Krugman felt the risk was worth the reward. "The decision to feed hepatitis virus to patients at Willowbrook was not undertaken lightly," he wrote in a 1958 paper published in the New England Journal of Medicine. He noted that the strain of hepatitis in Willowbrook wasn't very severe, that many of the children would get infected anyway, and that any knowledge gained from the experiment would in fact help other Willowbrook residents.

Armstrong Lab at Brooks AFB, San Antonio, TX, -"Directed Energy Warfare RF Effects"

Army Air Force- Hermann Becker-Freysing And Siegfried Ruff, Becker-Freysing was convicted and sentenced to 20 years in prison for conducting experiments on Dachau inmates, such as starving them, then force feeding them seawater that had been chemically altered to make it drinkable. Ruff was acquitted (in a close decision) on charges that he had killed as many as 80 Dachau inmates in a low-pressure chamber designed to simulate altitudes in excess of 60,000 feet. Before their trial, Becker-Freysing and Ruff were paid by the Army Air Force to write reports about their experiments.

The Army Chemical Center -P aid for LSD and related drug brainwashing experiments by Dr. Paul Hoch.

Army Chemical Corps -Conducted a classified medical research program for developing incapacitating agents. This program involved testing nerve agents, nerve agent antidotes, psycho chemicals, and irritants. It is known that tests were undertaken in Cairo, Egypt, Liberia, in South Korea, and in Japan's satellite province of Okinawa in 1961, or earlier. This was at least one year prior to the creation of Project 112.

Army Research Institute (ARI)- A sked the National Research Council (NRC) to assess a field of popular techniques designed to enhance human performance.

Army Research Laboratory (ARL) is the U.S. Army's corporate research laboratory. ARL is headquartered at the Adelphi Laboratory Centre (ALC) in Adelphi, Maryland. Its largest single site is at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland. Other major ARL locations include Research Triangle Park, North Carolina, White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico, Orlando, Florida, and NASA's Glenn Research Centre, Ohio and Langley Research Centre, Virginia. In addition to the Army Research Office, ARL has six technical directorates: Computational and Information Sciences

A.S. Popov Institute- E.K. Naumov.

The Asia Foundation - CIA asset from the early 1950s until 1967, gained access to lists of Asian anthropologists by offering to subsidise AAA membership dues for Asian anthropologists.

Aspen Institute, Berlin - Shepard Stone.

Association of Old Crows- The Association of Old Crows is a non-profit organisation dedicated to electronic warfare with 13,500 members.

Associated Universities, Inc.- Operates Brookhaven National Laboratory (BNL).

Aston Hall-Derbyshire- Evidence from Aston Hall shows sodium amytal was being used into the late 1970s - on children and adolescents. Medical records show the typical dose of sodium amytal was 60mg.

AstraZeneca- In 2004, University of Minnesota research participant Dan Markingson died by suicide while enrolled in an industry-sponsored pharmaceutical trial comparing three FDA-approved atypical antipsychotics: Seroquel (quetiapine), Zyprexa (olanzapine), and Risperdal (risperidone). Associated Universities, Inc- Supported study the injections of the tracers, the researchers monitored the activity of the cerebrospinal fluid in the lateral ventricles and the lumbar subarachnoid space by assaying the radioactivity levels of the plasma for 5 hours. The investigators concluded that the amount of cerebrospinal fluid created daily is small and that fluid creation is not the sole responsibility of the choroid plexus.

Association Of Applied Eniology -C reated in 1989 by the Federation of Soviet engineers.

Association Of Applied Eniology- Created in 1989 by the Federation of Soviet engineers, led by F.R.Hantseverov (Ф.Р.Ханцеверов).

Atlanta Federal Penitentiary- MK-ULTRA Subproject 47: Study drugs affecting the central nervous system, looking towards an anti-interrogation drug. Also, to screen and evaluate hallucinogenic materials of interest to

Technical Services Division. Testing on human volunteers at Atlanta Federal Penitentiary.

Atomic Energy Authority, UK- Papers released by the American Department of Energy, show scientists from the UK Atomic Energy Authority removed children's bones and bodies to ship to the United States for classified nuclear experiments. American and British government scientists discuss levels of radiation in the ribs of stillborn babies and lists of dead children's bodies obtained from the Middlesex Hospital and spirited to American nuclear laboratories. Between 1957 and 1990.

Atomic Energy Commission, US- Involved in Radiation Experiments. The Fernald students' experiment was just one among dozens of radiation experiments approved by the Atomic Energy Commission. Released iodine-131 and xenon-133 into the atmosphere near the Hanford site in Washington, which contaminated a 500,000-acre (2,000 km2) area containing three small towns.

Atomic Weapons Establishment at Aldermaston, UK- Experiments which involved a number of different radioactive substances being inhaled, injected, swallowed or eaten, some of them by women and one by a man aged 82 years. The substances involved included Niobium-92m, Barium-133, Palladium-103, Chromium-51, Strontium-85, Strontium-86, Iodine-132, Americium-241, Calcium-45, and Tritium. Between 1957 and 1990.

Atomic Energy Research Establishment at Harwell, UK- experiments which involved a number of different radioactive substances being inhaled, injected, swallowed or eaten, some of them by women and one by a man aged 82 years.

The substances involved included Niobium-92m, Barium-133, Palladium-103, Chromium-51, Strontium-85, Strontium-86, Iodine-132, Americium-241, Calcium-45, and Tritium. Between 1957 and 1990.

Australian Chemical Warfare Experimental and Research Station in Innisfail, Queensland- Series of gas chamber tests.

Australian National University in Canberra, ACT -W here the previously mentioned, Leonard G.H. Huxley served as Vice-Chancellor (1960-1967).

Scientists ran three experiments where participants played games against a computer. As the machine gained insights from the behaviour underlying participant responses, it identified and targeted vulnerabilities in people's decision-making to steer them towards particular actions or goals. (2021) (CSIRO)

American Family Foundation- MK-Ultra community front.

Atmore State Prison, Alabama- 50 psychosurgical operations.

Automation and Electrometry, Special Department 8 Russia- investigate telepathy and distant influence, otherwise called 'biocommunication'. closed down in 1969.

University of Western Australia -CIA's Human Ecology Fund gave a research grant to Professor Ronald Taft.

Aynaghar (Bengali: আয়্নাঘর) or House of Horrors- The name of a secret detention centre run by the Directorate General of Forces Intelligence (DGFI), Bangladesh's defence forces' intelligence branch.

Badger Arms- South African Defence Force front company.

BAE Systems, Britain- DSTL listed "understanding and influencing human behaviour" among its list of research priorities, including through the "targeted manipulation of information" and "coordinated use of the full spectrum of national capabilities ... including military, non-military, overt and covert".

Bagram AirField in Afghanistan- Interrogation facility for high-value detainees, Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) runs the site.

Ballistic Research Laboratories, Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD-Psychoenergetic research.

Battelle Memorial Institute, Richland, Washington- Radioactive promethium was administered to 14 subjects by injection or drinking. These experiments were designed to measure the passage of this substance through the body and the ability of a drug (chelating agent) to increase the removal of promethium.

Five subjects were injected with radioactive phosphorus. In addition, five subjects were fed fish from the Columbia River which contained radioactive phosphorus, produced and discharged into the river by reactors at the Atomic Energy Commission's Hanford Site. These experiments were designed to estimate the doses to humans eating contaminated fish.

Baylor University- Neil Burch.

Beacon Fund- CIA funding front.

Bechtrev's Brain Institute- Conducted successful sessions of telepathic communication between Leningrad and Sevastopol.

Behavioral Science Consultation Teams (BSCT)- A joint operation of the Army and CIA.

Beijing's Academy of Military Medical Sciences- Currently developing a series of mind control weapons dubbed as 'biotechnology.' One of the key weapons being developed includes, 'purported brain-control weaponry.

Bekhterev Brain Institute, Moscow- Telepathic experiments. Gulyat.Ev, P. Bell Laboratories-Parapsychology- Bell Laboratories have successfully replicated the SRI remote viewing tasks.

Bellevue Psychiatric Hospital- From 1942 to 1955, paediatric neuropsychiatrist Dr. Lauretta Bender conducted electroshock therapy treatment experiments on hundreds of children ranging from three to twelve years old.

Belmont Hospital - Using ECT (Electroconvulsive Therapy), continuous narcosis, insulin coma therapy and psychosurgery. William Sargant.

Fort Benning, Georgia- Effects of psychochemical agents.

University of California at Berkeley- Studies in whole-body radiation of human subjects by external and internal radiation. (2) Studies on the metabolism of radioactive iodine in animals and man.

Berry Street Foundling Home- Children's home to test a new quadruple antigen vaccination, which included a polio vaccine possibly contaminated with a monkey virus since linked to cancer.

Beth Israel Hospital- Professor Frankle hypnotises a patient.

Researchers studied the thyroid function of 21 students and seven parents at Fernald using doses of radioactive tracer high enough to cause "serious concern," according to the state task force report. Severely retarded infants and young children, including orphans, at the Fernald State School in Waltham were offered as test subjects for studies at Beth Israel Hospital.

Bethany Babies Home in Geelong- Children's home to test a new quadruple antigen vaccination, which included a polio vaccine possibly contaminated with a monkey virus since linked to cancer.

Bikini Atoll- During 1956, the US Air Force sent manned planes through radiation clouds from atomic bomb tests in the Pacific to measure radiation doses in the clouds and to the crew.

Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation- Help fund the clinical trial in India. RotaTeq, marketed by Merck & Co., and Rotarix, marketed by GlaxoSmithKline. More than 2,000 children in the India trial received placebo injections of salt water rather than one of the available effective vaccines. Given the availability of two highly effective rotavirus vaccines at the time the India study was initiated, the failure to provide infants with one of these two vaccines instead of a placebo violated international ethical standards for conducting human research. A rotavirus vaccine study in which infants received a placebo would never have been permitted in the U.S.

Billings Hospital at University of Chicago- Manhattan Project injection of plutonium into three patients.

Biocon (South Africa)- South African Defence Force front company. **Billings Hospital, University of Chicago-** Patients were injected with plutonium. These experiments were carried out by the Manhattan Project. **BioCorRx-** F acilitated an anti-opioid implantation in an incarcerated person earlier this year. But the procedure hadn't been approved by the FDA. (2019) Enrolled the first prisoner in its "Recovery Program Pilot" when LDPSC

doctors had placed a sustained-release naltrexone implant into a soon-to-bereleased inmate at the Louisiana State Penitentiary.

Bio-Research Inc and Panoramic Research, Inc,- Study of bacterial and fungal toxins Study (Used in Cuba)-"Investigations of the remote directional control of activities of selected species of animals." Ultimate purpose was operational use of animals in delivery systems. Systems unspecified – could have included audio and/or photo devices (See 142 for assassination applications). (Implantation of miniaturised stimulating electrodes in specific brain centre areas of animals – rats, donkeys, dogs.)

Biotrial, French contract-research organisation, Rennes- One person died, and five others were hospitalised, after a clinical trial of an experimental drug in France went tragically wrong. The Portuguese company Bial produced the drug, which was aimed at treating anxiety and motor disorders associated with Parkinson's disease, and chronic pain in people with cancer and other conditions.

NHS Hospitals In Birmingham ,UK- LSD research took place (based on MKUltra methodology) at several institutions.

Biological Apparatus Building In Puschtschmo, Russia- Equipment necessary for the proof of the KIRLIAN-effect" "finger radiation", which, for example, might a ow lay practitioners to make diagnoses, to achieve healings with this particular process, triggered on the skin of the human body or plants. **Department of Experimental Psychiatry at Birmingham University UK-** R eceived substantial funding via the Rockefeller Foundation during the early 1950s for a five-year research programme. Dr Elkes was appointed as head of the programme.

Black Jail -A U.S. military detention camp established in 2002 inside Bagram Air Base, Afghanistan. Distinct from the main prison of the Bagram Internment Facility, the "Black Jail" is run by the U.S. Defense Intelligence Agency and U.S. Special Operations Forces. There are numerous allegations of abuse associated with the prison, including beatings, sleep deprivation and forcing inmates into stress positions. U.S. authorities refuse to acknowledge the prison's existence.

Black Jails (Chinese: 黑監獄; pinyin: hēijiānyù) -Are a network of extralegal detention centres established by Chinese security forces and private security companies across the People's Republic of China. They are used mainly to detain, without trial, petitioners (上访者, shangfangzhe), who travel to seek redress for grievances unresolved at the local level.

Borden Trust- CIA funding front.

Bordertown Facility' Bordentown NJ Reformatory- Dr. Pfeiffer would start experiments with the government at 'Bordertown Facility' in New Jersey under unknown projects in 1951(possibly under 'Artichoke' or 'Bluebird'). ARTICHOKE Docs 59-155.

Boston University- Martin Orne, Philip Nogee.

Boston University's Marsh Chapel -S ite of the Harvard Psilocybin Project. **Boston Psychopathic Hospital** - (Dr. Robert Hyde)-Subproject 8: MK-ULTRA. LSD in experiments secretly financed by the Central Intelligence Agency. Dr. Max Rinkle.

Bowman Gray, School of Medicine, Wake Forest University, NC- G amma globulin, in people with multiple sclerosis. (Brookhaven National Laboratory). Boys Town- S taffed by the likes of Dr. Leslie Collins and Michael Casey; brief residence of Charles Manson; source of child prostitutes in the Franklin scandal.

Ft. Bragg- P ersonnel from Edgewood Arsenal conducted field testing of LSD at Fort Bragg (1958). On Sept. 16, 2002, the BSCT and four interrogators from JTF-170 arrived at Fort Bragg for training where they were joined by a CIA psychologist and several Army personnel.

Branch 285, Syria -Investigations branch 285 located in Kafr Soussa, west of central Damascus.

Brandeis University- Hypnosis, with Martin Orne.

Breadsall Remand Home in Derby- T ook girls from the Midlands and Yorkshire and sent many to Aston Hall Hospital.

Bright Light -The codename of one of the Central Intelligence Agency's network of black sites—clandestine interrogation centres. The location of the site, in Bucharest, Romania.

Brinkgreven in Deventer. Netherlands- LSD-C. H. Van Rhijn.

Bristol-Myers Squibb- U.S. researchers used prostitutes to infect prison inmates, insane asylum patients, and Guatemalan soldiers with syphilis and other sexually transmitted diseases to test the effectiveness of penicillin in treating the STDs. Approximately 700 people were infected as part of the study (including orphan children).

British National Association for Mental Health- Montagu Norman. The president of Norman's association was to be Richard Austen ("RAB") Butler. He had been deputy foreign minister to Lord Halifax and the spokesman in the British Parliament for the pro-Nazi policy. The chairman of the association was to be Lord Halifax's son-in-law, the Earl of Feversham. The vice chairman was Lord Montagu Norman's wife, eugenics activist Priscilla Reyntiens Worsthorne Norman.

Brookhaven National Laboratory- Study on the use of iodine. Research on boron neutron capture therapy. Children 2-6 years old, iodine research. Gamma globulin, in people with multiple sclerosis.

from 1955 to 1956. The subjects were six children in various phases of the nephrotic syndrome using iodine-131 (I131), including one child who had recovered from the illness, and nine normal subjects, consisting of eight men and one woman, all between the ages of 21 and 29 years. These subjects were

Department of Psychiatry at the Medical University of Sofia, in Bulgaria-LSD experiments.

Bureau of Medicine (BUMED), Navy- Positively identified as having been involved, to some degree, with human radiation experiments.

Burns and Roe Services Corporation-(PIADC) L ow bids other competitors and is awarded the contract. In cost-cutting moves, the contractor scales back on safety and security measures in place for decades.

Bushnell Field, FL- Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects. **Bureau of Narcotics-** MK-ULTRA Subproject 132: "Realistic tests of certain RandD items of interest to TSD/CB (Technical Services Division/Chemical Branch), including a facility and personnel for the operational testing with complete non-attributability of sponsors."

Bureau of Prisons- Dr. Pfeiffer contacted the United States Bureau of Prisons to request permission to conduct lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD) and its antidotes.study under the auspices of the United States Public Health Service and Emory University at the United States Penitentiary in Atlanta, Georgia.Permission was granted and, in 1956, the study commenced.

Bureau of Social Science Research- Attitudes of Sierra Leone students. The Human Ecology Fund, CIA.

Butler Hospital Health Centre (part of Harvard)- T est a number of techniques for predicting a given individual's reactions to LSD-25, other psycho chemicals and alcohol. At Butler, among other things, the research team conducted an experiment on staff members with alcohol and the tranquilliser chlorapromazine that was also financed by the C.I.A.'s Society for the Investigation of Human Ecology.

Butler Health Center facility in Rhode Island- M any physicians, including Dr. Robert Hyde, worked for the Agency. Butler Center also served as the CIA's central site for exposing its own officials and agents to LSD and other drugs. The Society for the Investigation of Human Ecology., on behalf of the C.I.A., underwrote experiments using tranquillisers and alcohol on mental patients and staff members.

Butyrka Prison (Hospital Section), Moscow, USSR-Torture prision.

Naval Medical Research Unit No.3, Cairo, Egypt- Positively identified as having been involved, to some degree, with human radiation experiments. Study "Calcification of Schistosoma Haematoeium Eggs: Relation of Radiologically Demonstrable Calcification to Eggs in Tissues and Passage of Eggs in Urine." March 1978

University of California-Berkeley- An experiment funded by the U.S. military meant to sharpen soldiers' minds for the battlefield has found a way to improve memory: by zapping subjects' brains with tiny bursts of electricity during sleep. DARPA-funded research 2019.

University of California Department of Pediatrics- Performed experiments on 113 newborns ranging in age from one hour to three days, in which they studied changes in blood pressure and blood flow. In one of the studies, researchers inserted a catheter through the babies' umbilical arteries and into their aortas, and then submerged their feet in ice water. In another of the studies, they strapped 50 newborn babies to a circumcision board, and turned them upside down so that all of their blood rushed into their heads.

University of California, Los Angeles- P artnered with AgelessRx last year to launch the Phase II Participatory Evaluation (of) Aging (With) Rapamycin (for) Longevity Study (PEARL) trial (NCT04488601), designed to evaluate Rapamycin in an estimated 1,000 older adults.

California Institute for Women (CIW)- CIW makes use of an Anectine. Treatment similar to that used at Vacaville.

California Men's Colony - The psychiatric staff uses the powerful drug Prolixin to control inmate behaviour under the "novel diagnostic classification" that the prisoners are psychotics who are repressing the symptoms of their psychosis.

Callan Park (Australia) -Cerebral Surgery and Research Unit at Callan Park Psychiatric Hospital. After his (Dr. Harry Richard Bailey) appointment, the Sydney Sunday tabloid declared in September 1957, "Human guinea pigs in test: A Sydney mental specialist and 15 other volunteers deliberately sent themselves temporarily insane in recent mental research tests." Bailey was the man behind this experiment at Callan Park. He went on in the article to promote LSD as a hopeful method of treating "mental cases" and said that these experiments would hopefully trace the section of the brain which is affected by schizophrenia. In 1959, Bailey became the Medical Superintendent of Callan Park.

Cambridge Analytica- "According to media reports, Cambridge Analytica secured the Facebook data from Aleksandr Kogan, a data scientist and

psychologist who had been employed as a Lecturer and Senior Research Associate at the University of Cambridge from 2012 to 2018.

Camp 22, North Korea -Described laboratories equipped with glass gas chambers for suffocation gas experiments, in which three or four people, normally a family, are the experimental subjects. After the people undergo medical checks, the chambers are sealed and poison is injected through a tube, while scientists observe from above through glass. In a report reminiscent of an earlier account of a family of seven, Kwon claims to have watched one family of two parents, a son and a daughter die from suffocating gas, with the parents trying to save the children using mouth-to-mouth resuscitation for as long as they had the strength.

Camp 1391 or Unit 1391, or Facility 1391 - An Israel Defense Forces prison camp in northern Israel. It is run by Unit 504. Camp 1391 is situated in a Tegart fort on route 574 between kibbutz Barkai and kibbutz Ma'anit. Camp 1391 is operated by the Israel Defense Forces Intelligence Corps, rather than by Shin Bet.

Camp King, Germany- The facility's chief medical doctor was Dr. Walter Schreiber. Camp King in Oberursel, near Frankfurt am Main, Germany. Here the CIA began developing "extreme interrogation" techniques and "behaviour modification programs." The unorthodox methods the CIA and its partner agencies explored included hypnosis, electric shock, chemicals and illegal street drugs. Camp King was chosen as an ideal place to do this work in part because it was "off-site" but mainly because of its access to prisoners believed to be Soviet spies.

Camp Lejeune, NC- Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects. Camp No -An alleged secret detention and torture facility (black site) related to the United States detainment camps located in Guantánamo Bay, Cuba. Estimated to be located about a mile beyond the regular camp boundaries, the camp was described as a highly secret facility referred to as "Camp No" by Guantanamo guards. When soldiers asked about it, they were told "No, it doesn't exist".

Camp Polk, LA- Chemical weapons testing site using human test subjects. Camp Sibert, Alabama- Chemical weapons testing site using human test subjects.

Canadian Federal Corrections- Dr. George Scott. teamed up with shrinks from Allan Memorial Institute, including the notorious Ewen Cameron, to launch a variety of drug, electroshock, sensory deprivation and pain tolerance experiments, using prisoners and patients at mental hospitals as guinea pigs. The LSD for some of the experiments as well as funding for the research was provided by the CIA and the Canadian Defense Department.

Canadian Defense Department- LSD for some of the experiments as well as funding for the research was provided by the CIA and the Canadian Defense Department, George Scott.

Canadian Defense Research Board (DRB) -In 1951-convened a secret meeting in Montreal attended by military officials from the United Kingdom, Canada and two CIA officials. The focus of the meeting was — "brainwashing techniques." Dr. Donald O. Hebb, chief of DRB Behavioral Research and chair of Psychology at McGill. According to minutes of the Montreal meeting (1951), Hebb spoke at length, suggesting that: "sensory isolation might lead to some clues" "intervention in the individual mind together with methods concerned in psychological coercion." Hebb suggested that by "cutting off all sensory stimulation . . . the individual could be led into a situation whereby ideas, etc. might be implanted."

Canadian Ministry of Defense in Toronto, Canada- Dr. Douglas Pearce-

Carbó-Serviá (forensic) ward of Havana Psychiatric Hospital- Prisoners end up in the forensic ward of mental hospitals in Santiago de Cuba and Havana where they undergo ill-treatment including electroconvulsive therapy without muscle relaxants or anaesthesia.: 75 The reported application of ECT in the forensic wards seems, at least in many of the cited cases, not to be an adequate clinical treatment for the diagnosed state of the prisoner — in some cases the prisoners seem not to have been diagnosed at all

Cardiff University- An experiment funded by the U.S. military meant to sharpen soldiers' minds for the battlefield has found a way to improve memory: by zapping subjects' brains with tiny bursts of electricity during sleep.

DARPA-funded research 2019.

Carnegie Institute- E ugenics movement. The best human "pedigree" was, of course, any genetics that included Nordic, Germanic or Anglo-Saxon blood. One of the top priorities of the eugenics movement was the forcible sterilisation of the poor, disabled and "immoral" (which would include anyone convicted of a crime).

Carver Village- Fort Detrick, Maryland. The bioweapons developed by these programs were tested in Carver Village in Florida, a housing development that

was open to Black people.

Case Western Reserve University- The significant non-patient population in this study is the group Marshallese Islanders who were exposed to radioactive iodine from atomic bomb test fallout. Was funded sequentially by the Atomic Energy Commission, the Energy Research and Development Administration, and the Department of Energy.

Elaine Holden-Able, a healthy retired nurse, consumed a glass of orange juice that had been mixed with a dietary supplement for the sake of medical research. This Case Western University Alzheimer's experiment, financed by

the tobacco industry, wound up killing her in what was called a "tragic human error.' 2001

Catherine Mills Rehabilitation Center- Liberia's only psychiatric unit. Dr. Nathan S. Kline.

