Trauma Based Mind Control (TBMC) Programming is complex. There are numerous facets that occur within metals programming that cannot be covered. This is due to programming being individualised to a belief system, script, and internal part.

Metals Programming is a type of TBMC programming where parts/alters are given metals as a rank/value in a system. Metal parts are considered lower ranking within systems if there is a gem hierarchy as well. The exception would be if Osmium is found programmed in the system. Osmium is more valuable than diamonds.

There is metals (Medals) programming where the child being programmed is rewarded with a precious metal. The metal is awarded to the alter/part when they show proficiency in their assigned task.

There are three main types of metals:

Ferrous: Metals composed primarily of iron, such as cast iron or mild steel. Ferrous metals are magnetic and will also rust.

Non-Ferrous: Metals are not composed of any iron at all, such as aluminum and copper. They are not magnetic and will not rust.

Alloys: Compositions of two or more metals, such as brass which is composed of copper and zinc.

Lead and mercury were used magickally in the past but due to their known toxicity to humans and animals, they should not be used in programming or any other application.

Metals are regarded as sacred in some belief systems. Metals are to be treated as impure when purchased. Before their use they must be cleansed and charged through a ritual. Once this is done, their specific properties can be harnessed. Silver and Iron are considered incorruptible even if they are used in Baneful Magick. (any spell, ritual or craft meant to cause harm)

Iron is rarely found in its pure state except when it falls to Earth as a meteor (meteorite). Because iron in the earth is often the result of meteorites, it is a metal that reflects the ideology of "As above, so below." Iron is also linked with menstrual blood which in some belief systems has the most magick.

In the realm of magick and alchemy, silver is more than a precious metal; it is a carrier of lunar energy, a purifier of negative forces, and a bridge between the seen and unseen worlds.

Metals Programming- Metals Programming is a method of programming where parts are given metals as rank/value in the system. Metals are considered lower ranking within systems if there is a gem hierarchy present.

Which metals hierarchy is programed is dependent on the part's status, their parent's status, the location of birth, the group person is born into, and the programmers that work with them. Training for this program often begins between ages two and three.

Each step of obedience is linked to receiving a metal. To earn the designated metal the subject must:

- 1. Proficiency in assigned task (Hard Skills)
- 2. Pass programming tests
- 3. Be rewarded for special achievement (fighting, survival)
- 4. Be adept at games
- 5. Continuous Learning and Upskilling
- 6. Critical Thinking and Problem Solving
- 7. Show communication skills

Astrology is the belief that the positions of the sun, moon, planets, and stars can influence natural earthly occurrences and human behaviour. The word astrology means "Star Language".

Astrology when used in programming is complex. This portion of Astrology within programming provides a basic overview of the metals.

Alchemy/Astrology

In alchemy/astrology, three metals are especially important: gold, silver and copper.

Gold-Gold represents the sun in this constellation. It is considered perfect and pure because it is a precious metal and represents the perfection of the mind or soul. It is said to aid in healing, protection, growth and knowledge. Its alchemical symbol is a circle with a dot in it.

Silver-Represents the moon and is thus connected to femininity. It is also considered pure. Energies associated with silver include protection, love, dreams and divinations. Because of its clear and shiny appearance, its attributes are vision, clarity, awareness and focus. Its symbol is three arrows protruding from a single point. It is one of the most versatile metals, one of the three base metals in Alchemy. It is associated with philosophical traits of intuition, self-reflection, and inner wisdom. It is a feminine metal, a symbol of purity and is connected to the goddesses and spirits. Its energies include divination, healing, protection, emotion, love, wisdom, dreams, luck and wealth. It symbolizes attributes such as vision, clarity, awareness, focus, persistence and subtle strength.

Copper- Copper represents the body in the constellation. It is also closely associated with Venus and femininity. Copper embodies the nurturing aspect of women and their youthfulness. It is associated with matters of love & lust and symbolizes characteristics like charisma, feminine beauty, artistic creativity, affection, caring, and balance. It is also considered a healing metal that teaches about living a fulfilling life.

Iron-Is the counterpart to copper, being associated with Mars. It is a masculine metal and its attributes are physical power, aggression, lust. "It is considered to be the most 'human' metal and so, distrusted by the ethereal entities and spirits." (ancient-symbols.com) Similar to how gold represents the perfection of the mind, iron represents the need to temper these primal urges. The alchemical symbol is the Mars symbol.

