

Shakespeare Programming

Shakespeare Programming-Shakespearean prose, iambic pentameter, or specific recitations contain hidden triggers, memes, or scripts.

Literary conditioning: repeatedly using Shakespearean stories or language to reinforce particular ideas or emotional associations.

Archetypal programming: using figures such as Hamlet, Macbeth, Othello, or Lady Macbeth as symbolic models for particular behaviours or conflicts.

Quote based triggers: associating specific Shakespeare quotations with cues, emotions, or situations.

Thematic programming: using recurring themes; betrayal, ambition, jealousy, guilt, revenge, identity, madness, or power, as a framework for interpreting experiences.

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