Cecilia Jeffrey School- Ran until 1976 at least 37 students passed away while attending the Presbyterian Church-ran school. A local doctor and a school nurse experimented with 14 different drugs to treat "ear troubles". Cecilia Jeffrey School.

Central Bureau of Investigation, India- in July, 2013, NIMHANS, was involved in a controversy where it was alleged that it provided assistance to the Central Bureau of Investigation relating to some interrogation techniques. Central Committee of CPSU- For biological radiation and paranormal human's abilities -Russia.

The Central Epidemic Prevention and Water Purification Department of the North China Army/ Unit 1855- Japan.

The Central Epidemic Prevention and Water Purification Department of Central China/ Unit 1644- Japan.

The Central Epidemic Prevention and Water Purification Department of the Southern Expeditionary Army/ Unit 9620- Japan.

Central Intelligence Agency- sets up clandestine prisons in Germany, Japan, and the Panama Canal Zone. Prisoners are injected with drugs and interrogated. Dulles, Wisner, and Helms provide leadership. The endeavour is named Project Artichoke. May 15, 1952: Dulles and Wisner receive a report on Project Artichoke, spelling out the agency's effort to test heroin, amphetamines, sleeping pills, and LSD on human subjects. A few months later, Dulles approves a new program testing long term use of LSD on humans. It is code-named Ultra.

Central Middlesex Hospital's Department of Morbid Anatomy and Histology- The help of doctors steal dead babies for up to three decades UK Atomic Energy Authority removed children's bones and bodies to ship to the United States for classified nuclear experiments. Assigned codenames as part of tight security surrounding the experiments. Baby B-1102, for example, is listed as a boy who died aged eight months. Baby B-595 was a girl who was 13 months old when she died.

Centre for Critical Intelligence Studies (CCIS)- CIA program. Rutgers University.

Centre for Energy and Information Technologies at the St. Petersburg State Institute of Fine Mechanics and Optics (TSEIT GITMO)- Related to metrology of 'high-penetrating' emission, there are 19 groups of physical effects that can represent a basis for the development of sensors, with dozens of technical sensors. The appearance of generators and detectors of 'high-

penetrating' radiation in 2003-2004 indicated the beginning of a new stage in the development of instrumental psychotronics.

Centre For Personal Protection and Safety- Which counts both the DoD and the FBI among its clients. (Spivey, Sporleder, and Aldrich.)

Centre for the Study and Reduction of Violence -Its staff was to investigate the genetics and biochemistry of their prisoners, including "hyperkinetic children," whose every motion would be electronically monitored by Orwellian guards. Though backed by Gov. Ronald Reagan, the plan was defeated.

Centre Of Unconventional Technologies- Deal exclusively with instrumental psychotronics.

Cerebral Surgery and Research Unit at Callan Park Psychiatric Hospital in Sydney- September 1957, the Sydney Sunday tabloid published an article about a Callan Park experiment, headlined: 'Human Guinea Pigs in Test: A Sydney mental specialist and 15 other volunteers deliberately sent themselves temporarily insane in recent mental research tests.'

"The Chamber', Russia- Ran by the Secret Police is reported to be the location of experiments.

Charles F. Brush Foundation for the Betterment of the Human Race -Was founded in 1928 by the eponymous Cleveland inventor and industrialist with the aim of supporting eugenics research in Ohio and around the world.

Charles Camsell hospital in Edmonton- First Nation patients also underwent trials for streptomycin, an antibiotic that was used to cure TB. Doctors also continued to surgically remove TB from Indigenous patients into the 1950s and

60s, after the procedure was no longer done on the non-Indigenous population. Navy Brig in Charleston, South Carolina- Jose Padilla, who had originally been accused of wanting to set off a "dirty bomb." The charge was later forced, but Padilla was held in solitary confinement for many months and forced to take LSD or other powerful drugs while held in the Navy brig.

Chatham House, Britain- Militaries are investing in research and development programmes to enhance the performance of their soldiers, exploring pharmacological solutions to improve soldier strength, mental capacity, recovery, and resistance to fatigue and trauma. Drug use by the armed forces could be employed to improve soldier strength, mental capacity, recovery, and resistance to fatigue and trauma. However, in approving the use of drugs for these military applications, it is critical that their effects on the human nature of soldiers, such as empathetic understanding, or mental capacity, should not be undermined, where soldiers are to uphold their moral obligations under international humanitarian law.

Chelmsford Private Hospital- Became Australia's worst psychiatric disaster where over 1,400 patients were subjected to hypnotic drugs, ECT and DST in a mostly experimental fashion without informed consent. The entire Chelmsford medical team were previously involved in a eugenics program

of forced adoption at Sydney's Crown Street Hospital for Women where babies were taken from 'unfit' mothers and given to mothers deemed more appropriate. A massive 64% of unwed mothers had their babies stolen at Crown Street Hospital. Harry Bailey used hypnotic drugs to make the reluctant birth mothers comply. He directly ordered the abortion of twin foetuses without the consent of a woman who was under the influence of hypnotic drugs.

Naval Hospital Chelsea/Naval Blood Lab-W as disestablished approximately 1968. Red blood cell survival studies of transfused blood to test cell survival using Chromium-51. (November 1990)

Chemical and Radio-logical Laboratories of the Department of the Army-Foster D. Snell.

Chemical Warfare Service -Conducted experiments which exposed thousands of U.S. military personnel to mustard gas, in order to test the effectiveness of gas masks and protective clothing.

Chernyakhovsk Hospital (Chernyakhovsk, formerly the East Prussian town of Insterburg) Belokopytov (Major) Prison Commandant (Fnu). Cherry Farm Hospital In The South Island Of New Zealand- Between 1973 and 1978 - a version of Deep Sleep Therapy was used in several wards. used electro convulsive therapy or ECT as standard practice. Dunedin prison who we were told would also undergo deep sleep or narcosis therapy in an especially locked-down unit of the villa. Cherry Farm was the hospital to use deep sleep therapy most; many patients were not given optimal treatment; the specific application of modified narcosis was inappropriate and applied to a large number of patients up to 1978.

Cherry Hospital North Carolina- Electroshock therapy and locking troublesome patients in cages (a practice that was not abandoned until 1956). University of Chicago- 102 human subjects were fed real fallout from the Nevada Test Site; simulated fallout particles that contained strontium, barium, or cesium; or solutions of strontium and cesium. This experiment was designed to measure human absorption and retention of these radioactive substances.

Chicago Lying-In Hospital- A program of routine pelvic examination by x-ray early in pregnancy for 1008 mothers who were to bear their first child. The objective of the exposures was to make delivery and labour more predictable and easier by measuring the sizes of pelvis and foetal head.

Chicago VA Hospital- LSD experiments. Dr. Morris A. Lipton.

Children's International Summer Villages- CIA on Subproject 103, which was conducted at the International Children's Summer Camp in Maine include a statement concerning the Subproject that, In addition, it will assist in the identification of promising young foreign nationals and US nationals (many of whom are now in their late teens) who may at any time be of direct interest to the Company). The subjects in this research ranged in age from 16-21 years,

and they were attending the camp as part of a reunion, all having attended previously at ages as young as 11 years. Study in non-verbal communication to assess communications between 16-year old children at a reunion of those who had attended a Children's International Summer Village at age 11.

Children's Welfare Department at Turana, run by the Victorian government- Children's homes to test a new quadruple antigen vaccination, which included polio vaccine possibly contaminated with a monkey virus linked to cancer.

Chillicothe, Ohio -In which drugs were given to inmates in an effort to alter the "institutional behaviour and adjustment patterns" of sociopaths, to a manuscript on the issue of "whether there are certain kinds of human behaviour which the criminal law cannot coerce." L.E.A.A. Chillicothe Correctional Institution where drugs were given to inmates in an effort to alter their "institutional behaviour" and the "adjustment patterns" of sociopaths.

China's Air Force Engineering University- Chinese scientists have developed a telekinetic technology that allows a person to remotely control a metasurface with their mind. Uses a person's brain waves to wirelessly control a programmable metasurface using Bluetooth. What makes the team's approach unique is that unlike previous experiments that required a direct, wired connection to the metasurface, the subject is able to manipulate it remotely.

China's Ministry of Science and Technology- Employs more than 140 "science and technology diplomats" stationed in the SandT directorates of PRC embassies and consulates worldwide.7 Their charge is to monitor developments in global SandT, and to seek out opportunities for Chinese firms to "make full use of international resources" and "expand channels for international science and technology cooperation.

Chinese Academy of Military Medical Sciences- And 11 of its research institutions have been involved in the research and support of biotechnology, including brain-control weaponry, that the Chinese military intends to use to gain a battlefield advantage.

CIA -Funding was involved in nearly half the grants of the non-Big Three foundations Rockefeller, Ford, Carnegie in the field of international activities', CIA's Security Research Service (SRS) -Oversaw ARTICHOKE. The CIA was especially interested in the use of standard electroshock machines in producing amnesia, inducing subjects to talk and making subjects more prone to hypnotic control.

University of Cincinnati Medical School- Researchers led by Dr. Eugene Saenger conducted whole-body radiation experiments on 88 patients at its charity hospital. Patients who were being treated for cancer were given massive doses of radiation. The Cincinnati Project told the patients that they were being treated for their cancer, when in fact the experiments were funded

by the Military. The Military was interested in discovering how much radiation a person can absorb and still remain functional. Studies in whole-body radiation conducted on a largely African-American patient population.

Refrigeration experiment conducted on sixteen mentally disabled patients who were placed in refrigerated cabinets at 30 degree Fahrenheit, for 120 hours,

at University of Cincinnati Hospital., "to study the effect of frigid temperature on

mental disorders."

Study of glucose and lactic acid as a source of hydrogen. Used tritium and Carbon-14.

Cincinnati VA- Researchers at the University of Cincinnati publish findings of an experiment attempting to create a "psychosis model" on human beings. Sixteen patients, experiencing a first episode of schizophrenia, were subjected to repeated provocation with amphetamine. The stated purpose was to produce "behavioural sensitization. This process serves as a model for the development of psychosis, but has been little studied in humans. Symptoms, such as severity of psychosis and eye-blink rates were measured hourly for 5 hours." 1997 Citizens Engaged in Reuniting Families -Anti-cult networks vintage mid-1970s centred around MK -Ultra-CIA.

Citizens Freedom Foundation- Anti-cult networks vintage mid-1970s centred around MK -Ultra-CIA. Ted Patrick, a founder of CFF. Psychiatrist Louis Jolyon West and psychologist Margaret Singer.

City College of New York (Department of Psychology)- Psychoenergetic research.

Civil Cooperation Bureau- South African Defence Force front company. Cleveland City Hospital- Ran experiments to study changes in cerebral blood flow: they injected people with spinal anaesthesia, and inserted needles into their jugular veins and brachial arteries to extract large quantities of blood and, after massive blood loss which caused paralysis and fainting, measured their blood pressure. The experiment was often performed multiple times on the same subject.

Clinical and Experimental Medicine institute (Russia)- Treatment with the use of psychic powers. "Between 1987 and 1988 some 3,000 patients underwent non-traditional medical treatment at the Institute of Clinical and Experimental Medicine (IKIEM); this treatment included the use of psychic methods".

Clinical Immunology State Research Institute (Russia)- Treatment with the use of psychic powers.

Clinton Laboratory, Oak Ridge, Tennessee- Two groups of 10 subjects were exposed to beta rays, The objective of this experiment was to determine the beta ray dose at which skin erythema (reddening of the skin) would first be seen. In

the first set of experiments, 8 of 10 subjects showed a "visible reaction" of mild tanning at a dose of 250 rep. In the second set of experiments, 6 subjects showed erythema at 635 rep, and 8 showed erythema at 313 rep.

Cognitive Sciences Laboratory- The centre for government-sponsored parapsychology research in support of its intelligence program most recently known as STARGATE.

Cold Spring Harbor, Long Island, New York- Harold Abramson.

Colgate College- George H. Estabrooks.

University of Colorado in Boulder -Research on the effects of pulsed microwaves.

Columbia University- MK-ULTRA Subproject 130: Investigation of Personality Theory on patients with different symptoms: indirect assessment. theory, David Saunders/William Thetford.

12 terminal cancer patients were injected with radioactive calcium and strontium. This experiment was designed to compare the distribution of these two substances among body tissues after autopsy.

Columbia University's New York State Psychiatric Institute- Hoch codirected the research for LSD and related drug brainwashing experiments.

Committee on Medical Research (CMR)- Chaired by University of Pennsylvania pharmacologist Alfred Newton Richards, the CMR distributed over \$24 million to 137 institutions. Among the funding priorities of the CMR was research on chemical warfare agents and the prevention or cure of infectious diseases, especially those likely to be encountered by the armed forces.

Committee On "Racial Problems- 1930 report alleged the racial orphanage experiment could "throw light" on how heredity and environment influenced health, vigour, intelligence and sociability. To do this, scientists would try to improve the condition of the black children in the study by altering environmental factors, including shielding the children from racism, offering improved nutrition, and providing better educational opportunities than they might otherwise have had. The study never went forward.

Congress For Cultural Freedom - Which had been discredited when it came to light that much of its funding came from the CIA. Shepard Stone.

Concord Military Hospital (Australia)- Leonas Petrauskas.

Concord Prison- Conducted from 1961-1963 inside the walls of the Concord State Prison, a maximum-security prison for young offenders, in Concord, MA by a team of researchers at Harvard University under the direction of Timothy Leary, which included Michael Hollingshead, Dr. Allan Cohen, Dr. Alfred Alschuder, Dr. George Litwin, Dr. Ralph Metzner, Dr. Gunther Weil, and Dr. Ralph Schwitzgebel, with Dr. Madison Presnell as the medical and psychiatric adviser.

The original study involved the administration of psilocybin-assisted group psychotherapy to 32 prisoners in an effort to reduce recidivism rates.

Cornell University- MK-ULTRA Subproject 60: This project established a covert funding mechanism, the Society for the Investigation of Human Ecology, Inc., (SIHE), for the support of sociological and psychological studies. Prior to SIHE, this activity was part of the Human Ecology Study Program of Cornell University, which sponsored, with Agency financial assistance, studies primarily at Cornell.

Many projects of little or no direct value to the CIA were funded, primarily to develop the cover of SIHE as a legitimate Foundation. Subproject 81-Extension of Hinkle--Wolf.

CPPS -Has offices in Spokane and Reston, Virginia. It bills itself as "the leading developer and provider of scalable training and consulting solutions in the U.S. for Workplace Violence Prevention, Active Shooter Response, and High Risk Travel," and it claims its clients include more than 60 percent of Fortune 100 companies, thousands of universities and hospitals and a variety of federal agencies including the FBI, Department of Defense, Department of Veterans Affairs and the Social Security Administration. (Spivey).

Creedmoor State Hospital, Children's Unit, Queen's Village, New York-experiments-children, six to twelve years of age, under careful continuous observation, single doses of LSD at weekly and semi-weekly intervals and with increasing frequency, until it was evident that children could tolerate and benefit from daily doses up to 150 micrograms.

Two previous reports (4, 5) from the Children's Unit of the Creedmoor State Hospital have been made on the treatment of schizophrenic children with dlysergic acid diethylamide (LSD-25) and a methylated derivative, 1-methyl lysergic acid butanolomide (methy-sergide-UML 491).

Crichton Royal, Dumfries-John Raven- As Raven's Test is strictly visual, the issues of potential language barriers and religious/cultural affiliations are circumvented. Hence, Raven's Progressive Matrices test is one of the most common measures for general intelligence.

Crocker Labs- Biodistribution tracking where compounds of interest travel in an experimental human subject.

Crockett Hospital -Texas-Radiation experiments.

Cross Lake, Canada- Nutritional experiments were conducted between 1942 and 1952 using Indigenous children from residential schools.

Crown Street Hospital for Women in Sydney- It was here that they were involved in a eugenics program of forced adoption from 'unfit' mothers, to ones who were deemed more appropriate. Bailey had helped to introduce methods of using hypnotic drugs to make them comply. He directly ordered the abortion of twin foetuses without a woman's consent while she was under the

influence of these drugs. 64% of unwed mothers had their babies taken at Crown Street.

Cryopharm Corporation, Pasadena, CA. (1991)- To evaluate the safety and circulation time freeze dried red blood cells. The blood cells were labelled with trace amounts of radioactivity in order to make direct measurements.

Cult Awareness Network (CAN)- MK-Ultra community fronts. Ted Patrick, a founder of CFF. psychiatrist Louis Jolyon West and psychologist Margaret Singer. CAN lost a lawsuit and filed for bankruptcy in 1996, Scientologists were able to acquire CAN's name, phone numbers, assets, files and records, and reopened under the name New Cult Awareness Network

Czechoslovakia -Three chemical plants located in conducting independent research on CW compounds. They were working on super—active compounds based on materials such as LSD and mescaline. The work was supported by the Soviet Union but conducted by the Czechs, with the final product going into Czechoslovakian stockpile.

Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences in Prague- Doctor Milan Ryzl. Czech Ministry of Internal Affairs -Asked the USSR to assist in the investigation of Pavlita's devices. Two representatives: from Academy of Science – A.Kitajgorodskiy (А.Китайгородский) and from KGB – Y.Azarov (Ю.Азаров) arrived in Czechoslovakia.

D

University of California, Davis (Dept, of Psychology)- Psychoenergetic research.

Defence Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA)- Sponsored Army/Navy Pandora experiments. Pandora's initial goal: to discover whether a carefully constructed microwave signal could control the mind.

DARPA has also been testing memory-enhancing implants as part of the BRAIN Initiative, reaching significant improvements of short-term memory as far as 35%.

U.S. Defence Intelligence Agency (DIA)- Also indicated interest to Pavlita's work

Defence Science and Technology Laboratory' (DSTL)- The DSTL is a multi-disciplinary department, covering counter terrorism, security, and the mysteriously named 'cyber and influence' – which it cites as directing research in 'human influence'.

Defense Academy for Credibility Assessment- In March 2006, the Department of Defense Polygraph Institute DoDPI now the Defense Academy for Credibility Assessment DACA Research Division requested research to

determine the optimal approaches or techniques used by an interrogator. Specifically, DACA wanted the researchers to gather information from expert interrogators referred to as superior interrogators regarding the approaches and techniques they used in obtaining confessions and admissions following a failed credibility assessment and compare them with the more common approaches and techniques that are employed by the majority of interrogators. **Defense Systems, Easems and GEC-** Most of the scientists worked on highly sensitive electronic warfare programs for NATO, including the Strategic DefenseInitiative. It is claimed that directed energy weapons might have been used to literally drivethese men to suicide and 291accidents.

University of Delaware- Isolate, characterise and identify naturally occurring compounds with psychogenic properties. Much of this work was done with mushrooms. James Moore.

Delta G Scientific Company- Was originally a front company established April 1982 in Weldegraan, Pretoria by the South African Defence Force to research and produce chemical weapons within a covert operation known as Project Coast.

Denver University- Research into the nature of hypnosis and possible operational uses including the use of hypnosis as a learning aid; use in interrogation and counter-interrogation. Uses and limitations of hypnosis. Subproject 5b: MK-ULTRA.

US Department of Defense (DOD) -In the 1962-74 time period conducted a classified chemical and biological warfare test program as well as conducted testing of agents in other countries that were considered too unethical to perform within the continental United States. SHAD /project 112.

In addition to LSD, the Army also tested quinuclidinyl benzilate, a hallucinogen code-named BZ. Many of these tests were conducted under the so-called MKULTRA program, established to counter perceived Soviet and Chinese advances in brainwashing techniques. Between 1953 and 1964, the program consisted of 149 projects involving drug testing and other studies on unwitting human subjects.

Department of Indian Affairs of Canada- About 600 Native children from the reserves near Qu'Appelle, Saskatchewan, were enrolled in a trial to test the tuberculosis vaccine. During the course of the trial, in both the control and treatment groups nearly a fifth "died from diseases of poverty, gastroenteritis and pneumonia, as a result of the lethal living conditions on the reserves." Parental consent was not sought for indigenous children, though it was sought for the non-indigenous.

Between 1942 and 1952, malnourished children from six residential schools were used in experiments without consent or parental notification. They were split into treatment and control groups and denied increases in nutrition, despite the researchers believing malnutrition to be a serious problem in the

schools, as they were used to determine whether certain combinations of supplements mitigated problems. Children died, developed anaemia, and were in some cases denied dental care previously available to them as they developed cavities and gingivitis.

Department of Physics, State Instrument Engineering College of Moscow-Naumov, E.K., Valus, N. A.

Department of Military Intelligence, Syria, (Shu`bat al-Mukhabarat al-'Askariyya)- Torture. Damascus as well as regional, city, and local branches across the country.

Department of Psycho Correction -At the Moscow Medical Academy. acoustic psycho correction. transmission of specific commands via static or white noise.

Department of Psychology, Moscow State University- Konovalov, V.F., Krinch1k, E.P., Luria, A. R., Tikhomirov, O.K., Vasilyeva, V.M., Voronin, L.G.

Depo-Provera -Was clinically tested on Zimbabwean women. Once approved, the drug was used as a population control measure in the 1970s. Commercial farm owners put pressure on native women workers to accept the use of Depo-Provera. Population control interests motivated many of the family planning programs. This led to its eventual ban in Zimbabwe.

Deseret Test Center- A U.S. Army operated command in charge of testing chemical and biological weapons. The Deseret was headquartered at Fort Douglas, Utah. No tests were actually conducted at Deseret Test Center however, the Deseret administration facility was supported by Dugway Proving Ground about 80 miles (130 km) away. This testing, which took place aboard ships and on land in various locations from 1962 to 1974.

Fort Detrick, Fredrick, Maryland- Fort Detrick, Maryland, that ran from 1953 to 1970. The project involved, 'developing, testing, and maintaining biological agents and delivery systems for use against humans as well as against animals and crops.' MK-NAOMI received CIA funding through MK-ULTRA Subprojects 13, 30 and 50. Unit 731 exchanged data from their biological experiments with the U.S. for immunity from war crimes. Dr. Sanders, an esteemed microbiologist, described the information as "extremely helpful" and "obtained at a relatively low cost". Technology created by the Japanese was incorporated in bioweapon facilities such as Fort Detrick.

2,300 Seventh Day Adventist draftees who volunteered in lieu of active duty on the battlefield. They were subjected to 157 experiments testing deadly pathogens and disease-causing agents, and experimental vaccine safety trials. Among the diseases studied: Q fever, yellow fever, encephalitis, plague, tularemia, and others. The purpose was to determine their use as biological weapons and to gain knowledge about effective protective interventions. Division of Clinical Biophysics, Medical Institute, Riga- Portnov, F.

Dixon Institution for the Retarded, Illinois- Dysentery projects funded by the CMR.

Donetsk Medical Institute- Komissarov, I.V., Talaloyenko, A.N.

Dow Chemical Company- Dow Chemical wanted to study the health effects of dioxin and other herbicides, to discover how they affect human skin, because workers at its chemical plants were developing chloracne. University of Pennsylvania under contract with Dow Chemical.

Dugway Proving Ground- Utah-project designated as MKCHICK. Dugway was involved in testing dangerous biological and chemical agents on military personnel in exercises on land and at sea. A chemical-biological test centre where hundreds of former workers have contracted Gulf-War like symptoms.

Dugway Proving Ground nerve agent tests in the 1960's, and the most recent controversy over the use of investigational drugs such as pyridostigmine bromide and botulinum toxoid on troops in the Gulf War.

Duke University- Duke researchers J.B. Rhine and William McDougall made that university the second in the nation to officially enter into paranormal research when, after an exceptionally fascinating lecture by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle on the possibility of communication with the dead, the men formed the Parapsychology Laboratory as part of the university's main psychology department. Laboratory research focused mainly on the critical study of extrasensory perception (ESP) and psychokinesis (PK).

Dunedin Prison -Prisoners would undergo deep sleep or narcosis therapy in an especially locked-down unit of the villa. The prisoners were to be taken to Cherry Farm Hospital for this controversial treatment.