Brass: Brass is the result of combining copper and zinc. The ratio of copper to zinc determines the shade of brass, ranging from a light yellow to a deep, rich gold. Brass brings out the inner truth, brings courage, shield from negative energies, and psychic attacks. Copper is sometimes viewed as a feminine, yin element, and zinc as a masculine, yang element.

Mercury-Liquid at room temperature. It is a toxic metal and is associated with death, mystery, and transformation. It is connected with divination and scrying. Mercury is also related to travel and movement, be it of a physical or spiritual nature.

Metals In Occult Practices

Aluminum: Air magick; calming; meditation; protection; soothing; travel; truthfulness. May be used as or in a mirror for scrying as it reflects energies. The magician's "invisibility metal". Reflects incoming energies and makes the perfect base for magic mirrors. Useful for magical protection if worn as jewellery.

Antimony-Is regarded as a cooperative metal because it works best when it is combined with another metal, notably lead, brass and bronze. It is actually a metalloid that does not react chemically as a metal but has a metal-like appearance & physical properties. It is a protective metal and teaches the values of transformation and adaptability. It teaches of wisdom and strength that can be gained from others and also given in return.

Brass: The magickal properties of copper as well as: defensive magick; prosperity; reversal magick; self-confidence; self-discipline; self-esteem; spirit communications; strength; sun magick; wealth. It does not conduct energy as well as pure copper.

Bronze: The magickal properties of copper as well as: ambition; auditory magick; career; communication; creativity; employment; job; imagination; intuition; resilience. It does not conduct energy as well as pure copper.

Copper: Abundance; attraction; balance; change; concentration; fertility; financial comfort; focus; friendship; good luck; happiness; harmony; healing; health; love; lust; money; passion; peace of mind; peacefulness; purification; repel negativity; romantic love; self-esteem; spirituality. It is often used in wands as it is excellent for conducting other energies. In magick, it is the most versatile of all metals.

Electrum: The magickal properties of gold and silver as well as: marriage; relationship communication; true love. It is also used to honour and invoke Goddess and God together.

Gold: Ambition; confidence; financial comfort and success; fortune; generosity; good luck; healing; happiness; honesty; hope; influence; money; opportunity; positive energy attraction; positivity; power; prosperity; protection; strength; success; sun magick; wealth; willpower; wisdom.

Iron: It is both terrestrial and stellar; as above, so below. Attraction; astral projection and travel; change; courage; defense; Earth magick; grounding; hex-breaking; marriage; psychic healing, defense and protection; repelling magick, negativity and spirits. Iron does not hold non-inherent energies and they will naturally dissipate from iron shortly after use. Iron is very effective when used for dowsing.

Lead-The silent metal. It is a law upon itself and in magic, creates a space of silence. This is the perfect metal for "black space" meditations. Because of its ability to be silent in and of itself, it makes a good barrier to all forms of energy, and can be used to keep things in, as well as out; however, that is not its main purpose in energy magic but indeed, it is about "the silence within".

Lead has dark connections and is related to death and transformation. This toxic metal represents impurities of the metals as well as the humans, and its burning is

metaphoric with cleansing and removal of imperfections. It was associated with divination spells.

Nickel: It is extremely complex and when added to an alloy, increases the complexity of the mix by its very presence. Attraction; influence; knowledge; repelling; truth; wisdom.

Pewter: The magickal properties of tin as well as: family; home; home protection.

Platinum-Has been called the "solid wisdom meta

Silver: Balancing; clairvoyance; clearing; cleansing; divination; dowsing; dreams; emotional healing and growth; grounding; hex-breaking; hope; intuition; lucid dreaming; meditation; moon magick; nurturing; protection; psychic abilities; psychic attack protection; purification; reflection; self-awareness; spirituality; wisdom. It is also used to honour and invoke Goddess as well as to conduct other energies.

Ruthenium-Lends strength when added to gold or platinum

Tin: Abundance; desire; good luck; honour; hope; lust; money; passion; prosperity; rejuvenation; sexuality; success; wealth. It also amplifies the magickal properties of other ingredients.

Zinc-The metal of magical revelation. It appears innocent and ordinary in its physical state, but on the other levels zinc is an extraordinary event with powerful transformational properties.

Demonology

Atrax-The Testament of Solomon tells us that Atrax was one of the seventy-two demons that King Solomon used in the construction of his Temple (spirits of solomon). A demon of fevers, Atrax was made to perform heavy labor by theking, such as keeping the furnaces stoked for metalwork. He is described as having a shapeless head, like a DOG, but with the face of a bird, donkey, or ox.