Duplessis Orphans -E ndure forced lobotomies, electroshock, straitjackets, experimental psychiatric drugs, and physical, sexual, psychological, and emotional abuse. Some children are sent out to work with farmers, while other children do the maintenance and janitorial work that enable the orphanages to function. They are treated as slave labour and receive harsh discipline if they refuse orders. Duplessis Orphans, a group of more than 5,000 children whose parents handed them over to Catholic orphanages during the 1940s, 1950s and 1960s, promised their children would receive a "good education."

Durov Institute- Clandestine psi.

E

Eastern Michigan University (Dept, of Sociology)- Psychoenergetic research.

Edgewood Arsenal -Facility in Maryland. From 1948 to 1975, the U.S. Army Chemical Corps conducted classified human subject research at the Edgewood

Arsenal facility in Maryland. The purpose was to evaluate the impact of low-dose chemical warfare agents on military personnel and to test protective clothing, pharmaceuticals, and vaccines. A small portion of these studies were directed at psychochemical warfare and grouped under the prosaic title of the "Medical Research Volunteer Program" (1956–1975). The MRVP was also driven by intelligence requirements and the need for new and more effective interrogation techniques. MKOFTEN

The experiments involved at least 254 chemical substances, but focused mainly on mid spectrum incapacitants, such as LSD, THC derivatives, benzodiazepines, and BZ. Around 7,000 US military personnel and 1,000 civilians were test subjects over almost three decades. A concrete result of these experiments was that BZ was weaponized, although never deployed.

Edgewood Arsenal Research Laboratories undertook a program for doing research on the identification and characterization of drugs that could influence human behaviour. Edgewood had the facilities for the Lull range of laboratory and clinical testing. A phased program was envisioned that would consist of acquisition-of-drugs and chemical compounds believed to have effects on the behaviour of humans, and testing and evaluating these materials through laboratory procedures and toxicological studies. Compounds believed promising as a result of tests on animals were then to be evaluated clinically with human - - subjects at Edgewood.

Edsel Fund- CIA funding front.

El Centro, CA- Chemical Weapons Testing Sites Human Subjects.

Electronic Magnetic Logistical Component- South African Defence Force front company.

Electronics Research and Development Command (ERADCOM)- The commanding officer of INSCOM.

Eli Lilly Pharmaceuticals- Location: Indianapolis, Indiana Years: 1953-1955. Develop reliable source of LSD within the United States and assist in the search for additional natural hypnotic products. Previously the supplier, Sandoz, based in Switzerland.

Elite LLC, subsidiary of Star Group Finance & Holdings, Inc.- CIA prison in Antaviliai, neighbourhood of Vilnius, capital of Lithuania. It is believed that the Antaviliai facility is referred to as Detention Site Violet. In 2007, the site became property of the State Security Department of Lithuania and is used as a training facility.

Elgin State Hospital, Elgin IL- Patients were injected with radium. Emory University, Atlanta, Georgia -Dr. Carl Pfeiffer of Emory University, a pioneer in "orthomolecular psychiatry." In the 1970s, it was revealed that Pfeiffer was also one of the scientists who conducted secret research with LSD for the CIA's MK-ULTRA project.

Geneticists Li Xiao-Jiang and Li Shihua. The two researchers, who are married to each other, are Chinese Americans who have both worked at Emory for more than 2 decades, according to biographical information posted online. Both are U.S. citizens. They have been involved in efforts to use CRISPR gene editing.

Emerson College- LSD in experiments secretly financed by the Central Intelligence Agency.

Engadine Medical Centre (Australia)- Petrauskas.

Engineer District Hospital, Oak Ridge TN- Human radiation experiments. Eniwetok Atoll- During 1956, the US Air Force sent manned planes through radiation clouds from atomic bomb tests in the Pacific to measure radiation doses in the clouds and to the crew.

Environmental Research Institute of Michigan (ERIM)-Reputed for its classified discoveries in the areas of remote sensing, radio-electronics and holographic imaging.

E.R. Squibb Company- Hypo-spray instrument. Artichoke.

Esalen Institute in Big Sur, California- Joe K. Adams and Dell Carson led an early conference on psychic phenomena. (Anderson, pg 59). In their first seminar on Human Potentiality, led by Willis Harman, every program leader was involved with LSD research: Adams, Harman, Gregory Bateson, Gerald Heard, Paul Kurtz, and Myron Stolaroff.

Other drug-culture luminaries, such as Timothy Leary and Richard Alpert, taught at Esalen, and various psychedelics were used by the staff and students, although drug-use was not officially endorsed.

Eugenics Research Association- Frederick H. Osborn

Executive Outcomes- South African Defence Force front company.

F

Facebook- Breached ethical guidelines by conducting a research experiment to manipulate 700,000 users' emotions without their consent.

Fait Richardson, **AK-** Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects. **Farfield Foundation-** A now defunct CIA front, acted as a philanthropic foundation. The CIA used it as a vehicle for their covert funding of groups and persons that were believed to be effective weapons in a culture war against the Soviet Union during the Cold War.

FDA -December, 1990: issued a waiver from informed consent to permit the Department of Defense to use unapproved, experimental drugs and vaccines – e.g. anthrax vaccine on soldiers.

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) -Setting forth that use of microwave radiation on terrorists could kill them, stun them or at least modify their behaviour by changing their "perceptions."

Federal Reformatory, El Reno, Okla -START program.

Feed Material Production Center (FMPC) -Located on a 1,050 acre complex near rural Fernald, Ohio. The FMPC was a U.S. government facility operated by private contractors

under the supervision of the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission and later the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), and was part of the US Department of Energy (DOE) nuclear weapons production complex. National Lead of Ohio Inc. was the main contractor, and operated the plant from 1951 until December 31, 1985. Releases from the site resulted in exposure to ionising radiation, especially radon, soluble and insoluble

forms of uranium, and various other organic and inorganic chemicals.

Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory- A facility owned by the Department of Energy. and is funded by the National Cancer Institute.

Fernald School in Massachusetts- Walter E. Fernald. Fernald was a proud advanta of the eugenics movement, believing that the best way to improve

advocate of the eugenics movement, believing that the best way to improve society and the general human race was to separate unwanted and inferior people so they could not breed. Fernald began taking in perfectly capable patients who were simply poor or unwanted. It has been estimated as many as half of Fernald's patients were of normal intelligence.

Fernald School in Massachusetts performed medical experiments on children involving nuclear radiation. Neither the children nor parents were informed that researchers were quietly slipping radioactive material into the breakfast and milk of children under the care of the Fernald School. Dr. Clemens E. Benda.

In 1956, researchers gave mentally disabled children radioactive calcium orally and intravenously. They also injected radioactive chemicals into malnourished babies and then collected cerebrospinal fluid for analysis from their brains and spines.

Filatov Institute, Laboratory of the Physiology of Vision, Odessa-Shevalev, A.

Field Blood Transfusion Institute, China- Biotechnology processes to support Chinese military end uses and end users, to include purported braincontrol weaponry.

Fitzsimons Army Hospital In Denver- Conscientious objectors who were taking part in experiments which required them to eat foods that had been exposed to cobalt radiation. Assessed by doctors at Fitzsimons and the University of Colorado)

University of Florida- Human adaptation to disaster: response to stress and crisis. Results could increase sophistication of CIA's **Blacked out** mission.

University of Florida team is identifying which brain neural pathways VNS activates. The team also will conduct behavioural studies in rats to determine the impact of VNS on perception, executive function, decision-making and spatial navigation.

Another University of Florida team will combine fluorescent imaging and optogenetics to test neural circuity that connects centres in the deep brain to decision-making regions in the prefrontal cortex, and optimise VNS parameters in this circuitry. (DARPA/TNT)

In 2000, noncompliance letters were sent related to research that used prisoners as test subjects. Noncompliance issues included placebo studies on prisoners, lack of a prisoner representative on the IRB, discrepancies in the subjects' compensation, inadequate provisions for follow-up care, lack of certifications for the research, and conflicts of interest among serving members of the IRB.

Florida University- MK-ULTRA Subproject 126: Human adaptation to disaster: response to stress and crisis. Results could increase sophistication of CIA's mission.

Folsom State Prison in California- A prisoner alleged that his constitutional right to be free from cruel and unusual punishment had been violated when he was given succinylcholine (a drug which causes temporary paralysis and inability to breathe.

Ford Foundation -B ankrolled an Esalen experimental program using group-sensitivity techniques on grammar school children in public schools all over California. The findings of that several-year-Long study, published by George Brown in a book, Human Teaching for Human Learning, noted that children responded particularly well to some of the role-playing techniques which, after all, were very similar to many children's games. Brown felt the need to include a chapter, "Proceed with Caution," warning that the introduction of group-sensitivity methods to the classroom proves to be more successful in destroying pre-existing values and learning than in replacing the abandoned values and knowledge with anything positive.

Fort Benning, Georgia -Personnel from Edgewood Arsenal conducted field testing of LSD at Fort Benning (1960).

Fort Bragg- 1990, the Army created the Civil Affairs and Psychological Operations Command at Fort Bragg. Commanded by a USAR 3 1 brigadier general and staffed primarily by reserve component personnel on varying periods of active duty, this headquarters of 146 personnel (later reduced to 80) serves all active and reserve component Army civil affairs and psychological operations units. This new organisation reports to the US Army Special Operations Command (USASOC) at Fort Bragg.

Fort McClellan, AL- U. S. Army Training Command Chemical Center. Human chemical experiments.

Fort Pierce, FL- Chemical Weapons Testing Site Using Human Subjects. Falt Richardson, AK- Chemical Weapons Testing Site Using Human Subjects.

Foster D. Snell -A consulting firm, carried out experiments for the U.S. Army by placing "synthetic" radioactive soil on the hands of about 118 subjects, and measuring the ability of different cleaning agents to remove the contamination. Foundations Fund for Research in Psychiatry, Inc.- A front for the CIA. Louis Jolyon ("Jolly") West. Before West had conducted a similar project in Oklahoma City to infiltrate teenage gangs for the purpose of changing their members' behaviour. Labelled "Mass Conversion", this project was funded by Sidney Gottlieb.

Foundation for Research on the Nature of Man (FRNM), Durham, NC-Psychoenergetic research.

Fred Hutchinson Cancer Center in Seattle- Cancer patients were not informed about the risks nor that effective alternative treatments were available. The experiment proved almost uniformly fatal: at least 20 patients in the trial at the Hutch died. Furthermore, of the 82 people around the world who were enrolled in the experiment, 80 were dead by 1998. The protocol underwent 9 separate phase II studies that incrementally altered the subject entry criteria to ever sicker patients and increased the dose of post-transplant interventions. As the intervention dose increased, the death rate increased. Fulbright Scholarship Program- CIA used to insert its agents or contractors.

G

Gamal's Institute- Institute Of Bioengineering. torsion generators have been tested. As a part of these experiments various virological, biological, medical and agricultural works were carried out. The objects of these experiments were microorganisms, mice, plants, and even medical works with patients.

General Dynamics- High-power microwave testing facility.

General Electric- General Electric ran the Hanford Nuclear Reservation in Richland, Washington as part of the U.S. weapons program.

Experiments were performed on inmates at a prison in Walla Walla, Washington, near Hanford. Starting in 1963, 64 prisoners had their scrotums and testes irradiated to determine the effects of radiation on human reproductive organs.

General Intelligence Directorate, Syria (Idarat al-Mukhabarat al-'Amma)- Torture. Damascus as well as regional, city, and local branches across the country. General Intelligence Directorate includes Interior Security branch 251. George Washington University- MK-ULTRA Subproject 129:Computer analysis of bioelectric response pattern significance for polygraph. George Washington University, performed several literature surveys for the program under a personal services contract. (Project OFTEN)

Georgetown University Hospital, Washington DC- Years: 1955 To further Technical Services Division's chemical and biological requirements, a single, non-recurring grant (\$375,000)was made to Georgetown Hospital for a new Research Wing (the Gorman building). The arrangement would name it

non-recurring grant (\$375,000)was made to Georgetown Hospital for a new Research Wing (the Gorman building). The arrangement would permit Agency-sponsored research projects, using Agency personnel, to be carried out in the new wing without being aware of CIA interest. subproject 35: MK-ULTRA: Georgetown Hospital: Geschichter.

Geschickter Fund for Medical Research- A CIA front named for Dr. Joseph F. Geschickter, a prominent Washington pathologist and cancer researcher who taught at Georgetown. Involved in 49 sub-projects. Mx. Carl Pfeiffer, a pharmacologist now associated with a private treatment centre in New Jersey, conducted LSD experiments for the C.I.A. on prisoners at the Federal penitentiary in Atlanta and the Bordentown Reformatory in New Jersey between 1955 and 1964. He was paid \$25,000 a year through the Geschickter Foundation.

University of Glasgow's politics department- For the school year 2002/3. Richard Mansbach of Iowa State University applied for an academic swap within the University of Glasgow's politics department for the school year 2002/3. The University was unaware of Mansbach's involvement in a defamatory college scandal back in 1984. Though having left US intelligence in 1983, tensions with the Soviet Union intensified and the US was deploying Pershing II and cruise missiles in western Europe. Subsequently, Mansbach was asked by the CIA to form a secret research team to monitor European non-state actors. And who did he recruit? That's right, his undergraduate class. In exchange for academic credit, these students would produce data-intensive reports for Mansbach, completely oblivious to the fact they were covert CIA workers.

God's Lake Mine, Canada- Nutritional experiments were conducted between 1942 and 1952 using Indigenous children from residential schools.

Gotham Foundation- CIA funding front.

Gordon Residential School in Saskatchewan- Closed its doors in 1996. Muskowekwan First Nation, Canada-They had found 35 unmarked graves at the site of its former residential school, the last residential school in Saskatchewan to shut down.

Greater Boston Radiation Research Complex- The Greater Boston area houses a number of independent, but related, institutions which played central

roles in radiation research (and, of course, research in general) during the Cold War. Some of the experiments conducted were at the FernaldSchool.

Fort Greely -Chemical and biological warfare and drug testing.

Grey Nuns of Montreal- The building we now call Grey Nuns was host to countless atrocities perpetrated upon wards of the state settled there. Hundreds of thousands of children were physically and sexually abused, purposefully misdiagnosed with mental disabilities, and tortured for financial gain. These children became known as the Duplessis Orphans.

Grupo Rosarino de Estudios Psicologicos (GREP), Argentina- Remote Sensing

The Guangzhou Epidemic Prevention and Water Purification Department of South China Army/ Unit 8604- Japan.

Guatemala's National Mental Health Hospital- From 1946 to 1948 U.S. scientific researchers in Guatemala infected hundreds of mental patients with sexually transmitted diseases (STD). Researchers from the U.S. Public Health Service (PHS) conducted experiments on approximately 1,500 male and female patients. The scientists injected the patients with gonorrhoea and syphilis—and encouraged many of them to pass the disease on to others. The experiments were done in cooperation with the Guatemalan government. Gulfport, MS- Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects. Gustavo Machin hospital in Santiago de Cuba- Prisoners end up in the forensic ward of mental hospitals in Santiago de Cuba and Havana where they undergo ill-treatment including electroconvulsive therapy without muscle relaxants or anaesthesia.

H

Haight Ashbury Free Medical Clinic- To recruit subjects for his LSD research he started the Haight-Ashbury Project (HAP) in June 1967. Located on Frederick Street, it was, in his own words, a "laboratory disguised as a hippie crash pad", where he had six graduate students dressed up as hippies examine the behaviour of actual hippies. To promote HAP, he also took an office at the Haight-Ashbury Free Medical Clinic (HAFMC)

Hanford Nuclear Facility, Richmond, Washington- General Electric ran the Hanford Nuclear Reservation in Richland, Washington as part of the U.S. weapons program. Beginning in 1949, General Electric deliberately released radioactive material to see how far downwind it would travel. One cloud drifted 400 miles.

General Electric officials in conjunction with representatives from the Department of Defense and the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) unleashed

the largest single known incident of intentional radioactive contamination at the Hanford site. Known as the "Green Run," this fuel processing experiment utilised raw, irradiated uranium fuel elements cooled for only sixteen days only before dissolving in acid.

Radioactive promethium was administered to 14 subjects by injection or drinking. These experiments were designed to measure the passage of this substance through the body and the ability of a drug (chelating agents) to increase the removal of promethium.

Hanford Environmental Health Foundation- 6 subjects were injected with promethium and observed for retention. 2 subjects drank orange juice with promethium in solution. 6 Subjects were injected with promethium and then injected with the chelating agent diethylenetriaminepentaacetate (DTPA), and the ability of DTPA to remove promethium from the body was examined. These experiments were funded by the Atomic Energy Commission Harry Diamond Laboratories (HDL)- In 1972, Jack Anderson reported that HDL was working on "short-time-span control of human behaviour", which Anderson characterised as "Experiments to control human behaviour with science fiction devices". An Army spokesman responded that the research program was looking at alternative ways for crowd control.

Harper Hospital in Detroit -O rally administered iodine-131 to 65 premature and full-term infants who weighed from 2.1 to 5.5 pounds (0.95 to 2.49 kg). Hart's Island in New York City -Tests of liquid mustard agent on men's forearms. Civilian researchers used U.S. sailors who were imprisoned at Hart's Island.

Harvard University- Martin Orne-Study of the induction of high motivation in individuals by means of specific interpersonal relationships. Further to establish the limits of usefulness of hypnosis. Ultimate aim was improvement of agent assessment techniques. Harvard University (Henry Beecher)

Genetic experiments conducted by Harvard University in rural China. Harvard and Massachusetts General Hospital- Henry Beecher Harwell Laboratory, UK- Volunteer subjects were administered radionuclides at Harwell Laboratory (United Kingdom) and were whole-body or chest counted at the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory and at other Department of Energy contractor in vivo counting facilities in the United States. Two subjects were from Lawrence Livermore Laboratory and the remainder were from the United Kingdom.

This study was broad in scope and spanned several years. From 1972 to 1976, three males inhaled palladium-103 and chromium-51B labelled microspheres and were counted in 14 labs in Europe and the United States. From 1979 to 1985, 19 men and women inhaled niobium-92m (Nb92m)B labelled microspheres and were counted at several labs. During the 1986 to 1988 period, two males were injected with barium-133; one of the two was

also injected with strontium-85. During the 1988 to 1990 period, eight males (including five who earlier had inhaled Nb92m) were exposed to Nb92m and counted.

University of Helsinki, Finland- Study of the interaction between the mentally disturbed and their environment. To gain further insight into additional factors which may influence human behaviour and to achieve further development of the world-wide activities of the Human Ecology fund.

Hennepin County Medical Center- Paramedics responding to medical emergencies injected agitated people with either ketamine or another sedative to determine which drug worked fastest. Patients were only notified afterwards that they had received a sedative. Minneapolis, Minnesota, between 2014 and June 2018.

Veterans Administration Hospital, Hines, IL -Cesium-137, Brookhaven National Laboratory.

The H. J. Rand Foundation -Of Cleveland, Ohio agreed to act in the capacity of a "cut-out" for the purpose of funding organisations engaged in very sensitive research.

Hoffman-La Roche- MK-Ultra, BZ (3-quinuclidinyl benzilate). The U.S. Army began experimenting with BZ and its effects at the Edgewood Arsenal in Maryland in the 1950s.

Holmesburg Prison, Holmesburg, PA -Prisoners are subjected to dioxin, the highly toxic chemical component of Agent Orange used in Viet Nam. The men are later studied for the development of cancer. MKOFTEN.

A total of 33 pharmaceutical companies tested 153 experimental drugs at Holmesburg prison (PA) The people experimented on at Holmesburg Prison were subjected to practically every form of experimentation. Mindaltering drugs, cosmetics, viruses, and chemical warfare were all on the table when it came to human experimentation.

Honeywell, Inc. -F or "A method to penetrate inside a man's mind and control his brain waves over long distance."

Horn Island, Mississippi- Effects of psychochemical agents.

Houston University- MK-ULTRA Subproject 143: To determine if the growth of microorganisms in petroleum products can be markedly increased by the addition of substatic concentrations of antimicrobial agents. May have wide application to all areas of biological sabotage.

HRL- California-based science and engineering lab. An experiment funded by the U.S. military meant to sharpen soldiers' minds for the battlefield has found a way to improve memory: by zapping subjects' brains with tiny bursts of electricity during sleep. DARPA-funded research 2019.

Human-Computer Interaction Group of the Department of Computer Science at the University of Hamburg- Virtual reality.

Human Betterment Foundation -An organisation dedicated to improving the human race by encouraging those who were considered to be intellectually superior to reproduce while mandating compulsory sterilisation for those considered feebleminded. Promoted forced sterilisation in California and reportedly influenced the Nazi eugenics program. Terman, Goddard and Yerkes.

Human Betterment League- An organisation that pushed for eugenic sterilisation in North Carolina. In 1948, several philanthropists, including Procter & Gamble heir Dr. Clarence Gamble and hosiery magnate James G. Hanes, cofounded.

The Human Ecology Fund- To support an editorial and technical survey of graphology, ESP, subliminal perception, hypnosis, truth serums, expressive movements and magic. Graphology Journal and Cover. MK-ULTRA Subproject 134: Study of relationships between body type and temperament (personality characteristics) for the purpose of clandestine indirect assessment.

In 1961, the SIHE changed its name to the Human Ecology Fund, Inc, (HEF) and was reorganised. It established itself in Cornell University's Medical School, with James L Monroe as its executive director - a man that oversaw a study for the Air Force, on Korean War prisoners.

Human Potential Foundation- C.B. Scott Jones, President of the Human Potential Foundation. Worked with Dr. Igor Smirnov.

Human Social Science Research Capability (HSSRC) -Programme, involved the "targeted manipulation of information in the virtual and physical domains to shape attitudes and beliefs in the cognitive domain."

Hungarians -Presented a state-of-the-art paper on infrasonic weapons to the United Nations, "Working Paper on Infrasound Weapons", United Nations CD/575, 14 Aug 1978.

Hunter College in New York- Walter Weiss.

Huntsville Prison- The acid tests' goal was to find out what part of the brain was activated by LSD—so that, perhaps, the part of the brain "where mental illness resided" could be found, and, presumably, rooted out.

Hyanghari, **North Korea**- Political prison camp outside the city. They use anthrax bacterium as well as 40 different types of chemical weapons that the regime has developed itself.

Idaho Division of the Atomic Energy Commission- 8 individuals were involved in 13

different human experiments. All eight were employees. In four experiments subjects inhaled Argon-41; in nine experiments, subjects swallowed capsules containing microcurie amounts of radioactivity. These experiments were funded and carried out by the Atomic Energy Commission.

Idaho National Engineering Laboratory- Two human radiation experiments. Approximately 39 volunteers were involved in the two experiments. The volunteers in both experiments were employees of the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission.

I. G. Farben Industrial Complex- European Rockefeller Foundation official Daniel O'Brian wrote to the foundation's chief medical officer Alan Gregg that "it would be unfortunate if it was chosen to stop research which has no relation to war issues." The "non-war- related" research continued. The Rockefeller Foundation defends its record by claiming that its funding of Nazi German programs during World War II was limited to psychiatric research. IIE -Financed Fulbright scholarships into Australia and theInstitute was founded by Elihu Root (a founder of the Council on Foreign Relations, cofounder of the Carnegie Endowment and a member of the Pilgrim's Society) and Stephen P. Duggan who was also a member of the CFR and known as the "apostle of internationalism". USEFA was based at Huxley's Australian National University during the main years of imported CIA operations. Illinois University - University of Chicago Medical School professor Dr. Alf Alving infects psychotic patients at Illinois State Hospital with the disease through blood transfusions and then experiments with malaria cures on them (Sharav).