Azzael-In Enochian lore, in the Book of Enoch, Azzael ("God strengthens") is one of the fallen angels who swore allegiance to Samiaza, rebelled against God, took a human wife, and fathered the NEPHILIM. Additionally, he taught the construction of jewelry; the use of cosmetics and dyes; a type of magic that would allow the moon, stars, and sun to move closer to the earth where they can be better worshipped; the science of metallurgy and minerals; and untold secrets of a sexual nature.

Beherit-Demon who is a great duke of hell commanding 26 Legions of lesser demons. Beherit has red skin and appears as a soldier wearing a crown and riding a red horse. He gives true answers about things past, present, and future and can turn metals into gold. A magician must wear a silver ring when conjuring him.

Bofry-Theurgia Goetia, the second book of the Lemegeton, says that Duke Bofry commands twenty-six legions of demons. He appears before his summoner as a soldier wearing a red uniform and a gold crown upon his head, and riding a red horse. He will honestly answer any question regarding the past, present, or future and has the ability to transmute any metal into gold.

Dabog-Is associated with precious gems and smith work; his sacred metal is bronze. He lives in the underworld but can shape-shift into a wolf form that he uses to wander the mortal world at night.

Hagenti (Haagenti)-Fallen angel and 48th of the 72 spirits of solomon. Hagenti is a president who rules 33 legions of demons. He appears in the shape of a bull with griffin wings but will change into human form when commanded by a magician. He turns wine into water, transmutes all metals into gold, and imparts wisdom.

Och-The grimoire Arbatel de Magia Veterum (Arbatel of the Magic of the Ancients) written by an unknown author and published in 1575 in Basel, Switzerland, ranks Och as one of the seven Olympian spirits. He is known to create medicine; give excellent FAMILIAR spirits, gold, money, and wisdom; transform any substance into the purest precious gem or metal; as well as extend a person's life with perfect health for six hundred years.

Phul-In the grimoire Arbatel de Magia Veterum (Arbatel of the Magic of the Ancients), published in Switzerland by an unknown author in 1575. Phul is listed as one of the seven Olympian spirits and named the lord of the powers of the moon and supreme lord of the waters. A nocturnal demon with dominion over the moon, Phul is said to have the ability to change any metal into pure silver.

Rosabis-In Apollonius of Tyana's Nuctemeron (Night Illuminated by Day), Rosabis is the demon of metals. He is most powerful during the eleventh hour.

Trimasael-The Grimoirium Verum (Grimoire of Truth), allegedly written by Alibek the Egyptian in 1517. This demon is summoned for his ability to teach alchemy, chemistry, illusions, and sleight of hand, and how to burn base metals into silver and gold. When invoked, if Trimasael is not content with his summoner, this demon will not impart onto him the secrets of changing base metals.

Zagan-Fallen angel and 61st of the 72 spirits of solomon. Zagan is a president and king who appears, first as a bull with griffin wings and then as a man. He makes men clever and witty, turns water into wine, blood into oil and oil into water, and wine into water or blood. Zagan can turn any metal into money and can make fools wise. He commands 33 legions of demons.

Messianic Metals

Copper-A symbol of judgement and was only found in the outer courts of the Tabernacle. The laver/basin of water, where the priests washed their hands and feet, before making sacrifices on the altar for burnt sin offerings, were both covered in copper (ref. Exodus 27:1-8; 30:17-21). Likewise, American judge's gavels are typically fashioned with a copper or brass (an alloy of copper) band alluding to copper's ancient connection with judgement.

Silver-was seen as the transactional metal. It was linked with atonement and redemption and was the required form of paying off blood debts (ref. Exodus 21:32). Silver's connotation to fulfilling obligations was so significant that it was the typical word for currency in the Bible and is also the Modern Hebrew word for money "keceph" (99). When God asked Moses to take a census, every man over the age of twenty was required to provide a ransom of half a shekel of silver as a redemption price.

Gold-Association with purity is based on its high corrosion resistance, which makes it incredibly difficult to defile. Gold is the only metal mentioned before the Fall of Man and was heavily associated with the location of the Garden of Eden and the surrounding provinces, "where there is gold. And the gold of that land is pure" (Exodus 2:11-12).