University of Illinois Years: 1954 -1955. Study various depressant drugs which may more adequately control the maniacal psychotic patient, and test drugs that may help alcoholics and schizophrenics. Geschickter Fund

Integrated Scientific Microwave Technology, Malaysia- Biotechnology Intermountain Indian School, Brigham City, Utah -1969-1971; The study compared the efficacy of oral triple sulfa, tetracycline, and doxycycline as treatments, and also involved giving a placebo to some Native children with trachoma. The studies lasted 4-5 months each, and children who received placebos were treated with medication at the end of each study. Because trachoma was considered "mild" by those conducting this research, they did not view the delay in treatment of those students receiving the placebo as harmful to the children, despite the discomfort experienced by those afflicted with the disease.

International Academy Of Energy Science (MAEN) (Russia)-F.R. Hantseverov (Ф.Р. Ханцеверов).

International Association For Cultural Freedom- Shepard Stone International Federation for Internal Freedom Psychedelic Training Center in Zihuatenejo . Zihuatenejo . an isolated Mexican resort town. was the site for a two-year project involving 500 people - chosen. according to Leary. out of over 5.000 applicants. The objective of Zihuatenejo was to train psychologists and other professionals. religious leaders. teachers. etc. in the values of psychedelic drug use. The centre administered LSD to residents several times a week. conducting group sessions based on the Boston work of Leary and Alpert.

International Foundation for Advanced Study (IFAS)- Founded by Myron Stolaroff and Paul Kurtz, and located in Menlo Park, California. Studied the effects of LSD and mescaline from 1961 to 1965. involved with the IFAS were Alfred Hubbard, Vice President Willis Harman, Charles Savage, Robert

Mogar, James Fadiman, and Ethel Savage; with Hubbard reportedly supplying the drugs (then legal for research).

International Society of Hypnosis (ISH)- Ernest Hilgard, Martin Orne, Ainsley Meares, Josephine Hilgard, Kay Thompson, Herbert Spiegel, John Hartland, Per-Olaf Wikstrom, P. Brugnoli, and Erika Fromm.

Intensive Program Center near Marquette, Michigan -Subjects the prisoner to a "positive" behaviour program similar to the federal Standard Treatment and Rehabilitation Training program (START).4 7 This program begins with solitary confinement and allows inmates to "earn" better living conditions by their behaviour.

Ionia State Hospital for the Criminally Insane, Michigan- To exploit the research potential represented by a group of 142 criminal-sexual psychopaths confined at the Ionic State Hospital. The Agency believed that patients had the same kind of motivation for withholding certain information that is comparable to operational interrogation situations in the field.

Ionia State Hospital- Subproject 39: MK-ULTRA-Ionia State Hospital was the site of MK-ULTRA Subproject 39, in which investigators cleared at TOP SECRET received \$30,000.00 in 1955 for drug testing on prisoners and sexual psychopaths including interrogation with hypnosis, LSD and marijuana. Iowa Asylum for Feeble Minded Children- Originally the Glenwood branch of the Iowa Soldiers Orphans Home, the Iowa Asylum for Feeble Minded Children was the first facility in the state of Iowa to provide care and instruction for persons with physical and mental handicaps. Officially opening on September 1, 1876, under the leadership of Dr. O.W. Archibald the facility, now called the Glenwood Resource Center, had at its height over 2,000 residents and employees living on its campus, which has grown to over 200 acres from the original fifteen. The Asylum at Glenwood has been plagued with incidents of abuse and neglect throughout its history, even holding a man, Mayo Hazeltine Buckner, for 59 years despite his having a genius level IQ of 120. In more recent years the Asylum has moved away from the dormitory style housing of the past and the residents now enjoy a more traditional family style living environment. As of 2017 the resident population of the Glenwood Resource Center numbered 230.

Iowa Prison System- U sed "aversive" drugs, on a smaller principle; to associate an unpleasant sensation with behaviour that is deemed unacceptable. involved a drug called apomorphine that was injected without consent into inmates who violated prison behaviour rules.

Iowa Security Medical Facility- Apomorphine, The drug was administered as an "aversive therapy" for infractions such as "not getting up, for giving cigarettes against order, for talking, for swearing, or for lying."44 The drug had the effect of inducing vomiting which lasted from fifteen minutes to an hour.4 5 It also produced temporary alterations in blood pressure and the heart.

Iowa Soldiers' Orphans' Home- Twenty-two children Davenport were the subjects of the "monster" experiment that used psychological pressure to induce children who spoke normally to stutter. It was designed by one of the nation's most prominent speech pathologists, Dr. Wendell Johnson, to test his theory on the cause of stuttering.

University of Iowa- Wendell Johnson. the health effects of radioactive iodine in newborns and pregnant women. In one study, researchers gave pregnant women between 100 to 200 microcuries (3.7 to 7.4 MBq) of iodine-131, to study the women's aborted embryos in an attempt to discover at what stage, and to what extent, radioactive iodine crosses the placental barrier. In another study, they gave 25 newborn babies (who were under 36 hours old and weighed from 5.5 to 8.5 pounds (2.5 to 3.9 kg)) iodine-131, either by oral administration or through an injection, so that they could measure the amount of iodine in their thyroid glands,.

The Farm 'istra'- As a part of these experiments various virological, biological, medical and agricultural works were carried out. The objects of these experiments were microorganisms, mice, plants, and even medical work with patients.

Ithaca, New York- MK-ULTRA Subproject 61: Study the role of the human brain in overall adaptive behaviour. Specifically, the relationship of changes in behaviour due to stress to changes in behaviour brought about by loss of cerebral tissues.

U.S. Regional Medical Center at Naples, Italy- N aval psychologist Lt. Comdr. Thomas Narut. the navy's part in programming assassins. Ivanovo-Frankovsk Medical Institute- Lazarovich, V.G.

Jerry L. Pettis Memorial Veterans Hospital Loma Linda, CA- "It looks as though instead of taking a valium when you want to relax yourself it would be possible to achieve a similar result, probably in a safer way, by the use of a radio field that will relax you." A Soviet device that bombards brains with low-frequency radio waves may be a replacement for tranquillisers and their unwanted side effects.

Jeugkrag -Was a short-lived South African youth group, surreptitiously funded by the apartheid government's department of Military Intelligence in an operation known as Project Essay.

Jewish Chronic Disease Hospital, New York- Researchers injected cancer cells into 19 old and debilitated patients to see if their bodies would reject them. (The doctors claimed to have obtained oral consent, but it was

discovered that many of the patients in question were deaf, spoke only Yiddish, or were senile.)

Johns Hopkins University- Further research on harassment techniques. This project was to investigate HyperAllergic (allergy-inducing) substances and to provide Technical Services Division with small quantities of these substances. It was to support Technical Services Division's "requirement to establish an offensive chemical toxicants capability."

750 Guatemalan victims of a US-Government-sponsored experiment to infect them with syphilis and other sexually transmitted diseases.

Johns Hopkins University-Maryland team focuses on brain regions involved in speech and hearing to understand plasticity's effects on language learning. The team will compare the effectiveness of invasive versus non-invasive VNS, testing volunteers' ability to discriminate phonemes -- sounds that distinguish one word from another -- learn words and grammar, and produce unique sounds used in some foreign languages. (DARPA/TNT)

On May 4, 2001, a 24 year old healthy female employee at Johns Hopkins Asthma and Allergy Center inhaled hexamethonium as a volunteer in a research study.

Johnson & Johnson- Holmesburg Prison experiments.

Josiah Macy Jr. Foundation- CIA front group. The Josiah Macy Foundation appears to have been a Tavistock research outpost in America since its inception. During World War II, this collaboration became extensive, and included studies on how one causes public panics, and on how to covertly disperse chemical and biological agents. Working with the CIA and with the British MI6, the Macy Foundation became one of the primary covert funding conduits for a MK-Ultra. Dr. Harold Abramson, LSD research was funnelled through two other CIA cutouts: the Geschickter Fund for Medical Research and the Josiah Macy Jr. Foundation.

Directed by former Black Chamber and military intelligence chief Gen. Marlborough Churchill. The Macy group would manage London's most advanced experiments in mind-control and social engineering.

J. P. Morgan and Co. of New York -Financed an expedition, headed by Gordon Wasson for the purpose of studying and collecting hallucinogenic species of mushrooms of interest to TSS/CD. Subproject 58: MK-ULTRA

Kaiser Wilhelm Institute for Psychiatry- Rockefeller Foundation provided funds to construct the Kaiser Wilhelm Institute for Anthropology, Human Heredity, and Eugenics in Berlin. On arrival at Mengele's experimental station,

twins filled out "a detailed questionnaire from the Kaiser Wilhelm Institute." There were daily drawings of blood for Verschuer's "specific protein" research. Needles were injected into eyes for work on eye colour. There were experimental blood transfusions and experimental infections. Organs and limbs were removed, sometimes without anaesthetics. Sex changes were attempted. Females were sterilised, males were castrated. Thousands were murdered, and their organs, eyeballs, heads, and limbs were sent to Verschuer and the Rockefeller group at the Kaiser Wilhelm Institute.

Kamloops Indian Residential School- The discovery of 215 unmarked graves in 2021.

Kansas City Jail- Clinical trials of new drugs for malaria. Kaplan Fund -A CIA front from 1959 to 1964. Margaret Mead Karaganda Medical Institute's Department of Psychiatry- A.M, Syvadoshch

Karolinska University Hospital, Sweden- T ritium and carbon-14. (Brookhaven National Laboratory)

Kazakh State University at Alma-ata- "Bio-plasma"-have found that illnesses tend to show up in advance as a disordered play of flares from the "bio-plasma" long before they manifest in the physical body. Gibadulin, F., Grishchinko, V., Inyushin, V., Shouiski, N., Vorobev, N.

Kentfield Fund- CIA funding front.

University of Kentucky-N arcotics Farms, Narco-Hypnosis. Subproject 73: MK-ULTRA

Kiev -One of the main centres of instrumental psychotronics.

Kingsley Hall- Aspects of the experiment was that they used LSD, a psychedelic drug, to (apparently) facilitate certain mental experiences. R. D. Laing

Kirkland AFB- Ron Blackburn, former microwave scientist and specialist. The event was the second experiment executed at the DMOC and focused on building and capturing tactics, techniques, and procedures, or TTPs, of the USAFE inspired Agile Control Integration Team while concentrating on integrating additional TOC-L mission sets.

Kirov Military-Medical Academy in Leningrad- Psychophysiological research in connection with ergonometric questions, and only peripherally have something to do with parapsychology. the effect of coloured illumination. The relationship between aggressiveness and colour type is of interest especially since the work comes from a known military establishment

Fort Knox- Support for field experiments on mental practice, a renewed interest in stress-reduction procedures, including meditation; a reduced interest in programs designed to train officers to use neurolinguistic programming and hemispheric synchronisation; and a decision to discourage applications of parapsychological techniques.

Kobe Medical School- A large number of infants and forcibly administered sugar by having needles inserted through their noses and into their stomachs. A tube was inserted into their anuses to determine how the sugar was processed by their digestive systems. Many of the infants experienced diarrhoea and anal bleeding. The parents were never informed that their children were being used as test subjects.

Kopeisk Prison, Ural Mountains, Russia- Torture prision. Much of the abuse was committed by prisoners forced to beat their fellow inmates.

Kuper Island residential school - The federal government shutdown the school in 1975. The Penelakut Tribe in BC said they had located 160 unmarked graves. (2021)

Laboratories of Experimental Neuropsychology Veterans Administration Hospital

Kansas City, Missouri- Microwaves and Behavior.

Laboratory on Applying Isotopes in Ophthalmology in Moscow- research on the distant influence of living systems that produce random fluctuations. Some of their instruments have been able to register micro-PK effects. They have also carried out anomalous distant influence experiments involving a species of fish called Gnathonemus petersii. These fish are known for their ability to emit pulsed electric signals, which they use to assist navigation in the darkness. Psychics were asked to slow down the rate of the fishes' pulses – allegedly with much success.

Laboratory of Non-Traditional Treatment at IKIEM- T wo labs - IKIEM and a second one in Leningrad, now St Petersburg - 'took part in several successful ESP experiments.

Laboratory of Pharmacology of the Nervous System, Institute of Pharmacology, USSR Academy of Medical Sciences- Rayevskiy, K.S.. Zakusov, V.V,

Laboratory of Psychopharmacology, Bekhterev Scientific Research Psychoneurological Institute, Leningrad- Lapin, I.P.

Laboratory of Sensory Processes, Scientific Research Institute of Psychology, Moscow - Lomov, B.

Laboratory of Vision, Institute of Problems of Information Transmission of the USSR Academy of Science- Bongard, M., Smirnov, M.S. Lafayette Clinic- Psychiatric research facility, to attempt to treat uncontrollable violence in state hospital patients by one of two methods:

psychosurgery or an experimental drug imported from Germany. The goal was

to "cure" as many patients as possible of their violent tendencies and restore them to society.

LAIR- Experimental Psychology Group, who had moved from Fort Knox, Kentucky, to become the Division of NonIonizing Radiation in LAIR's Department of Biomedical Stress.

Lake Alice Psychiatric Hospital (New Zealand)- Children in the 1970s were tortured with electroshock, including to their genitals, and given injections of paraldehyde, a central nervous depressant as punishment. child and adolescent unit were routinely punished with unmodified ECT (ECT without anaesthesia). Laurel Children's Center in Maryland -Tested experimental acne medications on children. They continued their tests even after helf a fell.

medications on children. They continued their tests even after half of the children developed severe liver damage from the medications.

Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory- H uman subjects were placed within neutron and ion beams at accelerators. One objective of the experiments was to explore "visual sensations" in humans from exposure to ions.

Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory- In the South Bay, is working on the development of a "brain bomb." A bomb could be dropped in the middle of a battlefield which would produce microwaves, incapacitating the minds of soldiers within a circumscribed area.

Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, the impact of ozone on the human lungs was studied. The objective was to determine the functional changes that might result from low ozone levels in smog.

Four healthy, male subjects were exposed to 0.4 part per million by volume concentrations of nonradioactive ozone for a total of 2.5 hours. Periods of exercise and rest were alternated during the exposure. The subjects then inhaled small quantities of radioisotope labelled gas mixtures for the purpose of measuring lung function. The mixtures were similar to air, with an oxygento-nitrogen ratio of roughly 1 to 4; however, in the first mixture, a small amount of the nitrogen was a radioactive tracer, nitrogen-13. The second mixture contained a few percent of radioactive oxygen-15 Labelled carbon dioxide.

LEAA-Law Enforcement Assistance Administration -Funds for such things as neurological research and drug experimentation will have either to cease operations or to find other funding. In February of 1974, a spokesman for the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA) estimated that it had funded at least 400 behaviour modification programs, but at the same time admitted that the agency did not know exactly how many programs it had funded.

Fort Leavenworth- Colonel Frank Burns recruited and trained a Delta Team of psychics.

Department of Psychiatry at Leeds University- Max Hamilton, the professor of psychiatry there developer of the Hamilton Depression Rating Scale.

Leler University of Georgia- MK-ULTRA Subproject 129: Computer analysis of bioelectric response pattern significance for polygraph.

Lema -W as a "blue plan" front-company of the Civil Cooperation Bureau established in Johannesburg, South Africa with offices in Parktown by expoliceman Leon André Maree.

University of Leningrad- Laboratory for biocommunications. Major aspects of the work of this laboratory are to conduct research and to develop machines capable of monitoring, testing and studying telepathic communication. work has been done on the effects of strobe lights flashing at. a different rate for each eye. One rhythm for the left eye and another for the right eye brings on measurable brain wave patterns. Lights flickering at different rates on each eye cause a sensation of rotation and a very unpleasant feeling in the viewer.

Galunov, V.I., Gubinskiy, A. I., Livshits, V.A.

Lexington Kentucky public health service hospital- Dr. Harris Isbell. CIA drug testing program.

Lexington: Air Force -Alcohol: Amnesia: Animals: David Anthony:ARPA Lincoln Technical Institute- Sensorimotor Technology Realisation in Immersive Virtual Environments (STRIVE) Center. The STRIVE Center promotes collaboration among the government, academic, and medical communities on key challenges in clinical rehabilitation, wearable technology development, and advanced operational training. The centre's flagship capability is the Computer Assisted Rehabilitation Environment (CAREN), which enables the assessment of individuals' biomechanical, physiological, and cognitive performance as they interact with a fully immersive virtual environment.

Lion's Pride (Deployed Signals Intelligence Operations Center Ethiopia's capital, Addis Ababa)- In the aftermath of 9/11 the National Security Agency forged a relationship with the Ethiopian government. There are "three Lion's Pride Remote Sites," including one located in the town of Gondar, in northwestern Ethiopia.

Lithuania, city of Vilnius- T he black site was a guest house in the capital which operated as early as 2002.

London's Galton Laboratory- This field applied to psychiatry the concepts of eugenics (otherwise known as race purification, race hygiene, or race betterment.

Louise Wise Services- The agency psychiatrists had separated identical twins and triplets for the purposes of experimentation. Samuel Karelitz, Peter Neubauer, and Viola Bernard.

University of London, UK- To study levels of motivation as related to certain personality characteristics and contribute to Technical Services Division's long term interest in indirect assessment. One of the factors in making this grant was

"to lend prestige to the Society for the Investigation of Human Ecology, Inc., as a worldwide funding organisation."

Los Alamos National Laboratories- During 1951 and 1952, at least 14 human subjects were exposed to tritium in air, by immersion of body parts in water, or by drinking. These experiments were designed to measure the retention or excretion of tritium by the human body.

The Barolo subcritical experiments were conducted underground at the U1a complex, a vast warren of tunnels deep beneath the desert. These tests are called "subcritical" because they use fissile materials but create no self-sustaining nuclear chain reaction. Most subcritical tests employ plutonium which is imploded with high explosives or shocked in various ways. (2015) University of California, Los Angeles (1968 - 1978)- Over a ten year period, UCLA's Neuropsychiatric Institute (NPI) was home to a "non-sanctioned entity" of paranormal research which studied clairvoyance, telepathy, haunted houses, Kirlian photography and a psi development group (1971 to 1980) which sought to help "normal people" develop latent psychic abilities.

Louisiana State Penitentiary- BioCorRx and the Louisiana Department of Corrections failed to disclose to prisoners that they would be receiving an unapproved implant. (2019)

The experiments were funded by the U.S. Army. In the studies, he dosed them with LSD and bulbocapnine, and implanted electrodes into the septal area of the brain to stimulate it and take electroencephalography (EEG) readings. **Lovelace Clinic-** Close military ties, and facilities that allow it to work with deadly viruses and bacteria, Kirkland air force base.

Loma Linda University Medical Center- On October 26, 1984, in California removed the defective heart (hypoplastic left heart syndrome, in which the left side is much smaller than the right) of a five pound baby girl (known as Baby Fae). It was replaced with the heart of a baboon, a procedure known as xenotransplantation (cross-species transplantation). Twenty days later, on November 15th, the baby died of complications caused when her body began to reject the transplanted heart. Among the ethical issues raised by the Baby Fae case are the risk/benefit ratios for the human subject, experimentation and quality of the informed consent and surrogate decision making, exploration of other options, the introduction of expensive and untested technology, and the priorities and economics of medicine. Regarding other options, the doctors at Loma Linda never sought a human heart and the chances for a successful xenograft were very slim.

Conducting the first large-scale tests of a toxic drinking water contaminant on human subjects a precedent medical researchers and Environmental Working Group condemned as morally unethical and scientifically invalid.Loma Linda Medical Center in San Bernardino is paying 100 people \$1,000 to eat a dose of perchlorate every day for six months. Perchlorate is a

toxic component of rocket fuel that damages thyroid function, preventing healthy development of foetuses and children and causing cancer. (2000) **Veterans Administration Hospital in Loma Linda California-** Dr. W. Ross Adey.

London's Institute of Psychiatry- Hans Eysenck

Lorton Prison- Microwave experiment with human subjects.

Lufkin Memorial Hospital - Texas-Radiation experiments

Lying-In Hospital of the University of Chicago - The women experienced an abnormally high number of miscarriages and babies with low birth weight (LBW). None of the women were told that they were being experimented on. Experiments in which they tested diethylstilbestrol, a synthetic oestrogen, on pregnant women.

MacGill AFB- (USSOCOM) was established in 1987 at MacDill Air Force Base,

Florida. Included in this unified command staff was a directorate for psychological operations and civil affairs (J-9)

Macquarie University School of Behavioural Sciences- F ounded by Ian K. Waterhouse (an Australian Military Psychologist, and former Tavistock Clinic student). Prof. Jacqueline Goodnow.

The Macy Foundation -C hief medical officer, Dr. Frank Fremont- Smith, would be the permanent co-director of the World Federation with J.R. Rees. and T. T. Peck were among the first physicians to report at a meeting held at Princeton, New Jersey, under the auspices of the Macy Foundation that children may safely be given LSD-25.

Maimonides Medical Centre - Chuck Honorton, mainly on RNG studies. Edwin C. May, Ph.D.

South Africa's Mangaung Prison - In 2013, leaked video footage shot inside showed a prisoner with no record of mental illness being forcibly injected, apparently with antipsychotic drugs.

Manhattan District Hospital, Oak Ridge, Tennessee- The Manhattan Project, patients were injected with plutonium.

Mankind Research Unlimited- Was/is owned by SCI (Systems Consultants Inc.) SCI, founded in 1966, is a military contractor which studies intelligence electronic warfare and sensor technology. They receive most of their funding from the Navy.

MRU studies dowsing, the effects of electromagnetic radiation on the central nervous system, telepathy, infra and ultrasound, cranial implants, mind-

altering drugs, biofeedback and Krilian photography. Mankind Research Foundation (MRF).

Marconi or Plessey Defense Systems in the UK- The number of deaths. Marieval Indian Residential School, Canada- 751 unmarked graves at a cemetery near the former Marieval Indian Residential School. (2021) Marshallese Islanders -Exposed to fallout from early atomic bomb tests. This report notes that thyroid nodules, produced by exposure to radioactive iodine, did not first appear among inhabitants of the atoll - with the highest fallout until 9 years after the testing. Nodules began appearing some years later among inhabitants of atolls where the doses were lower; and after 22 years, nodules were still being observed.

Marion Federal Penitentiary- F ederal government was complicit in the use of psychological torture to silence prisoners' complaints.

Marsh Chapel Experiment- A lso called the "Good Friday Experiment", was a 1962 experiment conducted on Good Friday at Boston University's Marsh Chapel. Walter N. Pahnke, a graduate student in theology at Harvard Divinity School, designed the experiment under the supervision of Timothy Leary, Richard Alpert, and the Harvard Psilocybin Project. Pahnke's experiment investigated whether psilocybin (the active principle in psilocybin mushrooms) would act as a reliable entheogen in religiously predisposed subjects.

Mars/Kline Center for Neurology and Psychiatry, Hati- Was named for Haitian psychiatrist Louis Mars, founder of the first school of ethnopsychiatry with Roger Bastide and Georges Devereux (Farmer 1992b:260),19 and Nathan S. Kline, scholar of cross-cultural psychiatry in developing countries and pioneer in pharmacological treatment.

University of Maryland -Team is studying the impact of VNS on foreign language learning. They will use electroencephalography to examine the effects of VNS on neural function during speech perception, vocabulary and grammar training. (DARPA/TNT)

LSD was tested on military volunteers.

Had invented a Thought Reading Machine. In the 1970s, The South China Morning Post reported. Pharmacological testing and evaluation of certain chemical compounds that might have properties of interest to Technical Services Division. Years: 1956-1957. Subproject 59: MK-ULTRA: Unwitting Drug Tests at University of Maryland.

University of Maryland Medical School- Gerald Klee.

Maryland House of Corrections- Clinical trials of new drugs for malaria. Massachusetts Mental Health Center- Martin T. Orne, hypnosis study. A mentally ill patient who was given LSD by physicians experimenting at the Massachusetts Mental Health Center in the 1950s killed herself within hours of taking the potent psychedelic drug, says a Cambridge, Mass., psychiatrist who had been following her progress at the time. "They gave this patient LSD one

morning and when I came back from lunch that day, I was told she had hung herself in the downstairs bathroom," Dr. Robert Reid said yesterday. Dr. Reid said he was not told until after the woman's death that she had been given LSD. Subproject 75: MKULTRA.

Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) in Boston- Oak Ridge-sponsored experiment injected uranium into eleven patients. Approximately 12 terminal brain tumour patients were injected with uranium to determine the dose at which kidney damage began to occur. With assistance from the Oak Ridge National Laboratory and was funded by the Atomic Energy Commission. All subjects were terminal brain tumour patients who died within 18 months of the experiments. (Dr. William Sweet)

Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT)- A. J. Wiener, MK-ULTRA Subproject 90: To study the scientist in the Soviet Union to produce a descriptive model of the type likely to come in contact with Americans, and develop strategies for evaluating and influencing such scientists.

To administer radium-224 and thorium-234 to 20 people between 1961 and 1965. Many were chosen from the Age Center of New England and had volunteered for "research projects on ageing". Doses were 0.2–2.4 microcuries (7.4–88.8 kBq) for radium and 1.2–120 microcuries (44–4,440 kBq) for thorium.

Massachusetts Institute of Technology, led three different experiments involving 74 Fernald boys, aged 10 to 17. As part of the study, the boys were fed oatmeal and milk laced with radioactive iron and calcium; in another experiment, scientists directly injected the boys with radioactive calcium. **Maudsley Hospital The Institute of Psychiatry**—Maudsley Hospital was the "staging ground for European and African MK-ULTRA operations". There is evidence that strongly suggests it was also a staging ground for Australian operations. Dr. Hans J. Eysenck.

Mayang-do, an island off the east coast port of Sinpo- Experiments on humans, dates back to the late 1960s and was one of the first facilities used for chemical and biological weapons tests.

Oklahoma State Prison McAlister- Clinical trials of new drugs for malaria. Fort McClellan, Alabama - The experiments used Chemical Corps personnel to test decontamination methods for biological and chemical weapons, including sulphur mustard and nerve agents. The personnel were deliberately exposed to these contaminants, were not volunteers, and were not informed of the tests.

McDonnell Douglas Astronautics Company (Huntington Beach, CA)-Psychoenergetic research.

McFarlane Corporation- A "Death Ray" weapon was developed. Described as a modulated electron gun X-ray nuclear booster, it could be adapted to

communications, remote control and guidance systems, EM radiation telemetry, and death ray.

McGill University, Department of Psychiatry, Canada- Yoruba witchcraft study – African Witch Doctor study. Probably a cover for recruitment of promising young Nigerians. Subproject 121: MKULTRA: Witch Doctor study-Dr. Raymond Prince

McGill University, Department of Psychiatry, Canada- MK-ULTRA Subproject 68:

To study the effect upon human behaviour of the repetition of verbal signals. Patients were treated with LSD-25 and other similar agents to break down patterns of behaviour. The plan included intensive repetition of prearranged verbal signals. Patients were kept in sensory isolation then continuous sleep for seven to ten days. Dr. Cameron completed over 100 cases.

Fort Meade -Stargate Project was a secret U.S. Army unit established in 1978 at Fort Meade, Maryland, by the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) and SRI International. Home to the first remote-viewing operational units, called DT-S, codenamed: Grill Flame (1978-83), Center Lane (1983-6), and possibly Sun Streak.

Medical Science Research Foundation- MK-ULTRA Subproject 73: Establish whether susceptibility to hypnosis can be increased by use of drugs, such as alcohol, mescaline, scopolamine, LSD, etc. Also, to determine the extent to which various drugs possess specific "hypnosis-like" effects.

Medical Institute imeni S.V. Kurashov, Kazan - Amirov, N.Kh., Kalpina, G. A., Kamchatnov, V.P., Mendelevich, D.M., Zubairova, G.O.

Medical Center for Federal Prisoners in Springfield, Mo-START program Medical University of Madrid - "Two-way Communication with the Brain" describes how communication can be achieved with deep-brain processes using tiny transmitters, thereby also being able to suppress EEG patterns. They also state that because both energy and data is supplied by radio-waves, these transmitters last for life. (Yale University)

University of Melbourne- Dr. Oscar A. Oeser.

Menlo Park, CA -SRI International, SRI Proprietary.

Menlo Park Veterans' Hospital- The project studied the effects of psychoactive drugs, particularly LSD, psilocybin, mescaline, cocaine, AMT, and DMT on people.

Mental Hygiene Department of Victoria- Dr. Eric Cunningham Dax. Australia In 1952.

Menwith Hill, UK. USAF, CIA, and NSA -Signals Intelligence (SIGINT) gathering station, also run Electronic Brain Link (EBL) for controlling humans and Programmable Life Forms (PGLF's)

Menninger Institute and Clinic- Conference on various means of producing states of consciousness was sponsored by the Menninger Foundation and the American Association of Humanistic Psychology. Psychoenergetic research. Merck & Co.- Despite the availability of vaccines, more than 2,000 children in the India trial received placebo injections of salt water rather than one of the available effective vaccines. (RotaTeq)

Metallurgical Laboratory of the Manhattan Engineer district, Chicago-Plutonium experiments.

Methodist Babies Home- Children's homes to test a new quadruple antigen vaccination, which included a polio vaccine possibly contaminated with a monkey virus since linked to cancer.

MI5- In November 2019, four human rights organisations claimed that the UK government has a policy dating from the 1990s to allow MI5 officers to authorise agents or informers to participate in crime, and to immunise them against prosecution for criminal actions. The organisations said the policy allowed MI5 officers to authorise agents and informers to participate in criminal activities that protected national security or the economic well-being of the UK. The organisations took the UK government to the Investigatory Powers Tribunal, seeking to have it declare the policy illegal, and to issue an injunction against further 'unlawful conduct'. In December 2019, the tribunal dismissed the request of the human rights organisations in a 3-to-2 decision. The potential criminal activities include murder, kidnap, and torture, according to a Bloomberg report. MI5 is known sometimes to use the Government Communications Planning Directorate (GCPD) as a cover name, for example, when sponsoring research.

University of Michigan -James McConnell, Professor of Psychology of the University of Michigan: I believe the day has come when we can combine sensory deprivation with drugs, hypnosis, and astute manipulation of reward and punishment to gain almost absolute control over an individual's behaviour. Zarnoff A. Mednick

Michigan Fund- CIA funding front.

Microbiological Research Establishment, Porton Down- Bacillus subtilis (also known as Bacillus globigii or BG) selected as the test agent. This bacteria was sprayed across South Dorset without the knowledge or consent of the inhabitants.

Midwest Psi Research Institute, Chicago- Psychoenergetic research.

Military Medical Academy, Bulgaria- LSD Experiments. Prof. Boyadjieva injected the soldiers with 25 micrograms of LSD in the presence of a colonel and a military psychiatrist.

Military Medical Academy (Leningrad)- Bodrov, V. A. Military-Medical Academy imeni S.M. Kirov, Leningrad -Kozhevnikov, Ye.P.

Military unit 71592 of the city Novosibirs- Established the first installation 'Radioson' and conducted pretests. The positive results are reflected in the act of tests of this military unit ...'.... According to calculations made in 1974, the generator 'Radioson' can effectively 'treat' the city of about a hundred of square kilometres, plunging its inhabitants into a deep sleep – and at a distance of up to 55 kilometres away from the transmitter'

Military Veterinary Research Institute- Biotechnology processes to support Chinese military end uses and end users, to include purported brain-control weaponry.

Miller Center for Community Protection and Resilience- CIA program-Rutgers University.

Milledgeville Georgia- Investigational drugs tested on mentally disabled children. No institutional approval.

Milson Island in the Hawkesbury River north of Sydney- Became a MK-ULTRA research facility.

Mind Science Foundation, San Antonio- Psychoenergetic research. University of Minnesota -(Alden Sears)-LSD experiments. Radiation experiments.

Ministry of Defence, Britain- 2002 attempted to get 12 professional psychics to prove their powers, apparently in an effort to determine whether they could offer their services in defence of their country.

Ministry of State Security (MSS), China- Ankang institutions. Special forensic mental hospitals. The political abuse of psychiatry in China only seems to take place in the institutions which are under the authority of the police and the MSS but it does not take place in those institutions which belong to other governmental sectors.

University of Minnesota- University of Minnesota research participant Dan Markingson died by suicide while enrolled in an industry-sponsored pharmaceutical trial comparing three FDA-approved atypical antipsychotics: Seroquel (quetiapine), Zyprexa (olanzapine), and Risperdal (risperidone) (2004) Dr. Amendeo Marrazzi

Missouri Institute of Psychiatry- Dr. Amendeo Marrazzi.

Mitchell Jessen and Associates -Received \$81 million on contract from the CIA to carry out the interrogation of detainees, referred to as "enhanced interrogation techniques". At one point, the firm reportedly had 120 employees.

Mitre Corp. in McLean VA- Directed Energy Warfare (DEW) Conference. Personnel Vulnerability" and Directed Energy Warfare Biological Effects". London's MoD- H ad approval to begin its psychic testing in 2001. Modum Bad Nervesanatorium, Norway -A psychiatric clinic which treated 379 inpatients with psychedelic drugs during the years 1961–76. The

psychiatrists there initially regarded the psychedelic treatment as efficacious and without serious negative reactions, but reports of long-term harm have since surfaced.

Monash University- Bionic vision. A team of researchers at Monash University in Melbourne, Australia, has built a bionic device that they say can restore vision to the blind through a brain implant. Gennaris bionic vision system 2020.

Monash Vision Group (MVG)- Gennaris bionic vision system. MVG has been supported through cornerstone donations from Marc & Eva Besen and The Alan and Elizabeth Finkel Foundation, plus funding from Monash Faculty of Engineering and IT Foundation.

Monroe Institute -Monroe Institute. Founded and directed by Robert Monroe from 1974 until his death in1995. Had classified contracts with the U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command (INSCOM) on orders by Gen. Albert Stubblebine. The Institute studied their hemi-synch techniques to see if they could enhance soldiers' performance and concentration.

I nvolves using a binaural beat to cause different psychological effects. A binaural beat is created by using stereo headphones with each speaker emitting a slightly different frequency. The result is a tone at the frequency between the two, which allegedly causes the brain to "entrain" on the frequency (i.e. the brain waves regulate themselves to the same frequency).

Monsanto Chemical Company's Mound Laboratory, Miamisburg, Ohio-A mixture of contaminants containing alpha emitters, and not further identified, was placed on the palms of four employees and detergents tested for removal. In addition, detergents were tested on the hands of three other employees "whose hands were contaminated in the normal course of work." Moscow Institute of Aviation- Ziegel, F.U.

Moscow Medical Stomatological Institute, Moscow- Matveyev, V.F. Moscow Foreign Language Pedagogical Institute -Has claimed resounding success with Lozanov's method.

Geology Department of Moscow State University- Ogilvy, A. A. Department of Theoretical Physics, Moscow University - Terletsky, Ya. Moscow Serbsky Institute- Flagship for punitive political control; its psychiatrists developed painful drug methods to make detainees talk and extract testimony for use in national security investigations. The first reaction: at the Serbsky Institute, they have already invented a similar drug to torture dissidents, an injection into the prisoner's heart zone which slowed down his heart beating and caused terrifying anxiety - viewed from outside, the prisoner seemed just dozing, while he was going through a nightmare.

Moscow's State Institute of Experimental Psychology -E ver since 1923, had conducted trials in hypnosis.

Montreal Neurological Institute, Canada- Wilder Penfield. He convinced the Rockefeller Foundation to endow and fund the construction of Montreal Neurological Institute.

Montana State College- Years: 1954-1963. isolate compounds from natural products which have psychogenic properties. Initially research was done on seeds from the plant Ipomoea sedifolia Choisy, a Mexican and Cuban trailing vine. Rivea Corymbosa and the fungus Amanita Muscaria, a mushroom. Montefiore Hospital, the Bronx- 12 terminal cancer patients were injected with radioactive calcium and strontium. This experiment was designed to compare the distribution of these two substances among body tissues after autopsy.

1999. The hospitals and schools are campaigning against controversial new rules for human experimentation on the mentally ill and disabled drafted by a Health Department task force. A state court struck down the state's old regulations, which allowed risky experiments of no benefit to patients incapable of giving consent. Warned the state Health Department that the regulations will stifle research and cause drug companies to divert their funding to states that have less red tape.

Moral Rearmament Movement of Frank Buckman- CIA front.

Moscow's board of scientific and technical society of radio engineering, electronics, and telecommunications- C haired by I.M.Kogan (И.М.Коган) Mount. Sinai Hospital NY - (Dr. Harold Abramson)-The civilian researchers in Baltimore were instructed to attempt to find chemicals that could induce anything from the desire for kinky sex, to stimulating death by carbon dioxide, that is, to produce a chemical that could fake suicide. MKSearch. They wanted disturbance by aberrant behaviour, changes of sex patterns, suggestibility and the creation of dependence, to be used in the obtaining of information.

Dr. Abramson sent a little noted telegram to the Senate Health subcommittee in 1975 in which he reported that he did work on LSD with the C.I.A.

Muslims- Are considered prime for behaviour modification programs. The goal is more than law abiding prisoners. The more is a political and social outlook which is acceptable and desirable to the behaviourists. Political repression has been closely connected with the use of behaviour modification.

Camp Nama - Was a military base in Baghdad, Iraq. The elite unit, known as Task Force 6-26, used the facility to interrogate prisoners both before and after the Abu Ghraib prisoner abuse scandal. Serious mistreatment of detainees by

the special task force, including beatings, exposure to extreme cold, threats of death, humiliation, and various forms of heavy interrogation.

Nancekuke, UK- Was used to produce and test nerve gas. Nancekuke closed in 1980.

National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA)-NASA have had research and testing facilities where substances such as BZ were created for military and domestic use.

Funded experiments on 67 inmates at the Oregon State Penitentiary sponsored by the Pacific Northwest Research Foundation of Seattle as well. **National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine.** 1991. In the Mind's Eye: Enhancing Human Performance. Washington, DC: The National Academies Press.

National Association for Mental Health- Gathered the world psychiatric and psychological leaders together at an International Congress on Mental Health at the United Kingdom's Ministry of Health in London. At this congress, a World Federation for Mental Health was formed, to run the planet's psychological services. Lady Norman, the hostess of the congress, was named to the executive board. Norman picked as president of the World Federation the chief of the British military's psychological warfare department, Tavistock Institute chief Brig. Gen. Dr. John Rawlings Rees.

National Institute of Health- Finance studies on the effect of physical and chemical agents on the central nervous system of anthropoids (man-like animals) and unspecified involvement with "an LSD Project".

Support study-conducted at about two dozen prominent research facilities throughout the country from 2005-2009, including Stanford University School of Medicine, Yale University School of Medicine, Brown University and Duke University. 1,316 premature infants were exposed to an increased risk of blindness, brain injury and death. One primary purpose of the research was to determine whether extremely premature infants were more likely to die or develop eye disease if treated with high or low amounts of oxygen.

1993 experiment was the inclusion of a placebo group of more than 500 infants who got no protection at all, an estimated 5 percent of whom were expected to develop whooping cough, compared to the 1.4 percent estimated risk for the study group as a whole. Because of these risks, this study would not be permissible in the U.S. The NIH, however, insisted on the inclusion of a placebo control and therefore initiated the study in Italy where there are fewer restrictions on human research trials.

Tested AIDS drugs on hundreds of foster children. The practice ensured that foster children (mostly poor or minority) received care from world-class researchers at government expense, slowing their rate of death and extending their lives. But it also exposed a vulnerable population to the risks of medical research and drugs that were known to have serious side effects in adults and

for which the safety for children was unknown. The research was conducted in at least seven states — Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, New York, North Carolina, Colorado and Texas — and involved more than four dozen different studies. The foster children ranged from infants to late teens,

U.S. National Institute of Justice -ln 1993, along with a "fever" gun and a "convulsion" gun, both using micro- wave technology. feasibility of "thermal guns" which could heat the body to 105 to 107 degrees F and incapacitate the target; "seizure guns" which would use EM energy to induce epileptic-like seizures; and " magnetophosphene guns" which would cause the target to "see stars".

National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda - Installed a small reactor in approximately 1952 to manufacture radio pharmaceuticals. Clinical research has continued. Radiation therapy: approximately 11,000 radiation therapy patient treatments at the institute, some of which were on protocols.

Classified Navy files were discovered-which indicate that from 1947 to 1952 the -Department of the Navy conducted limited studies to determine the effectiveness of drugs on human behaviour and performance, in the treatment of psychiatric illness, and as an interrogation aid.

National Institute of Mental Health Addiction Research Center in Kentucky- In the mid-1950s, drug-addicted African Americans were given LSD, with seven of them kept hallucinating for 77 consecutive days. At this same centre, healthy African American men were still being used as test subjects almost 10 years later, this time for an experimental drug, BZ--100 times more powerful than LSD.

National Mental Health Hospital of Guatemala- Experiments involved 696 subjects, male prisoners and female patients for syphilis and gonorrhoea experiments.

National Research Council- Discussed an experiment: create racial orphanages, separate institutions where children of different races would be received as close to birth as possible. The idea was to compare white and black children under similar conditions. Scientists could closely monitor the institutionalised children as they developed to figure out whether differences were due to innate characteristics or environmental influence. Nursery schools and foster homes were proposed as places of comparative study too, but most of the committee's discussions focused on the idea of racial orphanages.

National Research Council's Committee on Techniques for the Enhancement of Human Performance- The NRC was evaluating enhancement and parapsychological studies conducted for the Army, so it is likely that Backster's research was involved with the government.

National Reactor Testing Station in Idaho- Planned radioiodine exposure to humans from May 1963 to November 1965, radioactive iodine was released

intentionally on seven separate occasions. On three occasions. human subjects were exposed.

National University of Singapore- A team of Chinese scientists has developed a telekinetic technology that allows a person to remotely control a metasurface with their mind. Uses a person's brain waves to wirelessly control a programmable metasurface using Bluetooth. What makes the team's approach unique is that unlike previous experiments that required a direct, wired connection to the metasurface, the subject is able to manipulate it remotely.

National Women's Hospital in Auckland, NZ-Herbert Green.

U.S. Navy- Sprays a cloud of bacteria from ships over San Francisco. Monitoring devices are situated throughout the city in order to test the extent of infection. Many residents become ill with pneumonia-like symptoms.

Navy's top secret "Perfect Concussion" program, which used sub aural frequency blasts to erase memory.

Naval Air Weapons Station (NAWS) China Lake The Navy and an army of contractors pave the way for the future of warfare, testing the newest evolutions in bombs, missiles, cannon shells, electronic warfare and communications systems.

Naval Hospital at Bethesda, Md.- The patient designated B-1 was given one dose of a radioactive isotope of an antimony compound called potassium tartrate, or tartar emetic.

Naval Medical Academy, Russia- Shastin, N.R.

Naval Medical Research Institute- Classified Navy files were discovered-which indicate that from 1947 to 1952 the -Department of the Navy conducted limited studies to determine the effectiveness of drugs on human behaviour and performance, in the treatment of psychiatric illness, and as an interrogation aid. Charles Savage.

Naval Postgraduate School Monterey Ca.- Using a serial short term memory task, subjects were required to respond to symbols presented one-back, 2-back, and 3-back from a randomly presented list of four different symbols while breathing either 100 percent oxygen or atmospheric air with an oxygen mask. The purpose of the experiment was to determine whether breathing 100 percent oxygen had an effect on short term memory. Analysis of the data collected from 36 subjects showed that breathing pure oxygen had no effect on the subjects short term memory ability over a 12 minute period. This result is in direct contrast to previously reported results.

Naval Research Laboratory, Washington, D.C.-Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects.

Naval Surface Weapons, Office of Non-Lethal Weapons- In 1981 to develop electromagnetic devices for purposes including "riot control," clandestine operations and hostage removal.

Naval Training Center, Great Lakes, IL- Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects.

NAVELEX, Wright-Patterson AFB -- Grill flame.

University of Nebraska College of Medicine -F ed iodine-131 to 28 healthy infants through a gastric tube to test the concentration of iodine in the infants' thyroid glands.

Neighborhood Family Clinics (Harlem)- Human Ecology Fund, CIA. Berle, Beatrice.

Neurological Hospital Number Three, Leningrad, USSR- Brqverman, L.B., Shcherbatov (Fnu), Svetlanova, N.K.

Neuropsychiatric Laboratory In San Diego- Dr. Narut knew of two Navy programming centres, the neuropsychiatric laboratory in San Diego and the U.S. Regional Medical Center in Italy,

Network Contagion Research Institute (NCRI)- CIA program. Rutgers University.

New England Deaconess Hospital- Biodistribution tracking where compounds of interest travel in an experimental human subject.

Newhaven Private Hospital, Australia- The site of a pioneering study in Australia during the early 1960s conducted by resident psychiatrist Dr Lance Howard Whitaker using a new psychiatric drug called lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD or LSD-2551). LSD was administered as an adjunct to conventional psychotherapy to expedite the treatment of a variety of psychiatric illnesses.

Newhaven emerged claiming that they had never suffered any mental illness and that the LSD they had received had not been administered for therapeutic purposes but rather as a recruitment tool for a fringe religious sect known as The Family that had commandeered the hospital and the loyalty of a number of its staff.

New Jersey Neuropsychiatric Institute- Study drugs affecting the central nervous system, looking towards an anti-interrogation drug. Also, to screen and evaluate hallucinogenic materials of interest to the Technical Services Division. Testing on human volunteers at Atlanta Federal Penitentiary.

New Jersey Neuropsychiatric Institute, Clinical Investigative Unit of the Bureau of Research -MK-ULTRA Subproject 47: Study drugs affecting the central nervous system, looking towards an anti-interrogation drug. Also, to screen and evaluate hallucinogenic materials of interest to the Technical Services Division. Testing on human volunteers at Atlanta Federal Penitentiary.

New Jersey Reformatory at Bordentown- Reformatory reported to the institute for an experiment session for which they were paid S4 cents. Scientists at the bureau invited the inmates to be subjects in an experiment involving LSD.

New Jersey State Colony for the Feeble-Minded- Dysentery projects funded by the CMR.

University of New Mexico- An experiment funded by the U.S. military meant to sharpen soldiers' minds for the battlefield has found a way to improve memory: by zapping subjects' brains with tiny bursts of electricity during sleep. DARPA-funded research 2019.

New Statesman- July 1931: "The legitimate claims of eugenics are not inherently incompatible with the outlook of the collectivist movement. On the contrary, they would be expected to find their most intransigent opponents amongst those who cling to the individualistic views of parenthood and family economics."

New York State Department of Mental Hygiene- Despite understanding the optics of infecting mentally disabled children with a potentially deadly disease, Dr. Krugman felt the risk was worth the reward. "The decision to feed hepatitis virus to patients at Willowbrook was not undertaken lightly," he wrote in a 1958 paper published in the New England Journal of Medicine. He noted that the strain of hepatitis in Willowbrook wasn't very severe, that many of the children would get infected anyway, and that any knowledge gained from the experiment would in fact help other Willowbrook residents.

New York State Psychiatric Institute-(Paul Hoch, Carney Landis, and James Cattell.) NYS Psychiatric Institute for depression following a divorce. Without his knowledge or consent, he was used as a guinea human pig in a horrific mescaline drug experiment that killed him.

In 1993 and 1998, three experiments at the New York State Psychiatric Institute were conducted on nearly one hundred boys aged 6-11, all from New York City, many Black or Hispanic, who shared an older sibling being legally charged with delinquent behaviour. These boys were further selected via court records and interviewing both mother and child to determine boys who had experienced "adverse rearing practices". In exchange for consent, the mothers were given \$125 dollars upon going to the aforementioned institute and allowing their children to be injected with a small amount of the drug fenfluramine, after which they'd be given a blood test to determine whether or not the level of neurotransmitters fluctuated in order to see if there might be a link betwixt neurochemical markers and violent behaviour. Those opposed to this experiment have brought up three main points, namely, that the drug was unsafe due to its usage in the diet-pill "fen-phen" which was taken off the market after heart-valve damage was discovered to occur in some users, that it was racist due to the majority of Blacks and Hispanics, and that the mother

may have essentially been bribed due to her generally low-income situation. Supports counter that the dosage was miniscule, given once, and that there is no reason to suggest that it was unsafe at those levels, that race was not an issue, and that the mother was not bribed at all.