Mythical Metals

Adamantium, adamantite, or adamantine-Depending on the source, is a near indestructible super alloy or metal. According to the X-Men movies adamantium can be shaped when created (by the combination of fluid ingredients). However, once cooled to a solid state, it becomes indestructible once again.

Cargonite-An incredibly dense and supposedly impenetrable metal featured in 4D Man, a 1959 film.

Dalekanium-In the Doctor Who TV show, this is the material from which the Daleks craft their nearly indestructible battle shells. The metal is considered a bonded polycarbide, and was dubbed "dalekanium" by the human Dortmun in The Dalek Invasion of Earth. Later it is seen that the Daleks call the material by this term.

Nth Metal-A do-all, wonder metal created by DC comics. Nth metal comes from the planet Thanagar – homeworld to Hawkman and Hawkwoman. Wearing objects made of Nth metal grants people many super-abilities including flight, super strength, and speed healing. It also protects the wearer from the elements and extreme temperatures.

Omnium Steel-A ferroalloy of the Marvel Comics universe which is stronger than titanium though weaker than adamantium. There is also a form of omnium which possesses elastic ductility while retaining high durability.

Orichalcum-A reddish metal mentioned in several ancient writings, most notably Plato's Critias dialogue. Orichalcum was considered second only to gold in value, and could be mined in many parts of ancient Atlantis. By the time of Critias, however, it was known only by name. It is used to make structures, walls, and coins, and may perhaps be based on an actual mineral or gold/copper alloy, possibly Auricupride.

Radium X-An intensively radioactive extraterrestrial element discovered by Dr. Janos Rukh (Boris Karloff) in the 1936 film The Invisible Ray. In the film, Dr. Rukh creates a death beam projector which harnesses the incredible power of Radium X for use as a destructive weapon of mass terror.

Rearden Metal-A key plot point in the novel Atlas Shrugged. Rearden metal is a new type of alloy invented by character Hank Rearden. It appears as greenish-blue and is set to be a lighter, stronger worldwide replacement for steel. Interestingly, it contains both iron and copper, which are rarely combined in real-world alloys.

Unobtainium-Is often used as an expression for extremely rare or costly materials needed to complete a goal or project design. However, the idea of unobtainium took tangible form in the movie Avatar. In the film, unobtainium is the most valuable substance in the galaxy and the cause of the planet-wide war at the center of the film. Ironically, the prop for unobtainium was a chunk of simple lead.

Uru-Asgardian metal used to create Mjolnir, the hammer of Thor.

Vibranium-Created by Marvel comics, vibranium is an extremely rare metal from meteorites that crashed into earth. It is so named because its isotopes completely

absorb any and all vibration, including sound. The energy from these vibrations is stored in the bonds between the molecules of the vibranium – increasing its strength. Bullets will not ricochet off vibranium. Rather, they will noiselessly thud against it as all the sound and force (vibration) is absorbed. Vibranium is perhaps most famous for being the principal raw material in Captain America's iconic shield.

Script Specific Metals:

When a script is used in programming, metals from the script are used as a part of metals programming.

Some metals in found in scripts are:

Beskar-This metal appears in the Star Wars universe. It is a metal used by the Mandalorian warriors, which is why it is also known as Mandalorian Iron. Beskar is extremely durable, being able to deflect shots from blasters and hold up against strikes from a lightsaber. The Mandalorians use it to create their armor, which can be passed down and reforged for generations.

Cortosis-A lightsaber resistant metal used in Star Wars.

Duranium-In Star Trek, spacecraft hulls are made from the super metal alloys duranium and tritanium.

Durasteel-One of the most used alloys in the Star Wars universe. Its qualities include: being very flexible, resistant to heat and cold, monumentally physically stress resistant, and the color brown. Because of these it is the most common material for the manufacture of spacecraft hulls.

Gold-Wizard of Oz

Mithril-A super metal from J. R. R. Tolkien's Middle-earth universe. It is precious and silvery, stronger than steel but much lighter in weight. It first appears in The Hobbit, where it is also called "silver-steel". Its properties were developed in The Lord of the Rings.

Phrikk-Star Wars Expanded Universe phrikk is a metal strong enough to withstand the destruction of an entire world.

Plasteel-Star Wars, a material that combines acrylic polymers and metal alloys.

Silver-Wizard of Oz

Steelstone-Star Wars, a building metal which has the visual appearance of stone.

Tin-Wizard of Oz. The Woodman was made of tin.

Transparisteel-Star Wars, A transparent metal alloy used in the construction of starship viewports and windows.