New York University, New York- E xperiments carried out on human subjects demonstrated that the biological effects of Thorium X (Radium-224), as judged by erythema and skin pigmentation, can be increased by using an electrical current to cause greater penetration of the skin by radioactive material.

He attached electrodes to the subject's wrist so he could apply mild electric shocks when certain pictures appeared on the computer. This technique creates a fear memory—which he tests by measuring the subject's sweat response. "We now understand there are points in time when we can change memory, where we can create windows of opportunity that allows us to alter memories, and even erase specific memories," Kroes

New York Police Department (NYPD) -a nd at least one former CIA employee were conducting military-like studies on Muslim populations at Rutgers University and other schools far outside their jurisdiction. During the 2000's, it came to light in 2011.

New York State Vocational Institution, a reformatory prison in West Coxsackie- S tudied the transmission of a deadly stomach bug by having young men swallow unfiltered stool suspension. The point was to see how well the disease spread that way as compared to spraying the germs and having test subjects breathe it. Swallowing it was a more effective way to spread the disease, the researchers concluded.

NIMH- S ponsored Addiction Research Centre, Lexington KY. The Study was intended to test various drugs, including hallucinogens, at the NIMH Addiction Research Center in Lexington, Kentucky.

Between 1974 and 1989, West received at least \$5,110,099 in grants from the government, channelled through the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH), a conduit for CIA programs.

NIMHANS, India- It was reported in June, 2012, that the Indian Government has approached NIMHANS, a well known mental health establishment in South India, to assist in suppressing anti-nuclear protests regarding the building of the Kudankulam Nuclear Power Plant. The government was in talks with NIMHANS representatives to chalk up a plan to dispatch psychiatrists to Kudankulam, for counselling protesters opposed to the building of the plant. To fulfil this, NIMHANS developed a team of six members, all of them, from the Department of Social Psychiatry. The psychiatrists were sent to get a "peek into the protesters' minds" and help them learn the importance of the plant NKVD's program (Russia)- With similar strategies of using psychotropic (e.g. drugs) substances and technical equipment.

North Pyongan Province, North Korea- A military academy for the regime's elite troops, mentally and physically disabled children are used as subjects in chemical weapons experiments.

Northern Arizona University- H.A. Cahn.

Northwick Park Hospital, UK- Six young healthy men participated in a clinical trial for the drug TGN1412; within 16 hours all had been transferred to the intensive care unit. TGN1412 was administered to the six men by intravenous infusion over the course of 3 to 6 minutes. Each patient received the experimental drug in quick succession. Within 60 minutes, the first participants suffered severe headaches, muscle pain, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, severe fever, restlessness, rash and rigors. After four hours, the volunteers developed hypotension, tachycardia and onset of respiratory failure. Norfolk Supply Center- In Virginia black workers were exposed to crates contaminated with A. fumigatus spores.

Northfield Labs- 2000–2010, artificial blood was transfused into research subjects across the United States without their consent. Later studies showed the artificial blood caused a significant increase in the risk of heart attacks and death.

Novartis -Commissioned clinical trials for a bird flu vaccine which ended up being carried out on homeless people in Poland. In 2007, Novartis engaged a company based in Germany and Poland to test a vaccine. This company did so in a clinic in the Polish city of Grudziadz. The subjects – homeless and poor people – were reportedly paid around CHF2 (\$2) to be tested on what they thought was a vaccine for normal flu.

Novo Nordisk- Danish company that manufactures NovoSeven. Undergoing trials for use to stop bleeding in trauma patients with severe wounds and bleeding within the brains of patients with severe head injuries. But its effectiveness and safety as a blood-clotting agent in these circumstances has not been proven. MoD (Britain) has authorised its use in battlefield trauma casualties. The drug's use by the MoD and US Department of Defence would not be fed into the company's randomised controlled trials of the drug.

Novosibirsk's Branch of the Entomological Society of USSR-V.S.Grebennikov.

Norway House, Canada- The experiments included deliberate, sustained malnourishment and in some cases, the withholding of dental services.

Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies- 54 hospital patients with normal intestinal tracts were fed lanthanum-140. This experiment was designed to measure the rate at which this radioactive substance passed through the body. Oak Ridge National Laboratory- Involved in human experimentation research during the time that Union Carbide was running it. exposed patients with leukaemia and other cancers to exceptionally high levels of radiation from cesium and cobalt isotopes. Nearly 200 patients, including a 6-year-old boy, were made subjects of the experiments.

In 1962, five human subjects drank milk containing radioactive Iodine-131 for periods of time from 1 to 63 days. In the first experiments all subjects drank daily doses of I-131 milk for periods from 4 to 63 days, Doses each day were 150 or 1840 picocuries. The largest dose was 1840 picocuries per day for 63 days, for a total of 115,920 picocuries. In a second experiment, two of the same subjects drank single doses of 92,000 picocuries each.

Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL)-Is examining approaches based on known

physiological responses to certain types of stimuli. These "weapons" would temporarily incapacitate an individual or a group with no lasting physiological damage.

Oak Ridge Nuclear Facility -W as 53-year old a "coloured man" Ebb Cade, a cement mixer at a construction company who had been hospitalised for broken bone injuries following an automobile accident. He told the doctors that he has always been in good health; so they secretly injected him with 4.7 micrograms of plutonium.

Oak Ridge Psychiatric Unit in Penetanguishene, Ontario, Canada -Patientinmates were subjected to experimental treatments that included sensory deprivation, hallucinogenic drugs and physical punishment.

Office of Naval Research- MK-ULTRA Subproject 54: To study the mechanism of brain concussion. Frey, funded by the Office of Naval Research and the U.S. The Army was the most active researcher on the bioeffects of microwave radiation in the country.

Office of the Chief Ballston Center LCDR - Positively identified as having been involved, to some degree, with human radiation experiments.

Office of Research and Development -It was run by Dr. Green, Dr. Steven Aldridge, Martin Orne, and Morris Allen.

Office of Scientific and Weapons Research -H as carried out some of the mind-control research.

Olsztyn-Mazury Airport- Terrorist suspects were secretly held, and even tortured, by the CIA. Flight records show that an aeroplane leased by the CIA

flying from Kabul to Guantanamo Bay made a stop in Szymany. Officials from the airport have confirmed some of these flights bypassed normal customs-clearing procedures. During the time of these landings, the airport regularly received visits by cars bearing markings associated with Stare Kiejkuty intelligence training school outside the nearby village of Stare Kiejkuty. University of Oregon Medical School- Subjects were injected with Phosphorus-32.

Three of the subjects were patients who received the P-32 as part of the therapy for

blood diseases.

Oregon State Prison- 67 volunteers were subjected to testicular irradiation by x-rays. Radiation doses ranged from 8 to 600 roentgen in single acute exposures, except that six prisoners were irradiated a second time, one a third time, and one was given weekly irradiations of 5 roentgen per week for eleven weeks.

Oryol Hospital- Use of drugs by Soviet psychiatrists in order to manipulate behaviour

Okinawa- The U.S. government has previously disclosed information on chemical and biological warfare tests it held at sea and on land. U.S. Army tested biological weapons in Okinawa in the early 1960s, when the prefecture was still under U.S. rule. During these tests, conducted at least a dozen times between 1961 and 1962, rice blast fungus was released by the Army using "a midget duster to release inoculum alongside fields in Okinawa and Taiwan," in order to measure effective dosages requirements at different distances and the negative effects on crop production. Rice blast or Pyricularia oryzae produces a mycotoxin called Tenuazonic acid which has been implicated in human and animal disease.

Ohio State Penitentiary- Injected live cancer cells, known as HeLa cells, into prisoners.

Ohio Soldiers and Sailors Home- Cincinnati physicians Merlin Cooper and B.K. Rachford, fused children in trials of an immunising agent effective against dysentery. Utilising different suspensions applied in different ways (intravenous, intramuscular, and subcutaneous), the researchers caused severe reactions in the children tested, effectively eliminating the vaccine for use among soldiers.

Ohio State University- MK-ULTRA Subproject 96: To secure data on European research attitudes and personality information on researchers. The problem of understanding human behaviour. Decision Making-Group Interview Methods

University of Oklahoma - Study to perform research in the field of psychology of the dissociated states and hypnosis.

Oxford University - Dr. Celia Green was researching ESP and 'out of the body experiences' during the 1960s.

Pacific Northwest Laboratory, Richland, Washington- Technetium-95 (metastable) and -96 were administered to 8 subjects. Retention and absorption of technetium were monitored by counting the bodies of subjects and by counting excretions. Doses were administered to subjects at the University of Washington. The Atomic Energy Commission funded the work of the Pacific Northwest Laboratory.

Pacific Northwest Research Foundation- From August 1963 to May 1971, 67 volunteers at the Oregon State Prison were subjected to testicular irradiation by x-rays. Radiation doses ranged from 8 to 600 roentgen in single acute exposures, except that six prisoners were irradiated a second time, one a third time, and one was given weekly irradiations of 5 roentgen per week for eleven weeks.

Pacific Institute for Bioorganic Chemistry" in Vladivostok- PSI ability.

Pacific Northwest Research Foundation- Funded radiation experiments on 67 inmates at the Oregon State Penitentiary.

Palo Alto Veterans Administration Hospital- Gregory Bateson. Bateson became the director of a hallucinogenic drug experimental clinic at Palo Alto. Pan American Health Organization- Experiments involved 696 subjects, male prisoners and female patients in the National Mental Health Hospital of Guatemala.

Parapsychology Foundation, New York- Psychoenergetic research.

Parke-Davis- Started to distribute peyote buttons to interested researchers, medical practitioners, psychiatrists and pharmacologists.

Parsons Corporation- Army began its secret aerosol testing in St. Louis Covert military operation out of an office in the 5500 block of Pershing Ave. in St. Louis. The tests involved the spraying of poor, inner-city neighbourhoods without residents' knowledge.

Panoramic Research, Inc.- Human Ecology Fund, CIA, \$80,000.

The Pas, Canada- The experiments included deliberate, sustained malnourishment and in some cases, the withholding of dental services.

Pathfinder International- Dr. Clarence Gamble, involvement in the practice of eugenics through the first half of the twentieth century and coinciding with the founding of Pathfinder. Into the 1960s, his racially biassed and unscientific beliefs clearly influenced his work in the U.S. and other countries and were manifest in his efforts to limit or reduce birth rates in certain communities,

regardless of whether or not the people in those communities expressed consent with his methods. Though Gamble died in 1966, the influence of his beliefs could be traced in Pathfinder's work into the 1970s, generally under the banner of "population control," a euphemism adopted by governments and family planning organisations at the time.

Pathfinder prospered greatly due to substantial funding from a new entity which entered the population control field with very deep pockets indeed: the United States Agency for International Development (USAID).

Patuxent Institution for Defective Delinquents- Where they are given "treatment" and are not allowed to leave until they are cured. 50 While at one time Patuxent utilised aversion therapy in the form of electroshock, it currently makes use of a "therapeutic milieu" in which an inmate gains privileges as a reward for good behaviour.

Patuxent prison in Jessup, Md- When the Asian flu pandemic was spreading, federal researchers sprayed the virus in the noses of 23 inmates to compare their reactions to those of 32 virus-exposed inmates who had been given a new vaccine.

Patrice Lumumba's University -Torsion generators are mainly performed on the basis of Biophysical Laboratory of the in the period from 1984 to 1987. Pavlov Institute of Higher Nervous Activity- Clandestine psi research. Anokhin, P.K., Koltzova, M.M., R0g0venk0, Ye.S., Rokotova, N.A. Pavlov Institute of Physiology (Leningrad)- Psychological research. Peasemore Facility, Berkshire, Wiltshire, UK -This is where Project Oaktree and PROJECT Mannequin run from, Genetic research, cloning, Military Abductions (MILAB's), cranial chip implants, Mind control and behaviour modification. NSA AL/499

Pedlow Nease Chemical Company, Inc- Location: Lock Haven, Pennsylvania

Peking University -Had trained children in psychic behaviour. "In some Chinese hospitals "Experiments with blind children also obtained results to some degree.

Pelican Bay State Prison- Dr. Haney, a professor of psychology at the University of California, Santa Cruz, interviewed 56 prisoners who had spent 10 to 28 years in solitary confinement in Pelican Bay's security housing unit, or S.H.U., including seven men he had interviewed in 1993. Some prisoners became so disoriented they began to question their own existence. 2015. Pennington Biomedical Research Center- Secured \$16.4 million in military awards. The success of the Optimising Performance for Soldiers study, which explored how maintaining normal testosterone levels affects performance

during prolonged, physically demanding missions, prompted a new \$3.5 million award. In OPS 2, Pennington Biomedical will continue the focus on discoveries that support warfighter performance and resilience under conditions of extreme stress.

Penn State University- MK-ULTRA Subproject 99:-Services related to certain physical studies which are required to develop effective materials which will influence the central nervous system. Project also supported studies on the optical rotatory power of solid and liquid crystals. Subproject 100: MKULTRA, Subproject 118: MKULTRA: Microbiology.

As consultants and as a subcontractor, who provided information on new drugs and chemicals and assisted in the screening and testing of selected new drugs and chemicals. (Project OFTEN)

University Of Pennsylvania's Experimental Psychology Unit- Dr. Orne founded

University of Pennsylvania's Institute for Human Gene Therapy- In September 1999, Jesse Gelsinger died while a participant in a gene therapy research study at the University of Pennsylvania. After his death, information divulged led Jesse's father to believe that Jesse and his family were not fully informed of the risks involved in the research.

Peoria State Hospital- 1940-starts to perform lobotomies and Skull Trephening September 1942 – Electro-Convulsive Therapy is introduced at Peoria State Hospital to treat Epilepsy.

Pfeiffer Pharmaceuticals (Atlanta)- Subproject 47: MK-ULTRA
Pfizer Inc.- G ave an antibiotic named Trovan to children with meningitis in
Nigeria, although there were doubts about its effectiveness for that disease.
Critics blamed the experiment for the deaths of 11 children and the disabling of
scores of others. Five children died on Trovan and six on ceftriaxone. But later
it was claimed that Pfizer did not have proper consent from parents to use an
experimental drug on their children and questions were raised over the
documentation of the trial. In 2009 it reached a tentative out-of-court
settlement with the Kano state government worth \$75m.

Pfizer hired investigators to look for evidence of corruption against the Nigerian attorney general in an effort to persuade him to drop the legal action. **The Philadelphia Association (PA)** -W as founded officially in 1965, by Laing, Esterson, David Cooper, John Heaton, Clancy Sigal, Sidney Briskin, Raymond Blake and Joan Cunnold.

Physics International- High-power microwave testing facility.

Physics/Consciousness Research Group- PCRG was co-founded by Jack Sarfatti and Michael Murphy at the Esalen Institute in Big Sur, California in 1974. Financed by Werner Erhard, Jean Lanier and the late George Koopman, the PCRG nurtured the creation of books like Space-Time and Beyond, The Tao of Physics, The Dancing Wu Li Masters, Cosmic Trigger, and The Roots

of Consciousness. The group included the physicists and authors, Fred Alan Wolf, Nick Herbert and Fritjof Capra, along with Saul Paul Sirag, Henry Dakin, Robert Anton Wilson, Uri Geller, Barbara Honneger, the late Brendan O Regan, George Leonard, Gary Zukav, Ira Einhorn, and artist Lynn Hershmann. According to Sarfatti, Koopman "provided money through military contracts with the Air Force and the U.S. Army Tank Command funnelled through his company Insgroup in Irvine, California."

Pitesti Prison- The objective of making them reciprocally humiliate each other, physically abuse each other and mentally torture each other. Victims were transformed into executioners; prisoners were tortured by their own friends, by their fellows in suffering. The purpose: "re-education" through physical and psychical destruction, the transformation of young people into atheists, into informers of their friends.

PIADC -Six workers test positive for African Swine Fever virus. The workers are not notified of the test results which are conducted clandestinely during routine annual physical exams.

Fort Pierce, FL- Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects. **Poison Laboratory Of The Soviet Secret Services** -A Iternatively known as Laboratory 1, Laboratory 12, and Kamera (which means "The Cell" in Russian), was a covert research-and-development facility of the Soviet secret police agencies. The laboratory manufactured and tested poisons and was reportedly reactivated in the late 1990s. 1978: Expanded into the Central Investigation Institute for Special Technology.

Polish National Health Service- Last year, three doctors and six nurses were given suspended prison terms for misleading some 200 people, mostly homeless, in the town of Grudziadz, into taking part in the new vaccine tests. They had described the shots as free vaccination against regular flu, and falsified documents to conceal some facts about the test's participants.

Political Security Directorate, Syria, (Idarat al-Amn al-Siyasi)- Torture. Damascus as well as regional, city, and local branches across the country.

Point Hope, Alaska -In Atomic Energy Commission field study code named "Project Chariot." Spread of radioactive materials over Inupiat land.

Pont-Saint-Esprit, France- A covert experiment by the CIA and the US Army's top-secret Special Operations Division, where CIA operatives peppered local food with massive amounts of LSD as part of a mind control experiment.

Powick Hospital in Worcestershire- LSD unit at the hospital, which opened in the 1950s. Powick Hospital, Malvern, Worcestershire, England-During the 1950s the hospital gained an internationally acclaimed reputation for its use of the drug LSD in psychotherapy pioneered and conducted by Ronald A. Sandison.

Princeton University- From 1979 to 2007, the tiny basement of Princeton University's engineering building was home to the Princeton Engineering Anomalies Research (PEAR) project, which aimed to determine whether there was factual basis for theories in mind/matter interaction—or in layman's terms, extrasensory perception (ESP) and telekinesis (TK). While officially expressed by university administration to be an embarrassment, the program claimed success when it was all said and done: Over the project's 28-year run it was determined by PEAR researchers that compounded data from the many trials did in fact reflect highly significant statistical deviation from what one could expect from chance alone. In other words, minds intelligent enough to teach at Princeton believe that ESP and PK exist.

Prison 15 in Angarsk, Russia- Torture sessions.

Prison S-21, Cambodia- Prisoners were repeatedly tortured and coerced into naming family members and close associates, who were in turn arrested, tortured and killed. In the early months of S-21's existence, most of the victims were from the previous Lon Nol regime and included soldiers, government officials, as well as academics, doctors, teachers, students, factory workers, monks, engineers, etc.

Proctor Foundation for Research in Ophthalmology at the University of California, San Francisco- Performed research on boarding school students between the 1967-68 and 1972-73 school years to determine the best treatment for trachoma. The study compared the efficacy of oral triple sulfa, tetracycline, and doxycycline as treatments, and also involved giving a placebo to some Native children with trachoma. The organisation did not seek informed consent from Native parents.

Profusa- "Hydrogel," a nanotechnology that is described as "microscopic robotic organisms," developed DARPA, and a private corporation called Profusa. One primary function of this technology is to gather information from the host's body, including blood pressure, blood sugar, heart rate, medications, and nutrients. However, Madej says, "it has the potential to be used for other things" as well, such as documenting how many steps one takes if a person is swimming, running, sleeping, menstruating, and potentially, even one's emotions.

Camp Polk, LA- Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects. Pont-Saint-Esprit- US had spiked the bread with LSD as part of an experiment.

Prague Psychiatric Research Institute- Began conducting his clinical experiments with LSD.

Price Fund- CIA funding front

Protechnik- Was a front company established on 24 June 1987 by the South African Defence Force to perform quality assurance testing of chemical

protective materials and equipment within a covert operation known as Project Coast.

Pingfan Complex, Japan- And other sites across China, scientists produced biological and chemical agents in large quantities, and invented new ways to use these agents as weapons of mass destruction. They tested the biological and chemical agents on prisoners to study the effects of the agents on humans, to determine survival rates for soldiers exposed to such agents, and to test the effectiveness of their weapons. Human subjects were also used in medical experiments that studied the body's resistance to extreme conditions, such as extreme cold, high pressure, and dehydration. The final phase of the human experimentation involved performing live vivisections of the prisoners without anaesthetic to extract their organs for research. The prisoners were then executed by lethal injection, and their bodies burned in large incinerators or buried in nearby mass graves. All of the defendants connected to the biological and chemical warfare units were given impunity by the US government in exchange for Unit 731's research.

Porton Down, Wiltshire, Britain- From 1945 to 1989, Porton exposed more than 3,400 human "guinea pigs" to nerve gas. Dorset Biological Warfare Experiments. Ian Foulkes was exposed to the deadly nerve agent Sarin in 1983 at the Porton Down Chemical and Biological Defence Establishment.

PSI-TECH -Has received several government contracts. For example, during the Gulf War crisis the Department for Defense asked it to use remote viewing to locate Saddam's Scud missiles sites. Last year (1992) the FBI sought PSI-TECH's assistance to locate a kidnapped Exxon executive."

Psychedelic Research Institute in Prague, Czechoslovakia- Stanislav Grof tested the value of LSD in treatment of psychologically ill patients. His goal was to observe the effect of psychedelics on the psychology of terminally-ill cancer patients. (Grof would later be involved in research at the Spring Grove Clinic.

Psychiatric Institute at the Ministry of Health for the Russian Federation-Controlled offensive behaviour.

Psychical Research Foundation, Durham-Psychoenergetic research.
Psychology and Neuroscience at Laurentian University, Ontario, Canada-Dr Michael Persinger

U.S. Army's 4th Psychological Operations Group- Enables the government to pull the strings, turn everything they touch into a weapon, be everywhere, deceive, persuade, change, influence, and inspire.

Psychophysical Research Laboratories, Princeton, NJ- Psychoenergetic research.

United States Psychotronic Association- Thomas Bearden Charles Whitehouse, board member. In 1977, Whitehouse sold the Navy a "multispectral image analyzer station" for \$5,111. The device supposedly

works by focusing psychic energies to locate hidden submarines, using pictures as its target. (McRae, Ronald, Mind Wars, St. Martin's Press, 1984, pg 4) Note: McRae has admitted to fabricating some of the more absurd elements of his book - this probably among them

Theodore Rockwell, "a prominent (Who's Who) nuclear engineer who has worked on naval nuclear propulsion systems and who also serves as vice president" (Durant, Robert J., "Will the Real Scott Jones Please Stand Up?") University of Puerto Rico- F or neurological research into the correlation between criminal behaviour and brain damage. The Puerto Rican project states that once sufficient data and "expertise" are acquired a "prospective community search can be made looking for young individuals who may suffer from undiagnosed cerebral or neurological pathology which may contribute, or in some manner be significantly associated, with criminal behaviour." L.E.A.A.

Pulkovo Observatory, Leningrad- Kozyrev, N.

Public Security Bureau, China- today's most frequent victims of psychiatric abuse are political dissidents, petitioners, and Falun Gong members. In the beginning of the 2000s, Human Rights Watch accused China of locking up Falun Gong members and dissidents in a number of Chinese mental hospitals managed by the Public Security Bureau

Princeton University- Years: 1953 -1954-CIA Monitor: Robert V. Lashbrook, Isolate and characterise the alkaloids of ipomoea sidalia choisy (Rivea Corymbosa).

Pine Gap, Australia- CIA and NSA Signals Intelligence (SIGINT) gathering station, also run Electronic Brain Link (EBL) for controlling humans and Programmable Life Forms (PGLF's), also operation Project Startalk using high frequency encoded lasers to communicate with ET's, UFO's and offworld planets

Psychological Operations Groups - Which in the UK are part of 1 Military Intelligence Brigade of the Intelligence Corp. The operation groups control PSYOPS for the three military services (army, navy, and air force).

Plum Island- Department of Agriculture's Biological Warfare Labs. Erich Traub.

Porton Down in Wiltshire- Microbiological Research Establishment. Government scientists were studying the effects of sarin and other nerve gases. On 6 May, a volunteer subject, a 20-year-old soldier, was dosed with sarin there, began foaming at the mouth, collapsed into convulsions, and died an hour later. William Sargant

The Presidio- At the Presidio of San Francisco, the Army Surgeon General formed the Western Medical Research Laboratory in 1966 to carry out research in tropical medicine, nutrition, surgery, blood replacement, pathology, and psychiatry. From 1971 to 1974, the Army opened four new

laboratory buildings at the Presidio. The facility was renamed the Letterman Army Institute of Research, as it adjoined the Letterman Army Medical Centre. LAIR was primarily a medical research centre doing specialised experimentation on artificial blood, laser physics, and treatment of trauma. **Psychotechnology Research Institute in Moscow-** U sed for human testing. The institute claims its technology can read the subconscious mind and alter behaviour.

Psychological Strategy Board- Lt. Geiger (Air Force), "This type of warfare is "primarily intended as a means of undermining collective emotional stability". The memo expresses the refinement of "definition of techniques" and issued a call for the "services of a psychiatrist or clinical psychologist, a cultural anthropologist, and a psychological warfare operator must be employed in a combined effort." The Psychological Staff Division was the "responsible office for the conduct for NSC 10/2" between the PSB and CIA (Central Intelligence Agency 1952b).

Cattle Farm 'kamenka' In Podolsk District- -As a part of these experiments various virological, biological, medical and agricultural works were carried out. The objects of these experiments were microorganisms, mice, plants, and even medical works with patients.

The farm 'Tarasovskay 'in Pushkin area- -As a part of these experiments various virological, biological, medical and agricultural works were carried out. The objects of these experiments were microorganisms, mice, plants, and even medical works with patients.

Popov Higher Naval Academy of Radio Electronics- Russia-hydroacoustics. **Public Health Service-** P harmaceutical companies and the like including Sandoz (now Novartis) and Eli Lilly and Co.

Psychological Assessment Associates Inc. -W hich operated in Washington until the mid.-1970's. CIA front. John Gittinger

Quaker -Supplied the cereal, MIT received funding for their research, and the school, presumably, provided free breakfast and entertainment for its students. The boys at Fernald ate oats coated with radioactive iron tracers, milk with radioactive calcium tracers (radioactive atoms whose decay is measured to understand chemical reactions happening in the body), and were given injections of radioactive calcium. The first two experiments' results were encouraging to Quaker: Oatmeal was no worse than farina when it came to inhibiting absorption of iron and calcium into the bloodstream. Quaker's commercial interests. "What was the genesis of these particular experiments? It

seems simply to be what are the relative benefits of oatmeal and Cream of Wheat," prosecuting attorney.

Ouaker Hill Foundation- Dr. Adelbert Ames.

Qu'Appelle reserves in southern Saskatchewan- Vaccine trial on First Nation children. The bacille Calmette-Guerin (BCG) vaccine trials were backed by the National Research Council and Indian Affairs. According to the study written by Lux titled, Perfect Subjects: Race Tuberculosis and the Qu'Appelle BCG Vaccine Trial.

Queen's College- MK-ULTRA Subproject 98:-Research on some Aspects of mass Conversion. A study into the mass psychology involved in brainwashing, mass defection, etc.

Queen's University Belfast (QUB)- While a student in the 1960s. He was shown pictures of naked men and given electric shocks if he was aroused. QinetiQ, UK- Porton Down has evolved into a multi-faceted research and development facility, partly operated by the private international defence and security technology company. DSTL listed "understanding and influencing human behaviour" among its list of research priorities, including through the "targeted manipulation of information" and "coordinated use of the full spectrum of national capabilities ... including military, non-military, overt and covert".

Racah Institute of Physics, Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Jeru.'-.alcm, Israel- Argonne laboratories.

Race Betterment Foundation -An organisation that promoted eugenics in Michigan and convened some of the first major U.S. conferences on eugenics in the 1910s.

Radio Physics Laboratory at SRI International- Edwin C. May, Ph.D., is a senior research physicist.

Radio Telemetry Laboratory- W as built by Rubinstein under Dr. Cameron's direction. Here, patients were exposed to a range of RF and electromagnetic signals and monitored for changes in behaviour. It was later stated by other staff members who had worked at the Institute that not one patient sent to the Radio Telemetry Lab showed any signs of improvement afterwards.

Rajanagarindra Psychiatric Hospital in Khon Kaen, Thailand- The military junta introduced a systematic process of 'attitude adjustment', whereby hundreds of dissidents were subjected to forcible detention and propaganda until they reformed their views of the junta; the majority did not and were subsequently charged with crimes. While psychiatrists were not employed, a

team of psychologists was involved, implying psychological warfare rather than political psychiatry

Rand Corporation- P ublished a report by R.J. MacGregor, entitled "A Brief Survey of

Literature Relating to Influence of Low Intensity Microwaves on Nervous Function." "A Direct Mechanism for the Direct Influence of Microwave Radiation on Neuroelectric Function," MacGregor sets forth the idea that the electrical component of microwave radiation induces transmembrane potentials in nerve cells and thereby disturbs nervous function and behaviour.

Randomline, Inc.- Scientist Allen Frey.

Rawalpindi, now in Pakistan- British military scientists sent hundreds of Indian soldiers into gas chambers and exposed them to mustard gas. Many suffered severe burns on their skin, including their genitals, leaving them in pain for days and even weeks. Some had to be treated in hospital. The experiments took place over more than 10 years. They were conducted by scientists from the Porton Down chemical warfare establishment.

Raytheon- A nnounced that it had partnered with a jail in Castaic, California, to use prisoners as test subjects for its Active Denial System that "fires an invisible heat beam capable of causing unbearable pain." Raytheon announced that they had made arrangements with a prison in California to test its new Active Denial System, some call it the "Death Ray." This weapon "fires an invisible heat beam capable of causing unbearable pain." The project needed test subjects and the prison needed funding. The Pentagon had denied testing in Iraq, they felt it was too tempting to be used as an "instrument of torture." (2010)

Redstone Arsenal Ala .-(Huntsville Arsenal) The Battlefield Highly Immersive Virtual Environment Laboratory, or BHIVE Lab, occupies an area in building 5400 here that's steeped in history.

Republican Hospital of the City of Riga, Latvian SSR- Krasnyansky, O.A., Markis, L.A., Rusinova, Z.G.

Research Institute of Psychology, Ukrainian SSR Academy of Sciences-Gubko, A., Leontovich, M.A., Leontovich, A.V.

University of Richmond- Synthesise new drugs and modify old ones to determine their effectiveness in modifying behaviour and the function of the central nervous system.

This project involved the search for, and preliminary testing of, materials (not mentioned) which might alter consciousness and have other physiologic effects (alteration of blood pressure, cardiovascular responses, body temperature or anti-cancer properties).

Riga Medical Institute- H as shown that high-tension static electrical fields affect the neurohumoral regulatory systems

University of Rochester NY the Manhattan Annex- (Harold Hodge) University of Rochester, to study a variety of drugs on student volunteers in an attempt to produce amnesia.

University of Rochester included "Study of the Metabolism of Plutonium, polonium, radium, etc. in human subjects".

Rockefeller Foundation- Powick Hospital in Worcestershire (a psychiatric unit which was closed in 1989) which had a dedicated LSD experimentation unit

750 Guatemalan victims of a US-Government-sponsored experiment to infect them with syphilis and other sexually transmitted diseases

The Rockefeller Foundation poured money into the occupied German republic for a medical specialty known as "psychiatric genetics." The Rockefeller Foundation helped fund the research institutions in Germany behind the Nazi programs of sterilisation and euthanasia.

Rockefeller Institute for Medical Research- Tested a drug (luetin) to diagnose syphilis on uninformed mental patients, patients in public hospitals, and orphans.

Romania, Northern Bucharest -Secret facility location. Involved in torture activities perpetrated by the United States Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) Rongelap Island- Brookhaven National Laboratory. Chromium-51. Exposure to Fallout Radiation.

Roodeplaat Research Laboratories (RRL) -(Afrikaans: Roodeplaat Navorsings Laboratoriums) was a front company established in 1983 by the South African Defence Force to research, test and produce biological weapons within a covert operation known as Project Coast.

Universidad Nacional de Rosario- Remote Sensing.

Rossville, Canada- Nutritional experiments were conducted between 1942 and 1952 using Indigenous children from residential schools.

Round Table Foundation- Involved in psychotropic research, Andrija Puharich. Puharich, who had begun his work at the Edgewood Military Laboratory with funding from the OSS.

Royal Air Force base Portreath- C hemical weapons tests.

Royal Marsden Hospital, London- Acquired body parts from doctors for Project Sunshine. Records show that almost half the bodies were of newborn or very young babies.

Royal Mental Hospital in Glasgow- Ewen Cameron under eugenicist Sir David Henderson.

Royal Victoria Military Hospital at Netley- Links with Porton Down and experiments with LSD in the 1950s. A ffiliated with McGill University, part of the CIA's MK-ULTRA program of covert mind-control.

The Russell Sage Foundation -For two decades employed Hastings H. Hart, a Congregationalist minister-turned-social worker, as a senior official and a

consultant; while Hart didn't support the sterilisation of the feebleminded, he was an avid proponent of mandatorily sequestering them.

Russia's Military Unit 10003- Military ESP and parapsychology.

Russian Academy of Sciences- Igor Smirnov. psychotropic weapons.

Russia's Scientific Research Institute- S tudies of human psyche. Igor Smirnov.

Rutgers University- To interview Hungarian refugees regarding Sociology of the Communist system in the throes of revolution. The Central Intelligence Agency secretly funnelled at least \$5,000 to the sociology department.

Rutgers University has been a significant hub for counterterrorism studies, intelligence gathering and enhancing public safety since about January 2015 when the state university started working alongside the CIA and the DIA on grant-based projects, funded federally, to facilitate recruitment and training of Rutgers students interested in intelligence and national security.

An experiment funded by the U.S. military meant to sharpen soldiers' minds for the battlefield has found a way to improve memory: by zapping subjects' brains with tiny bursts of electricity during sleep. DARPA-funded research 2019.

Naval Hospital St. Albans- Was disestablished in 1973. St. Albans was the major Navy cancer treatment hospital on the East Coast in the late 1940s to early 1960s. In 1952 a medical physicist was assigned to help physicians develop therapeutic use of radioisotopes.

Saint Barts Hospital, London- Leonas Petrauskas.

Saint Elizabeths- Was probably the first hospital in the U.S. to have conducted covert psychoactive drug experiments on unwitting patients on behalf of the government. Winfred Overholser, MD. Overholser's crew administered the hallucinogen mescaline to various test subjects. Then in the spring of 1943, they perfected the right mix of marijuana and tobacco to produce a "state of irresponsibility" in the subject.

Saint Elizabeth's, Washington D.C.- This location is a common connection between the CIA and Mind Control research. facilities at St. Elizabeths Hospital were used to carry out projects under the auspices of the "truth drug" committee for the Office of Strategic Services, the CIA's predecessor agency. Saint Eugene's Mission School- First Nations band in the Cranbrook area said they had discovered the remains of an estimated 182 children. (2021)

Saint Francis Memorial Hospital, San Francisco- MK-ULTRA Subproject 124: (See 2 and 140) Investigate the possibility of inducing a drug-like state through the simple expedient of carbon dioxide inhalation.

MK-ULTRA Subproject 140: Under cover of "Thyroid Research" the project was to design and conduct controlled experiments involving pharmacological and clinical tests on human volunteers.

Saint Jean de Dieu (Canada)- Some of the orphans remember being treated by Ewen Cameron. Cameron was known to use chlorpromazine in his experiments, combining drugs, electric shock, and lobotomies.

Saint. John's University (Psychology Department), Jamaica, NY-Psychoenergetic research.

St. Joseph's College, Philadelphia- Psychoenergetic research.

Saint Joseph's Home in Broadmeadows- Children's homes to test a new quadruple antigen vaccination, which included a polio vaccine possibly contaminated with a monkey virus linked to cancer.

Saint Julien Hospital, Canada- Electroshock, beatings and solitary confinement were routinely meted out as punishment.

Saint Mary's Indian Residential School, Canada- It was run by the Roman Catholic Church near the Devil's Gap Marina until 1972. Records show at least 36 students died while attending the school.

Saint Michel Archange Hospital (Canada)- Many Duplessis orphans disappeared in secret experiments. Many disappeared in drug trials.

Saint Petersburg Institute of Fine Mechanics and Optics- Investigated the phenomenon of Kulagina, which has been studied since 1977

Salk Institute for Biological Studies- Carlos Izpisua Belmonte.

Salt Pit and Cobalt -The code names of an isolated clandestine CIA black site prison and interrogation centre outside Bagram Air Basein Afghanistan. the same facility that Guantanamo Bay detainees referred to as the 'dark prison.' Samadhi Tank Co., Inc. -Was started in 1972 and named by Dr. Lilly. The first tanks were designed by Glenn Perry with Dr.Lilly's assistance.

Samuel Stouffer's Research Branch of the U.S. Army's Division of Morale-U.S. centres of psychological warfare and related studies.

San Antonio Contraceptive Study -Conducted on 70 poor MexicanAmerican women. Half received oral contraceptives and the other placebo. No informed consent.

San Diego State College- Doctor Ryzl.

San Jose Island, Panama Canal Zone- Chemical Weapons Testing Site Using Human Subject

University Hospital, University of California. San Francisco- Patients were injected with plutonium. These experiments were carried out by the Manhattan Project.

University of California, San Francisco- Conducted the experiments of at least 2,600 incarcerated men in the 1960s and 1970s, including putting pesticides and herbicides on the men's skin and injecting it into their veins.

The experiments were conducted at the California Medical Facility, a prison hospital in Vacaville that's about 50 miles northeast of San Francisco. The practice was halted in 1977.

U.C. San Francisco Medical Center- Dr. Joseph Gilbert Hamilton, a Manhattan Project doctor in charge of the human experiments in California, had Stevens injected with Pu-238 and Pu-239 without informed consent.

University of California Hospital in San Francisco- Exposed 29 patients, some with rheumatoid arthritis, to total body irradiation (100–300 rad dose) to obtain data for the military.

San Jose island, Panama- Effects of psychochemical agents. Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects.

San Jose State University- Doctor Ryzl

San Quentin State Prison- Dr. Leo Stanley, chief surgeon at San Quentin Prison for forty years.

Sandia Corporation- A secret meeting in New Mexico between U.S. and Soviet scientists involving the exchange of information regarding the biological hazards and safety levels of EMR.

Saratov Prison Hospital, Russia- Makarov said he was first tortured in February 2020 after refusing to confess to a supposed plot against the prison administration.

He claims he was then subjected to continuous violent sexual abuse by three men.

"For 10 minutes they beat me, ripped my clothes. And for, let's say, the next two hours they raped me every other minute with mop handles," he said. "When I fainted, they would splash me with cold water and throw me back onto the table."

Science Unlimited Research Foundation, San Antonio-Psychoenergetic research.

Science Applications International Corporation- Nonlethal technology in a form which might be used to control large populations.

USAF Scientific Advisory Board- Predicts that the military will have the tools to make potential enemies see, hear, and believe things that do not exist.

Scientific and Technical Society of Radio Engineering and

Telecommunications at the Popov Institute in Moscow- Its stated objectives are to discuss physical, biological, and philosophical aspects of bioinformation and to acquaint the Soviet scientific community with bio- communications research conducted outside the Soviet Union.

Scientific Research Institute of Pharmacology and Toxicology, Kiev-Nedopekin, T.K., Portnyagina, V.A., Stolyarenko, L.G., Vasilyeva, Ye.V.

Scientific Research Institute of Traumatology and Orthopedics, Riga-Kikut, R.

School of the Americas- Now named; Western Hemisphere Institute for Security Cooperation (WHINSEC). Latin American paramilitary groups working for the CIA and U.S. military received training in psychological techniques.

School of Aviation Medicine (SAM) -SAM was involved in a relatively large number

of human experiments

Scottish Rite Foundation- Provides funding for schedule 1 human drug research. Funding for MK-Ultra research. Winfred Overholser, Scottish Rite chief psychiatrist. (Scottish Rite of Freemasonry).

Seattle's Pacific Northwest Research Foundation -Dr. Carl Heller applied for a grant using prisoners at the Oregon State Penitentiary in Salem. (Radiation)

Sechenov Institute (Leningrad)- Fadayeva, D.K., Traugott, N.N.

Secret prisons of SBU- Secret detention facilities operated by Security Service of Ukraine (SBU) in Eastern Ukraine to incarcerate Russian-backed separatists. During the incarceration the detainees were tortured, beaten, subjected to electric shocks, threatened with sexual abuse, execution, and retaliation against family members in order to retrieve their confessions.

The Seed, in Ft. Lauderdale Florida- The techniques and principles of The Seed were remarkably similar to those employed by the Asklepion Society in Marion Prison, including attack "therapy" humiliations, intense group pressure, forced confessions, and sleep deprivation An extensive spying and informing system was developed, and absolute loyalty to the group was demanded. NIDA (National Institute on Drug Abuse), HEW and LEAA provided The Seed with millions of dollars in several years. operated between 1970 and 2001. At its height in the 1970s The Seed had locations in Fort Lauderdale, Fort Myers, Dade County.(5] and St. Petersburg.

SenseTime -China's largest artificial intelligence firm, which the administration says has developed facial recognition programs that can determine a target's ethnicity, with a focus on identifying ethnic Uyghurs.

The Sequoia Retreat Center- LSD experiments. (Harold A Abramson/Louis J. "Jolyon" West/Betty G Eisner)

Serbsky Psychiatric Institute (Russia)- Rozhnov, V. Moscow Serbsky Institute visited Beijing in 1957 in order to help their Chinese 'brethren', the same psychiatrists who promoted the system of political abuse of psychiatry in the Soviet Union.: 243 As a consequence, diagnostics in China were not much different than those which were made in the Soviet Union.: 244 The only difference was that the Soviet Union preferred "sluggish schizophrenia" as a diagnosis, and that China generally cleaved to the diagnosis of "paranoia" or

"paranoid schizophrenia".: 244 However, the results were the same: long hospitalizations in mental hospitals, involuntary treatments with neuroleptics, torture, abuse, all of which were aimed at breaking the victim's will. Serbsky Central Scientific Research Institute of Forensic Psychiatry, Moscow, USSR- Lunts, D.R. (Possible Kgb Colonel), Maltseva, M,M.

Martynenko (Fnu), Nmorozov, G.7. (Director), Pechern Ikova (Fnu), Tabanova (Fpu), Taltse (Fnu), Turova, Z.G.

Sexual Sterilisation Act, Canada- Alberta, starting in 1928, close to 3,000 youth deemed "mentally unfit" were surgically altered without their knowledge or consent under the Sexual Sterilisation Act. The sterilisations stopped and the law was repealed in 1972.

"Shabak", Israel- subjected a number of detainees at al-Mascobiyya interrogation center to severe physical and psychological torture, without any form of monitoring and protection.

Shanghai Jiao Tong University- Team of Chinese scientists has developed a telekinetic technology that allows a person to remotely control a metasurface with their mind. Uses a person's brain waves to wirelessly control a programmable metasurface using Bluetooth. What makes the team's approach unique is that unlike previous experiments that required a direct, wired connection to the metasurface, the subject is able to manipulate it remotely. Shelby County Penal Farm- Alleging that a prerequisite for participation in a work release program is the taking of Antabuse, a drug which induces severe and violent illness whenever a drink of alcohol is taken.

Camp Sibert, AL- Chemical Weapons Testing Using Human Subjects Siemens -E lectrical shock therapy.

Silent Sounds, Inc.- It is now possible, using supercomputers, to analyse human emotional EEG patterns and replicate them, then store these "emotion signature clusters" on another computer and, at will, "silently induce and change the emotional state in a human being."

Sixth Bureau of the Jiangsu Province Ministry of State Security (MSS)- T he primary intelligence agency of China.

Skid Row Cancer Study "Bowery Series"- More than 1,200 homeless, alcoholic men from New York's Bowery neighbourhood were recruited. Participants travelled to Francis Delafield Hospital, where they received a physical exam, X-rays, and various invasive tests, including a prostate biopsy that involved the removal of a sizable amount of tissue. Men whose samples were found to contain cancerous cells then underwent aggressive treatment, typically including the removal of the prostate gland and testes and administration of a synthetic oestrogen.

Sloan-Kettering Institute- 300 healthy females were injected with live cancer cells without being told. The doctors stated that they knew at the time that it might cause cancer.

The Smithsonian- Government documents have linked the Smithsonian to the CIA's mind control program known as MK-ULTRA. The Smithsonian Institution said yesterday that its involvement with the Central Intelligence Agency's MK-ULTRA mind-control program was limited to a review of paper work on two foreign population analyses by an unidentified former research associate.

Society for the Investigation of Human Ecology - Dr. Bender was notified that her planned LSD experiments would be partially and surreptitiously funded by the Society for the Investigation of Human Ecology (SIHE), another CIA front group then located in Forest Hills, New York.

To exploit the research potential represented by a group of 142 criminal-sexual psychopaths confined at the Ionic State Hospital. The Agency believed that patients had the same kind of motivation for withholding certain information that is comparable to operational interrogation situations in the field.

MK-ULTRA Subproject 136: ESP Research – Experimental analysis of extrasensory perception. To evaluate the possibility of using extrasensory perception in the intelligence field.

Söder Hospital- Brain implants.

SOPHIA (2008 - present)- University of Arizona. Body of research including broader claims of after-death communication, such as communion with discarnate entities (spirit guides, angels, divine higher power) under the program name SOPHIA.

South African Defence Forces (SADF) -During the apartheid era had been forced to submit to "curing" their homosexuality, both by electroshock therapies and by botched sex changes. A study called "The Aversion Project". The South African Defence Force forced lesbian and gay military personnel to undergo "sex-change" operations. This was part of a secret program to purge homosexuality in the army.

University of Southern California- An experiment funded by the U.S. military meant to sharpen soldiers' minds for the battlefield has found a way to improve memory: by zapping subjects' brains with tiny bursts of electricity during sleep. DARPA-funded research 2019.

November 2017, the University of Southern California conducted an experiment, in which for the first time a brain implant effectively improved human memory by increasing the working memory by 25% and the short-term memory by 15%.

Social Science Research Council- Discussed an experiment: create racial orphanages, separate institutions where children of different races would be received as close to birth as possible. The idea was to compare white and black children under similar conditions. Scientists could closely monitor the institutionalised children as they developed to figure out whether differences

were due to innate characteristics or environmental influence. Nursery schools and foster homes were proposed as places of comparative study too, but most of the committee's discussions focused on the idea of racial orphanages.

Social Psychiatry Research Institute (SPRI)- Sites in New York and New Jersey, SPRI has since its inception in 1970 worked on more than 100 studies for psychiatric drugs developed by major pharmaceutical companies including Wyeth-Ayerst, Eli Lilly and Co., Smith-Kline Beecham Pharmaceuticals, Pharmacia and Upjohn, Pfizer Inc., Solvay Pharmaceuticals, Bristol-Myers Squibb, Burroughs Wellcome and Janssen Pharmaceutica. Dr. Ari Kiev Sonoma State Hospital- In northern California. From 1950 to 1960, children with cerebral palsy were left at this particular hospital, where doctors reportedly performed unnecessary spinal taps as well as experimentation with radiation on them. The investigation reports over 1,400 deaths of children due to the experimentation done at the hospital.

South Oaks Hospital - Abramson edited the proceedings of the Second International Conference on the Use of LSD in Psychotherapy and Alcoholism, published in 1967 as The Use of LSD in Psychotherapy and Alcoholism. The conference took place at the South Oaks Hospital in Amityville, New York. He also worked as director of research at South Oaks Psychiatric Hospital. **Southern Illinois University at Carbondale** -Transformed Marion into a penal laboratory without legal and moral consequences".

University of Southern California- Doctor Charles Tart.

Southeast Hypnosis Research Center in Dallas, Texas- According to Pullman: Soviet diplomats will be able to sit' in their foreign 'embassies and use ESP to steal the secrets of their enemies.

Soviet Academy of Medicine, Institute of Psychiatric Research- Shchirina, M.G., Snezhnevskiy, A.V., Vartanian, M.

Soviet Academy of Science- Extrasensory perception.

Soviet Institute of Clinical and Experimental Medicine- Novosibirsk. Extrasensory perception. The experiments were carried out as follows: the volunteers were seated in the centre of the room between two concave mirrors. At this time, scientists tried to "transfer bioenergy to the patient", it was assumed that the mirrors would enhance the effect.

Special Operations Division (SOD) -At Fort Detrick in August 1949 sprayed Serratia bacteria into the vents of the Pentagon's air-conditioning system. SOD demonstrated civilian susceptibility to such attacks by releasing Serratia microbes from the decks of two United States naval vessels anchored in the Atlantic. In September 1950 the tests were successfully repeated in the Pacific, where "nearly every one of the 800,000 people in San Francisco exposed to the cloud at normal breathing rate inhaled 5,000 or more fluorescent particles." Spring Grove State Hospital, in Baltimore, Maryland- The test subjects were given enormous amounts of LSD over an extended period – 100

micrograms per day for two weeks, which was increased by a further 100 micrograms daily thereafter to combat rising tolerance levels.

Spring Grove Clinic in Catonsville, Maryland- A series of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD) studies performed from 1963 to 1976 on patients with psychotic illnesses. Later, Spring Grove was rebuilt into the Maryland Psychiatric Research Center. Many of the patients who took part in these experiments federally funded by the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) were admitted against their own wishes. Over the course of the experiments, over 700 people were treated with LSD.

Springfield, Missouri- A federal prison inmates being shackled all day long by both arms and legs to their steel beds (as part of Project START).

SRI International- Investigating psi phenomena for the U.S. government. **Stanford Medical School-** Subproject 85: MKULTRA, Subproject 86: MKULTRA-Telecontrol

Stanford Research Institute -W as named "ELF and Mind Control." was shifted in 1988 to Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC), under the direction of Edwin May.

Stanford University- Years: 1953-1958-CIA Monitors: and Robert V. Lashbrook.

Stare Kiejkuty, Poland- the former head of the current Polish national intelligence agency, Agencja Wywiadu, confirmed that in the Stare Kiejkuty facility there are two "internal zones" to which CIA officers have access; one of these (referred to as Strefa B) is officially the home of OSAW. Other Polish intelligence officials have confirmed that American personnel associated with the facility have been known to reside in the area for several months at a time State Pedagogical Institute in Sverdlovsk- Since the mid 1960s, the "eyeless sight" fad has subsided and serious research has proceeded quietly. Stateville Penitentiary - Malaria Study was a controlled study of the effects of malaria on the prisoners of Stateville Penitentiary near Joliet, Illinois, beginning in the 1940s. The study was conducted by the Department of Medicine (now the Pritzker School of Medicine) at the University of Chicago in conjunction with the United States Army and the U.S. State Department. Stewart Indian School in Carson City, Nevada- The study compared the efficacy of oral triple sulfa, tetracycline, and doxycycline as treatments, and also involved giving a placebo to some Native children with trachoma. The studies lasted 4-5 months each, and children who received placebos were treated with medication at the end of each study. Because trachoma was considered "mild" by those conducting this research, they did not view the delay in treatment of those students receiving the placebo as harmful to the children, despite the discomfort experienced by those afflicted with the disease. Strong Memorial Hospital, Rochester, New York- Patients were injected with plutonium. These experiments were carried out by the Manhattan Project.

Subliminal Projection Company, Inc- The use of subliminal perception In the advertising.

Swedish Hospital in Seattle- Subjects were injected with Phosphorus-32. for purposes only of calibrating equipment.

University of Sydney, AUS- MK-ULTRA psychiatrist Martin Theodore Orne, performed an experiment titled 'Antisocial Behaviour and Hypnosis'.

University of Sydney Psychology- Faculty head, Alfred Gordon Hammer, approved Subproject 84. Gordon Hammer (then APS Chair). Professor Martin Orne. In 1960, Professor Orne's work took him to the University of Sydney.

Syracuse University (Communications Studies Lab)- Psychoenergetic research.

Systems Consultants Inc- SCI, founded in 1966, is a military contractor which studies intelligence electronic warfare and sensor technology. They receive most of their funding from the Navy.

T

Naval Medical Research unit, Taipei- Body Composition and Starvation. Taiwan National Defense Department- In the spring of 1984, Yu was a lieutenant colonel serving in the National Defense Department of Taiwan. At that time, Yu read a classified document from the department that he serviced under. The document said the Military Police Department of Taiwan had purchased several of the MindReading Machines from the United States (In Taiwan, it was called Psychological LanguageMachine).

Tavistock Institute- The basic ideas of mind control originated in 1921, in Tavistock, a research centre of the British Intelligence Service, and then they were developed in Germany, mainly in the Nazi concentration camp, Dachau. Lewin is credited with much of the original Tavistock research into mass brainwashing applying the results of repeated trauma and torture (of individuals) in mind control to society at large.

The fourth element is the psychological-warfare branch of the British secret intelligence service.

Technical Service Division CIA- Explored use of "radiation, electro-shock, various fields of psychology, psychiatry, sociology, and anthropology, graphology, harassment substances, and paramilitary devices and materials" to control human behaviour

TeGenero, Germany- The disastrous 'Elephant Man Drug Trial'. TGN1412. Temara Interrogation Center/ Temara Secret Detention Center (Arabic: معتقل تمارة السري)- An extrajudicial detainment and secret prison facility of

Morocco located within a forested area of Rabat, Morocco. Frequently reported methods of torture include beatings, the suspension of the body in contorted positions, and the threat of rape or other sexual abuse of the detainees. Other reported methods include rape by the forced insertion of objects such as bottles into the anus, sleep deprivation, cigarette burns, and the application of live electrodes to the body.

University of Tennessee- Dr. Lester Middlesworth. Biodistribution tracking where compounds of interest travel in an experimental human subject. Fort Terry- A secret army base on Plum Island, off the eastern tip of Long Island, which was used to test toxins too deadly to be brought on to the US mainland.

University of Texas at Austin- MK-ULTRA Subproject 138: Research on biomedical instrumentation To develop a capability for remote testing (Polygraph, EKG, etc.) for use in indirect psychological and medical assessments.

Texas Christian University- Saul Sells, MK-ULTRA contractor. Activation of human behaviour by remote means. A review of literature and scientific developments related to the recording, analysis and interpretation of bioelectric signals from the human organism. Subproject 119: MKULTRA

University of Texas-Dallas- T eam is identifying stimulation parameters to maximise plasticity, and comparing the effects of invasive versus non-invasive stimulation in people with tinnitus as they perform complex learning tasks such as acquiring a foreign language. (DARPA/TNT)

Texas Department of Corrections.- 1995 Dr. Garth Nicolson, uncovers evidence that the biological agents used during the Gulf War had been manufactured in Houston, TX and Boca Raton, Fl and tested on prisoners in the Texas Department of Corrections.

Texas Research Institute of Mental Sciences (TRIMS), Houston, Texas-Dr. Neil Burch, the Head of the Psychophysiology Section of TRIMS, conducted polygraph research on the Agency's behalf for LSR/ORD. Dr. Burch used a member of the Texas Department of Public Safety, a Texas Ranger, as the polygraph examiner in portions of the study.

Thailand- B lack site.CIA employees and contractors took over and began the torture of Abu Zubaydah and the FBI agents left. Coded: Green

Third Bureau- When they are running out of subjects, a black van known as 'the crow' turns up and picks out a few more prisoners, sowing panic among the rest. The crow comes about once a month and takes forty or fifty people off to an unknown destination."

Tomsk Polytechnic University- Quartz resonators and detectors of radioactivity.

Tower Fund- CIA funding front.

Trapdoor Facility, Brecon Beacons, South Wales, UK.-This is where Genetic research and modification, Cloning, Soul Transference, and clone reprogramming is carried out.

Tuba City Boarding School, Tuba City, Arizona- 1971-1973, The study compared the efficacy of oral triple sulfa, tetracycline, and doxycycline as treatments, and also involved giving a placebo to some Native children with trachoma. The studies lasted 4-5 months each, and children who received placebos were treated with medication at the end of each study. Because trachoma was considered "mild" by those conducting this research, they did not view the delay in treatment of those students receiving the placebo as harmful to the children, despite the discomfort experienced by those afflicted with the disease.

Tulane University, New Orleans, Louisiana- Tulane had indeed signed an army "facility security clearance" for the Department of Psychiatry and Neurology in 1956. Dr. Robert G. Heath (of Tulane Medical School). In 2002, the CIA contact at Tulane was Political Science Professor and former Deputy Provost Robert S. Robins, a former intelligence officer who at the time was conducting CIA-related research from the Provost's Office in Tulane's Norman Mayer Building.

The first involved efforts to transplant chimpanzee kidneys into human patients at Tulane University, funded by the Public Health Service and NIH. **Tuol Sleng, "Medical Unit", Cambodia-** There is clear evidence that patients in Cambodia were sliced open and had organs removed with no anaesthetic. The camp's director, Kang Kek Iew, has acknowledged that "live prisoners were used for surgical study and training. Draining blood was also done."

UCLA- Conduct resilience training for Marines and their families at nine military bases across the United States and in Okinawa, Japan.

Tony LaMadrid commits suicide after participating in study on relapse of schizophrenics withdrawn from medication at UCLA.

UCLA's Neuropsychiatry Institute- 969 West was appointed as head of department and director. His research covered many fields: alcoholism, hallucinogenic drugs, sleep deprivation, violent behaviour, the hippie culture and cults. In 1972 initiated the UCLA Violence Project, which was approved by Governor Ronald Reagan. Before it was discontinued due to public outcry, one of the initial plans of UCLA Violence Project was to implant electrodes and remote monitoring devices in the brains of violent sex offenders at Vacaville State Prison.

Uganda- U.S.-funded doctors failed to give the AIDS drug AZT to all the HIV-infected pregnant women in a study even though it would have protected their newborns.

Uighur region of China- Nazi-style concentration camps.

Umedalen State Mental Hospital -771 prefrontal lobotomies were performed 1947-1958 with an overall postoperative mortality of 7.4 %. Most of the patients operated on from Umedalen were women (61.2%) and most of the patients were diagnosed with schizophrenia. Of all the lobotomies performed in Sweden (approx. 4,500), 28% had been carried out at the Sidsjön and Umedalen State Mental Hospitals.

Union of Free Hungarian Students at Berkeley- C.I.A. front organisation. Nicholas Nagy-Talavera.

Unit 504, Israel- Military Intelligence Unit 504, which sends undercover agents to missions overseas. Unit 504 operates agents in foreign countries and within the West Bank and Gaza Strip, who provide intelligence that is analysed within the Military Intelligence Directorate.

Loaded with tranquillisers and psychiatric drugs, he was gripped by three male nurses in white gowns, who took him to the treatment room. He was apathetic, his eyes were glazed, his gaze unfocused. They made him lie on a bed and attached electric cables to his head. This was the first electric shock treatment administered to Maj. Amit, a former outstanding intelligence officer in Israel Defense Forces Unit 504. (2020)

U.S. Advisory Committee- Drugs causing mental derangement; screening tests for psychotomimetic drugs; antibiotics; venoms; specific enzyme inhibitors; neuromuscular blocking agents; ganglion blocking agents; alkaloids; cardioactive steroids; and interim conclusions.

U.S. Health Service- Funded the Danish research project. During experiments meant to reveal psychopathic traits and map out the link between schizophrenia and heredity, children had electrodes put on their body and had to listen to loud, shrill noises.

USEFA (Australia) -Received funding through a CIA conduit known as the Institute

of International Education.

USSR Academy of Medical Sciences (Leningrad)- Bekhtereva, N.P., Budashevsky, B.G. Orlov, V.A.

USSR Academy of Sciences (Moscow)- Bashkirov, O.A., Bogachenko, L.S., Briks, Z.N., Felbaum, A. I., Fuflygina, T.P., Geras Imchuk, V.A., I Vanov-Smolensky, A.G., Korbatov, B.M., Maslennikova, V.M., Muchnik, I.B., Naroditskaia, G.D., Novik, I.B., Seredina, M.I., Shitl'man, E.V., Strokhina, T.V.

Unit 731 -L ocated near Harbin in Japanese-occupied Manchuria. commanded by Shiro Ishii. Established in 1936. Thousands of human beings were

experimented on and killed at Unit 731. Unit 731 faculty's observation of Marutas included their reaction to bubonic plague, typhoid, paratyphoid A and B, typhus, anthrax, smallpox, tularemia, infectious jaundice, gas gangrene, tetanus, cholera, dysentery, glanders, scarlet fever, undulant fever, tick encephalitis, "songo" or epidemic hemorrhagic fever, whooping cough, diphtheria, pneumonia, erysipelas, epidemic cerebrospinal meningitis, venereal diseases, tuberculosis, salmonella, frostbites, and many more deadly viruses, germs, and bacteria.

Utah State Prison- Inmates had blood samples taken which were mixed with radioactive chemicals and reinjected back into their bodies.

UVITOR in Bangkok, Thailand- Research into torsion fields.

California (Prison) Medical Facility, Vacaville --Conducted experiments of at least 2,600 incarcerated men in the 1960s and 1970s, including putting pesticides and herbicides on the men's skin and injecting it into their veins. University of California, San Francisco

Vacaville program of "Anectine treatment". Dr. Arthur Nugent, chief psychiatrist at Vacaville, when he observed that the Anectine treatment gave the "patient" the feelings of suffocation and drowning, of terror and horror, and made him feel "as though he were on the brink of death. "

MKSEARCH 3 - Testing at Vacaville, Hamilton.

Vanderbilt University -I n the late 1940's, eight hundred pregnant women were exposed to radiation to determine the effects of radiation on foetal development. The Advisory Committee found that at least 27 experiments exposed pregnant or nursing mothers and their babies in nontherapeutic research between 1944–1974. Gave 829 pregnant mothers in Tennessee what they were told were "vitamin drinks" that would improve the health of their babies. The mixtures contained radioactive iron and the researchers were determining how fast the radioisotope crossed into the placenta. (Four of the women's babies died from cancers as a result of the experiments, and the women experienced rashes, bruises, anaemia, hair/tooth loss, and cancer.

George Peabody College for Teachers in Nashville (now part of Vanderbilt University)

University of Virginia (School of Medicine Dept, of Psychiatry), Charlottesville, VA

Psychoenergetic research.

University of Virginia: Division of Perceptual Studies- A research unit within the Department of Psychiatric Medicine, was established by Dr. Ian

Stevenson in 1967. The division is still actively holding the field of Parapsychology afloat in North America as one of the only university-sanctioned paranormal research programs remaining in the U.S.

Medical College of Virginia -Performed experiments on severe burn victims, most of them poor and black, without their knowledge or consent, with funding from the Army and in collaboration with the AEC. In the experiments, the subjects were exposed to additional burning, experimental antibiotic treatment, and injections of radioactive isotopes. The amount of radioactive phosphorus-32 injected into some of the patients, 500 microcuries (19 MBq), was 50 times the "acceptable" dose for a healthy individual; for people with severe burns, this likely led to significantly increased death rates.

Veluweland in Ederveen- LSD. Most of these patients were classified as "neurotics" and originated from wealthier social backgrounds. They were registered as "guests", not "patients", in Veluweland, indicating their higher social status.'

Vermont State Hospital- Dr. Robert W. Hyde. director of research at the Vermont State Hospital. experimental drugs, experienced repetitive electroshock therapy. a personality study at the Vermont State Hospital between 1963 and 1966 titled, "The Use of Programmed Instruction with Disturbed Students" and funded by the National Institute of Mental Health.

The VERITAS (2006 - 2008)- University of Arizona. Created with the primary aim of exploring the possibility that human consciousness might survive the experience of physical death. From 2006 to 2008, VERITAS explored survival (existence of the personality beyond death) and mediumship Vietnam Mental Hospital- Consider the instance of the psychiatrist from California, working as a volunteer in a Vietnam mental hospital. He found their major problem was a lack of a desire to work. But it was only after the use of electroconvulsive treatment and eventual threats of total starvation that he was able to force his already malnourished patients to work as forced labourers in the vulnerable outposts of the United States Special Forces.

Vipeholm Hospital- Patients who were intellectually disabled in Lund, Sweden, were fed large amounts of sweets to provoke dental caries (1945–1955). The experiments were sponsored both by the sugar industry and the dentist community, in an effort to determine whether carbohydrates affected the formation of cavities.

Vladimir Prison-(100 miles east of Moscow)- Torture prison. Verwoerd Hospital, Pretoria South Africa- C ollaborated with Brookhaven National Laboratory to study ascorbic acid labelled with Carbon-14 in Bantu tribesmen. School of Medicine at Wake Forest University in North Carolina- The study group consisted of three patients with brain tumours that had been scanned previously with either radioactive copper or arsenic. Gamma globulin labelled with I124 was injected and multiple scans were conducted to determine how effectively the labelled protein concentrated in tumours. A typical level of administered activity was 260 microcuries of I124. Up to five scans were performed on each patient.

Walla Walla State Prison, Washington -S tate where prisoners were recruited to a study of the effect of radiation on testicles (prisoners agreed to undergo vasectomy after exposure to radiation).

Walter Reed Army Medical Centre- Dr. Joseph C. Sharp and Mark Grove equipment that had the capacity to convert sound waves into microwave radiation that enabled him to transmit threatening voices into a subject's head. The first un-classified successful transmission of the human voice directly into the skull of a living person was performed by Dr. Joseph C. Sharp, of the Walter Reed Army Institute of Research in 1974.

WRAIR's Experimental Therapeutics (ET) branch drug discovery and development enterprise created to protect military personnel from death, disease, and injury and meet Army and DOD mission requirements. While its historical focus has been radioprotection and parasitic disease, ET applies its core competencies of medicinal, synthetic, and analytical chemistry as well as clinical pharmacology to all therapeutic areas within the Medical Research and Development Command's portfolio. WRAIR maintains a network of expeditionary laboratories to conduct its mission.

Washington State Prison- 64 inmates received testicular irradiation from x-rays. Each subject was irradiated once, and doses ranged from 7 to 400 roentgen. Following irradiation, tissue samples and sperm were examined for indications of damage; urine samples were examined for hormone levels. The Atomic Energy Commission requested \$505,000 to support these studies, which were conducted by University of Washington Researchers.

University of Washington - Home to Roy Prosterman (of the Phoenix Program) and mind control psychologist Dr. Donald Dudley. James Dille. Researchers irradiated the testicles of 232 prisoners to determine the effects of radiation on testicular function. When these inmates later left prison and had children, at least four of them had offspring born with birth defects. The exact number is unknown because researchers never followed up on the status of the subjects.

University of Washington, the New York Times reported the death of an 18-year-old college honour student one of 40 volunteers in "an experiment connected with war research on blood preservation."

Project Revere declassified documents show that the US Air Force's Human Resources Research Institute funded a significant amount of money to Washington University to undertake the project. The team chosen for the project was a group of Psychology and Mass-Communications professors, led by Dr Stuart Dodd. Part of MK ULTRA.

Washington University (Physics Dept.), St. Louis- Psychoenergetic research. Waterbury Facility- Dr. Robert W. Hyde.

Water Island, U.S. Virgin Islands- Effects of psychochemical agents.

University of Western Australia- Human Ecology Fund gave a research grant to Professor Ronald Taft.

Wayne State University- Microwave Auditory Effects and Applications. It explores the possible mechanisms for the phenomenon, and discusses possibilities for the deaf, as persons with certain types of hearing loss can still hear pulsed microwaves (as tones or clicks and buzzes, if words aren't modulated on). Lin mentions the Sharp experiment and comments, "The capability of communicating directly with humans by pulsed microwaves is obviously not limited to the field of therapeutic medicine."

Westinghouse Friendship Laboratories -Joint-service ESP experiments.

The Wenner-Gren Foundation, London- A lso provided funds for a 'project in the Cross-Cultural Study of Psychoactive Drugs which was presented at the Congress'

West Haven VA- Yale University researchers publish findings of experiment that subjected 18 stable schizophrenia patients to psychotic relapse in an amphetamine

provocation experiment. 1996

Weyburn Mental Hospital- Between 1953 to 1960, thousands of alcoholics were dosed with LSD under controlled conditions.

Wharncliffe Hospital- John Rickman, Wilfred Bion. When Wilfred Bion arrived he was put in charge of the Training Wing and found that the main form of treatment was sedatives, for patients and doctors alike.

Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania- Eric Trist, Professor of Organisational Behaviour and Social Ecology,

White Sands- One of the key locations of the Manhattan Project. Became home of some German scientists, including Werner Von Braun,

Willowbrook State School, Staten Island, New York- 50 mentally disabled children, ages 5 to 10, under the care of Dr. Saul Krugman, wanted to determine if there were multiple strains of hepatitis. Krugman and Dr. Joan Giles, used the Willowbrook residents to test a preliminary vaccine. From 1955 to 1970, the children were injected with the virus itself or made to drink

chocolate milk mixed with faeces from other infected children in order to study their immunity.

Willow Grove- Allan Frey

University of Wisconsin- Process of personality change during psychotherapy. Focus upon schizophrenics with control composed of normal individuals. To provide certain techniques of influencing human behaviour that might have significance to the Agency.-Carl Rogers, Frank Olson.

Team is using state-of-the-art optical imaging, electrophysiology and neurochemical sensing techniques in animal models to measure the influence of vagal and trigeminal nerve stimulation on boosting neuromodulatory neuron activity in the brain. (DARPA/TNT)

Worcester Foundation for Experimental Biology, Shrewsbury, Massachusetts- MK-ULTRA Subproject 8: (See subprojects 10, 63 and 66) Study of the biochemical, neurophysiological, sociological, and clinical psychiatric aspects of LSD, and also a study of LSD antagonists and drugs related to LSD, such as L.A.E. (Lysergic Acid Ethylamide). Testing upon human volunteers.

Worcester State Hospital- Dr. Morton Rubin, Dr. William Malamud, Dr. Justin Hope, and Dr. Ellzabeth Schneidhuber are studying the psychological changes and the change in the brain activity as measured by the EEG in schizophrenic patients under the influence of sodium amytal, benzedrine, and cocaine.

World Health Organisation -O n LSD Ronald Sandison (psychiatrist). LSD Aldous Huxley, LSD Dr Harold Abramson (CIA)

Wrentham, Mass- School for the retarded, two Harvard scientists used children as young as one year old in a 1961-62 experiment to determine the human threshold for nuclear fallout.

Wright-Patterson AFB- Psychoenergetics.

Wright State University-Ohio- T eam will identify epigenetic markers of neuroplasticity and indicators of a person's response to vagal nerve stimulation, or VNS. With the AFRL and the 711 HPW the team also will work with volunteer intelligence analyst trainees studying object and threat recognition to determine the impact on the training of non-invasive VNS. (DARPA/TNT)

X

Xinjiang- Uyghurs and other Muslim minorities in Xinjiang, which includes the use of forced labour and sterilisation. Collected DNA samples from all Xinjiang residents ages 12 to 65, the official said. More than a million people, mainly Uyghurs and members of other Muslim minorities, have been detained

in recent years in a vast system of camps in China's far-west region of Xinjiang.

Yuma Proving Ground, Arizona -Effects of psychochemical agents.

Z

Zhong Ma Complex -But on a larger scale at Pingfan. Anyone charged with any type of crime such as anti-Japanese sentiment, opium smoking, espionage, communism, mental handicap or homelessness was sent to Unit 731 for experiments. Victims included mainly Chinese, stateless White Russians, Harbin Jews, Soviet prisoners captured at the borders, Mongolians, Koreans, and Europeans accused of espionage.

University Hospital of Psychiatry in Zurich- Studying how LSD breaks down people's senses of self, the research Switzerland is one of the few countries where it's possible to use LSD on human beings for scientific research.chers aimed to find targets for future experimental drugs to treat schizophrenia.
